The Board of Regents will consider the appointment of Lauren Tripp to the position of Chief Internal Auditor for the Nevada System of Higher Education, as recommended by the ad hoc Chief Internal Auditor Search Committee at its October 11, 2024, meeting. 4. UPCOMING VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF THE PRESIDENT, TMCC

FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Interim Chancellor Patricia Charlton, in consultation with Board of Regents Chair Amy J. Carvalho and Vice Chair Jeffrey S. Downs, will provide a recommendation regarding the upcoming vacancy in the Office of the President at Truckee Meadows Community College. This recommendation follows listening sessions with internal and external stakeholders on September 27, 2024, pursuant to the NSHE Code (Title 2, Chapter 1, Section 1.5.5(d)). The Board of Regents will consider the recommendation and may take action to commence a search for a permanent President of TMCC without appointing an acting or interim President, including determining: 1) when to commence the search; 2) the general timing of the search; 3) whether to conduct a national, regional, or in-state search; and 4) whether to engage the services of a Search Consultant to assist the Presidential Search Committee. (Ref. BOR-4)

FISCAL IMPACT: The cost of engaging the services of a search consultant is unknown at this time. The average cost of executive search services for the three most recent NSHE president searches is \$96,000 (professional/administrative fee only–does not include discretionary costs such as advertising and consultant/candidate travel.) All costs associated with the search shall be paid by TMCC.
