It is important to note that scholarships will also be provided through Podium and UNLV to ensure access to this special course experience by students who may otherwise not be able to afford the fee. UNLV offered this course on an experimental basis in Fall 2024 to determine student interest. The 100 seats in the class filled in less than 5 hours after registration opened, and in less than 24 hours UNLV filled a 100-seat waiting list as well. The students want access to these types of global, career-prep course experiences and establishing this fee (which will only cover the direct costs to Podium) will allow us to make this experiential learning opportunity available to them each semester.
