

Presidential Search Committee Best Practices, Ground Rules, and Standards of Behavior Truckee Meadows Community College

A Presidential search is a critical and dynamic process, and the results are far-reaching. Given its importance, it is essential that all members of the Presidential Search Committee are committed to upholding best search practices during the process. As a member of the Truckee Meadows Community College Presidential Search Committee, you are required to adhere to the following throughout the search:

- 1. **Listen Deeply** Members should be committed to actively listening to all perspectives and points of view. Experiencing a wide array of perspectives is part of the richness and purpose of having a Search Committee.
- 2. **Commitment to Student Success and Diversity** Search Committee members hold a responsibility to further the College's Values.
- 3. **Reference Checks** The Search Committee will not participate in the reference process. Reference checking is the sole responsibility of ACCT. Search Committee members are absolutely restricted from contacting references.
- 4. **Communication** Search Committee discussion will take place only when convened as a Search Committee. Side bar conversations are not permitted.
- 5. **Decision-Making** It is important that members consider decision-making as a shared process and focus on fairly assessing all candidates. Members should constantly monitor themselves for unconscious bias.
- 6. **Internet Research** Search Committee members shall avoid researching candidates via online platforms to evaluate their fit with the College. The search firm and its designees will work to conduct thorough internet checks.
- 7. **Thoughtfulness** Every Search Committee member is asked to demonstrate respect for one other and the importance of the integrity of the search process itself; dominating the conversation and bullying are not permissible.
- 8. **Collaboration** Every Search Committee member has equal time. Everyone is an ally. Everyone participates.
