Program Demand Gap Analysis of Nevada's Workforce and Workforce Development Efforts

- A program demand gap analysis typically examines the difference in evolving workforce development opportunities and needs and current graduation rates and educational program offerings.
- Methodology:
 - Examination of general socio-demographic, economic, and even housing characteristics across the state.
 - Industry and occupation sector trends (National, State, Regional).
 - Program enrollment and graduation trends.
 - 'Gap Identification' between industry and occupation sectors and program enrollment and graduation trends.
- Used to support informed decision making, improve resource allocations, and enhance educational 'relevance' to the private sector.

Required Skill Sets for Employees in Each 'Targeted Opportunity' Occupation Sector

- **Architecture and Engineering**: mix of technical and soft skills; strong analytical, problem-solving, and communication skills; proficiency in CAD and other software; building codes, regulations, project management; creativity, innovation, interpersonal skills, and leadership.
- Arts, Design, Entertainment, Sports, and Media: creative and technical skills; verbal and written
 communication, interpersonal skills; independent and collaborative work; attention to detail; adaptability and
 flexibility; problem-solving and critical thinking.
- **Business and Financial Operations**: technical, soft skills and industry knowledge; accounting, finance, data analysis; communication, collaboration, and problem-solving abilities; accounting software, financial reporting, cost-analysis, and reconciliation.
- **Computer and Mathematical**: technical expertise, analytical skills, strong problem-solving; programming languages, software development tools, data analysis techniques; mathematics, statistics, various mathematical principals and statistical techniques; pattern identification and solution development.
- **Construction and Extraction**: tools, machinery, equipment; building materials, construction methods, project management; plumbing, electrical, carpentry, masonry; safety and OSHA protocols and standards; communication, teamwork, problem-solving, adaptability, leadership, active listening, critical thinking, interpersonal skills.

Required Skill Sets for Employees in Each 'Targeted Opportunity' Occupation Sector

- **Educational Instruction and Library**: strong communication, interpersonal, and organizational skills; instructional design; adaptability; assessment of data analysis; organizational management; creativity and innovation; problem-solving; new and emerging technologies and 'best practices' management.
- **Food Preparation and Serving Related**: technical skills including knife and cooking skills, temperature control, food preparation and presentation; food safety including sanitation procedures, allergen management, food safety regulations; interpersonal and physical skills; communication and customer services; basic math skills; computer skills, time management, organizational, and leadership skills.
- Healthcare Practitioners and Technical Operations: technical proficiency, knowledge of medical procedures, familiarity with healthcare IT systems (esp. Electronic Health Records, Electronic Medical Records); communication, empathy, critical thinking, and problem-solving abilities; medical terminology; coding and billing knowledge.
- **Healthcare Support**: blend of soft skills (communication, empathy, time management) and hard skills related to patient care and technical procedures; strong communication and interpersonal skills; empathy and understanding; ability to work under pressure and attention to detail; patient care skills, technical skills (vital signs, administering medications, operation of medical equipment), knowledge of HIPAA, computer skills (electronic health records and other computer systems); required certifications.

Required Skill Sets for Employees in Each 'Targeted Opportunity' Occupation Sector

- Installation, Maintenance, and Repair: blend of technical skills, problem-solving, and physical dexterity; troubleshooting, repair, equipment maintenance, technical knowledge, electrical and mechanical skills, and basic computer skills; analytical thinking, attention to detail, critical thinking, time management; customer service, communication skills, and adaptability.
- **Legal**: adaptability, discretion, strong communication; analytical and research skills; ability to work collaboratively and ethically; legal knowledge; writing skills and technical proficiency (software for filing, eDiscovery); practice management; time management; professionalism, adaptability, persuasion, problem-solving, critical thinking, customer service.
- Life, Physical, and Social Science: technical and soft skills; scientific knowledge (biological processes, anatomy, physiology); analytical abilities including interpreting data, conducting research, drawing conclusions from experiments; problem-solving and attention to detail; communication and interpersonal skills; research and communication skills; policy development and analysis.
- Management: blend of hard and soft skills including leadership, communication, and analytical capabilities (interpreting
 data, patterns, making informed decisions); financial management and data analysis; strategic thinking including
 development of long-term plans and strategies; time management, delegation, teamwork and collaboration, adaptability,
 motivation.
- *Transportation and Material Moving*: strong communication skills; cognitive and mental skills; directing and signaling and coordination; judgment and decision-making, adaptability (identification and resolution of issues that may arise during the transportation and movement of materials), problem-solving; operation of machinery, safety knowledge.
