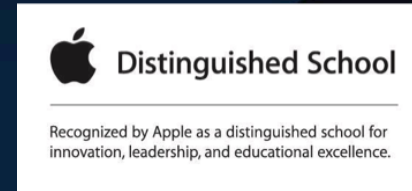

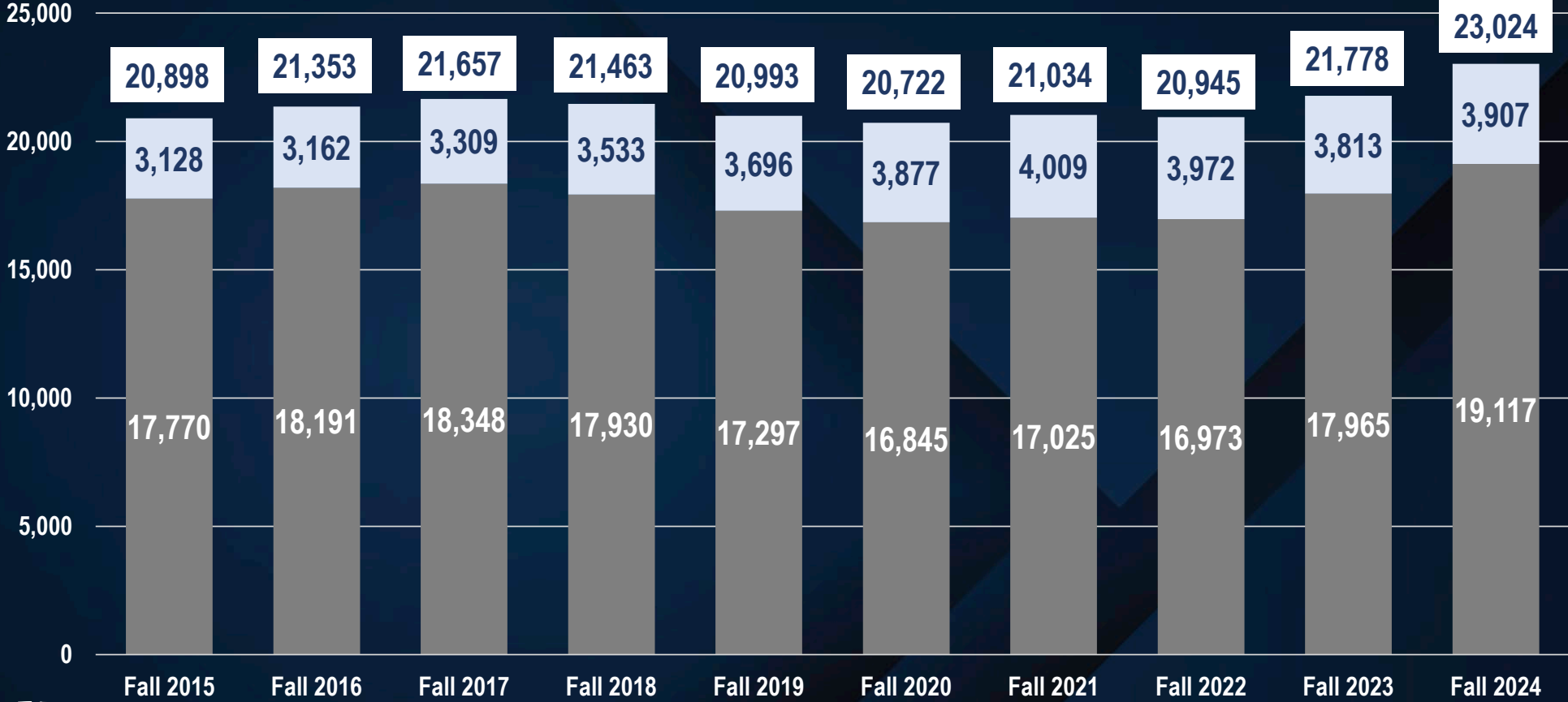

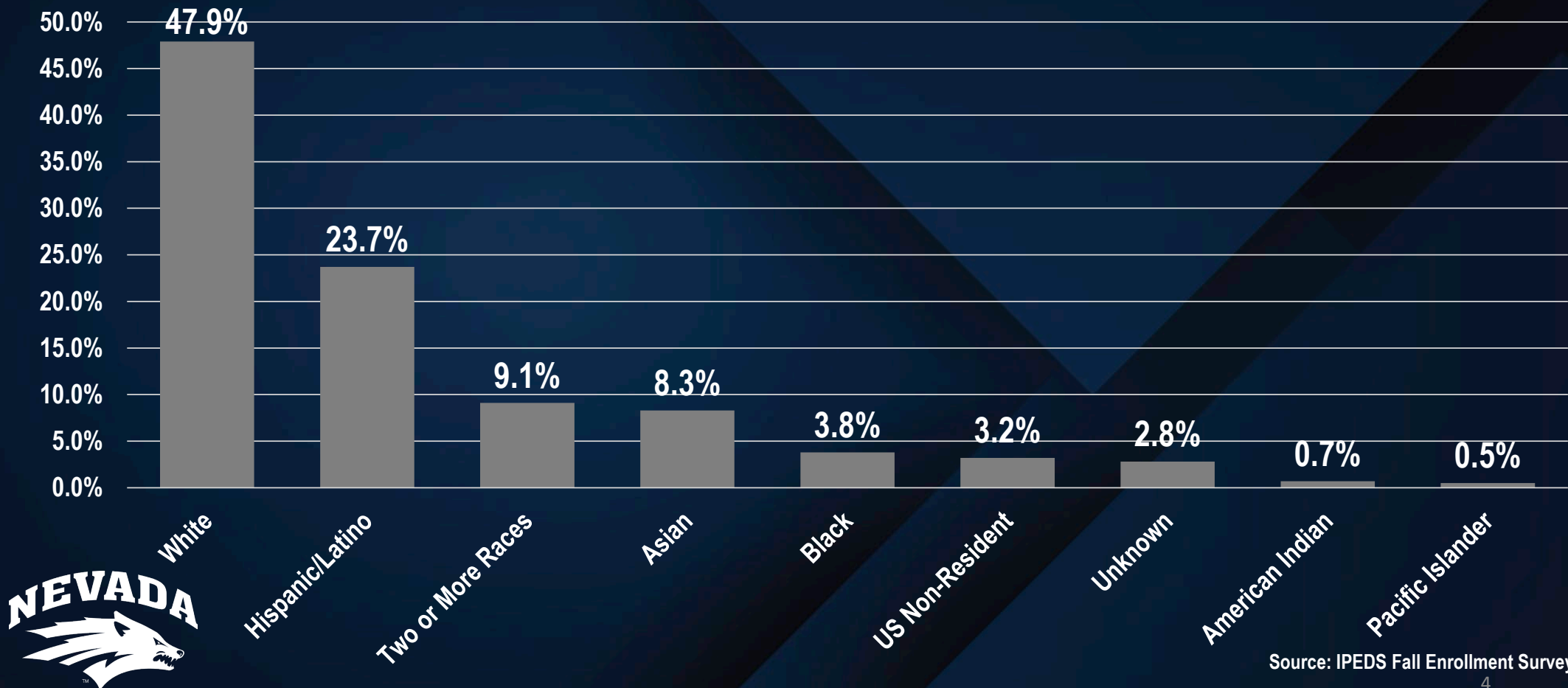

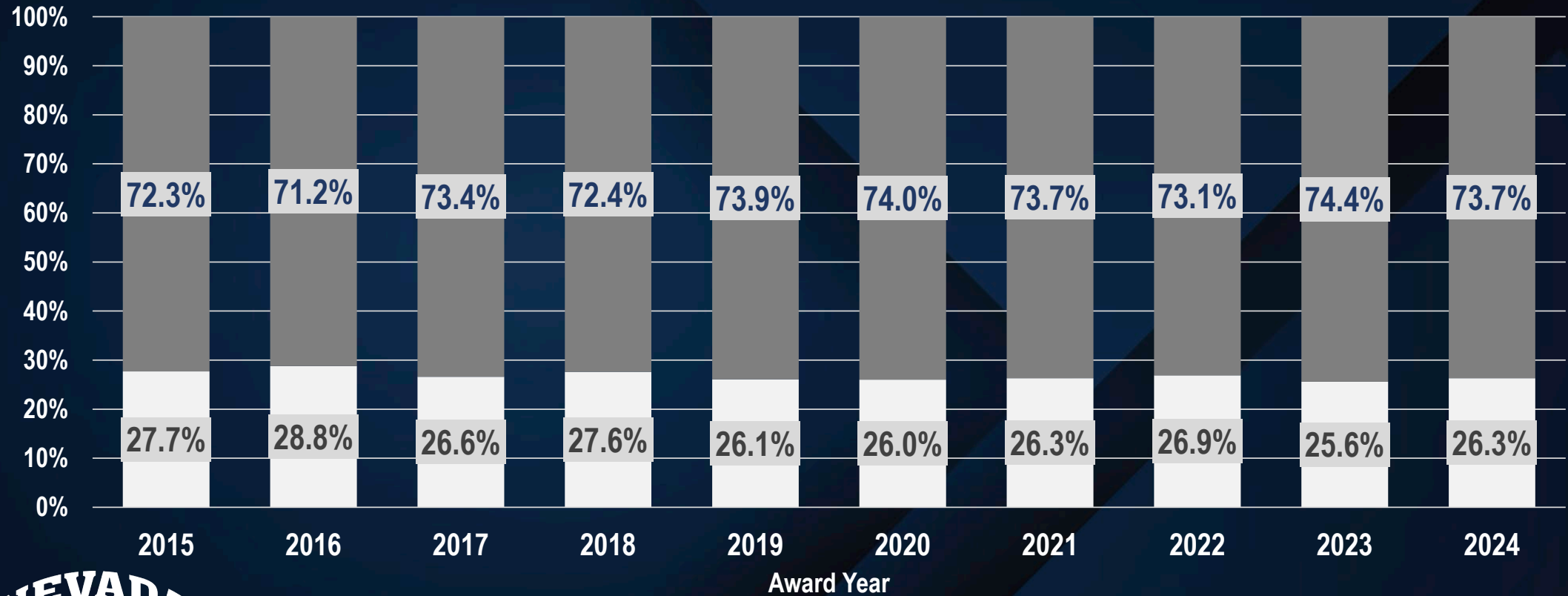

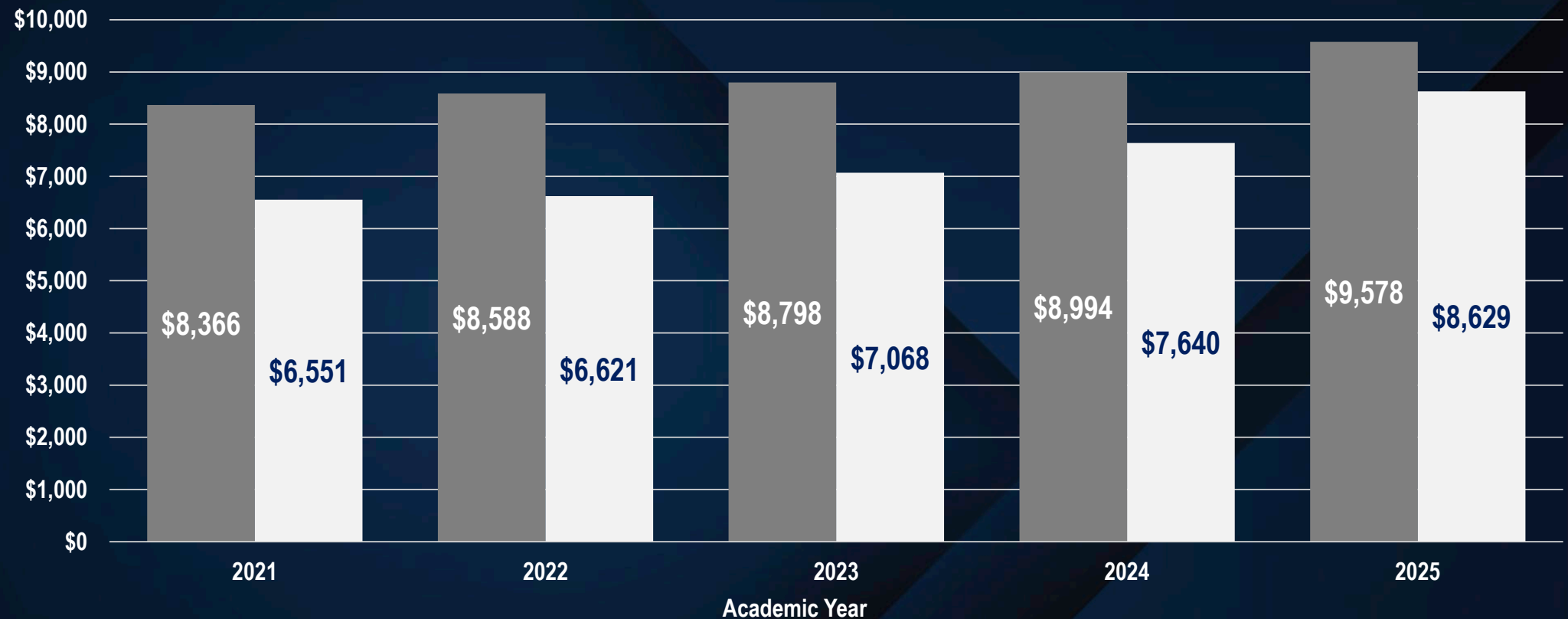
Annual Enrollment Distribution within Pell and Non-Pell Categories

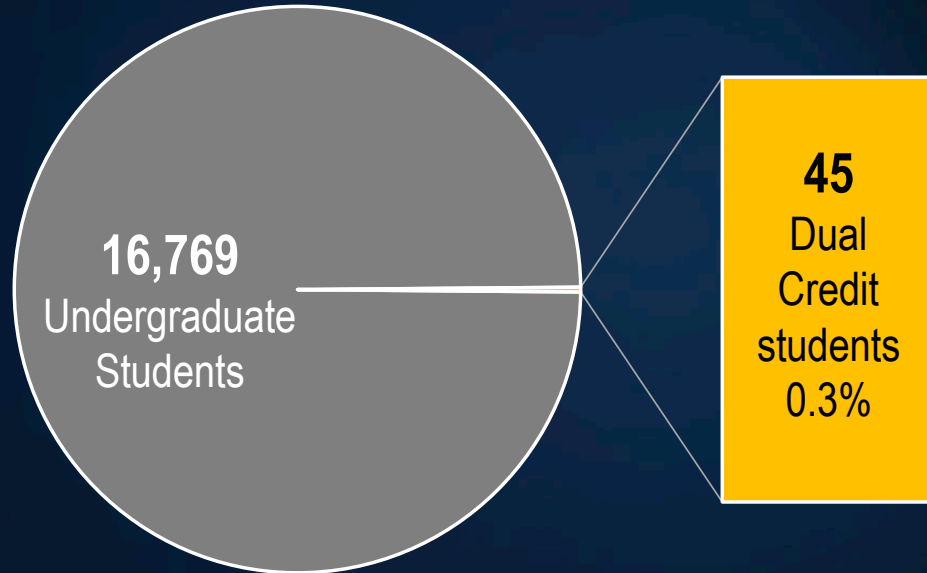

Dual Credit Enrollment vs. Non-Dual Credit Enrollment

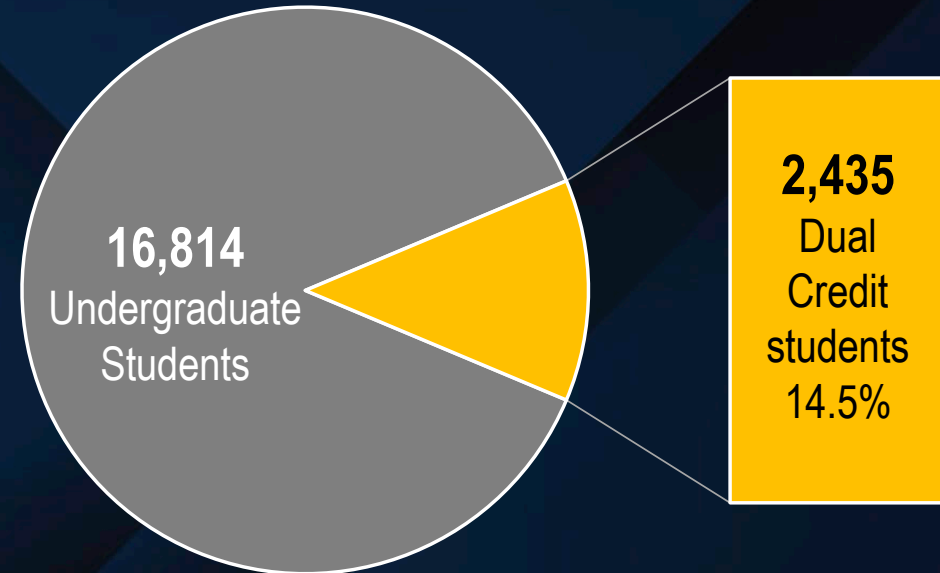
Fall 2014 Undergraduate Headcount

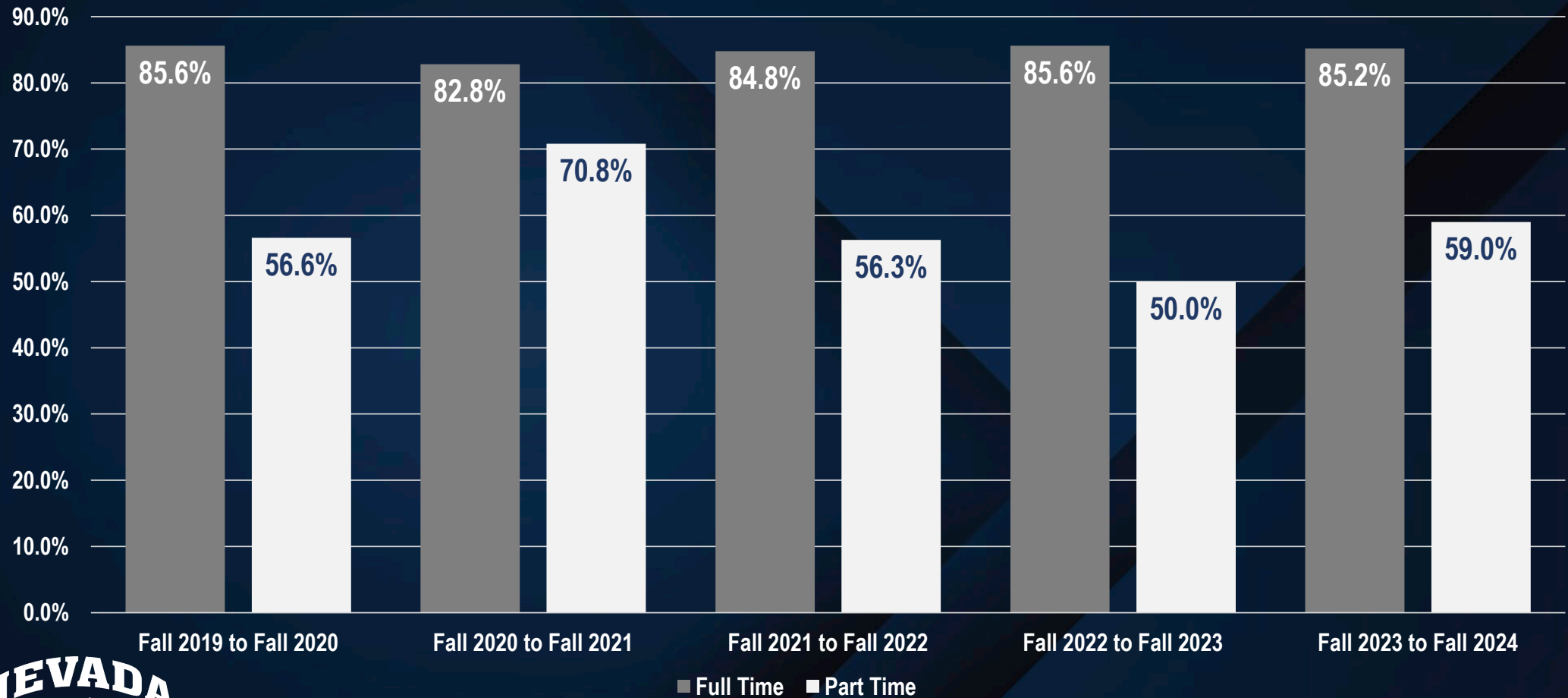

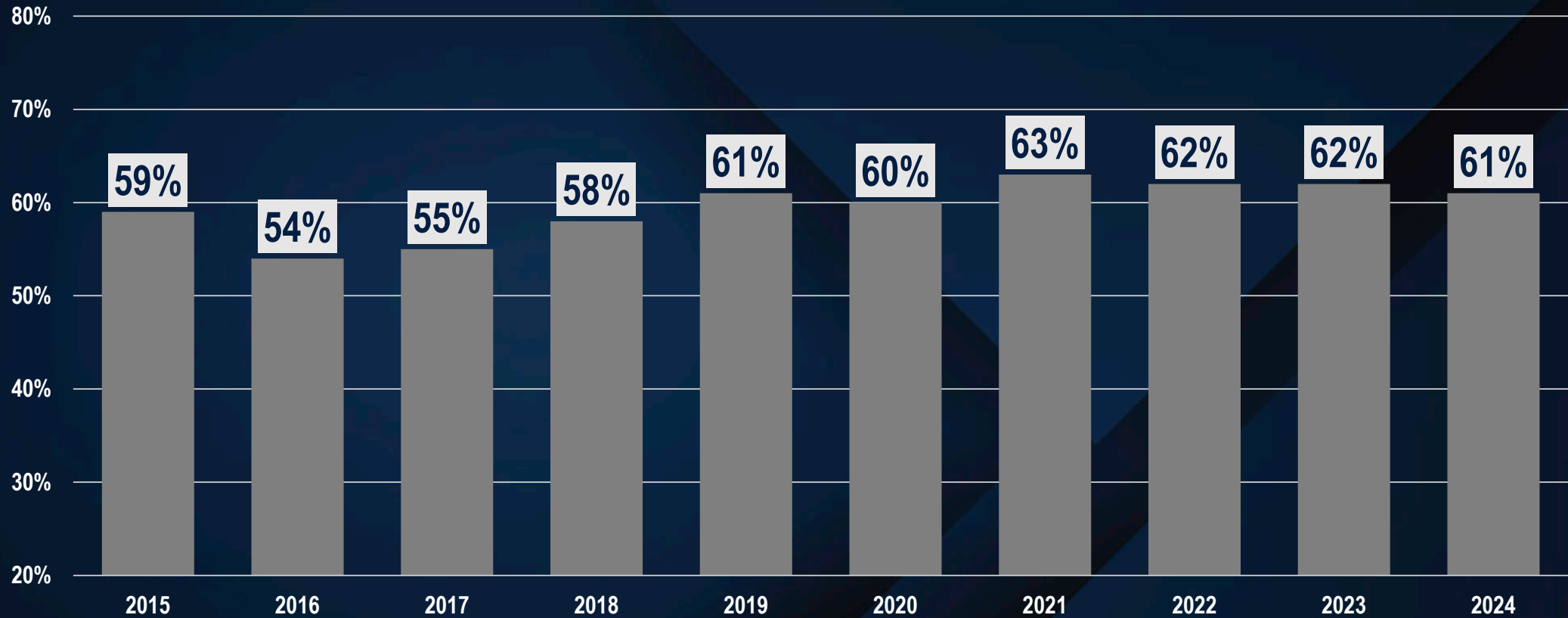

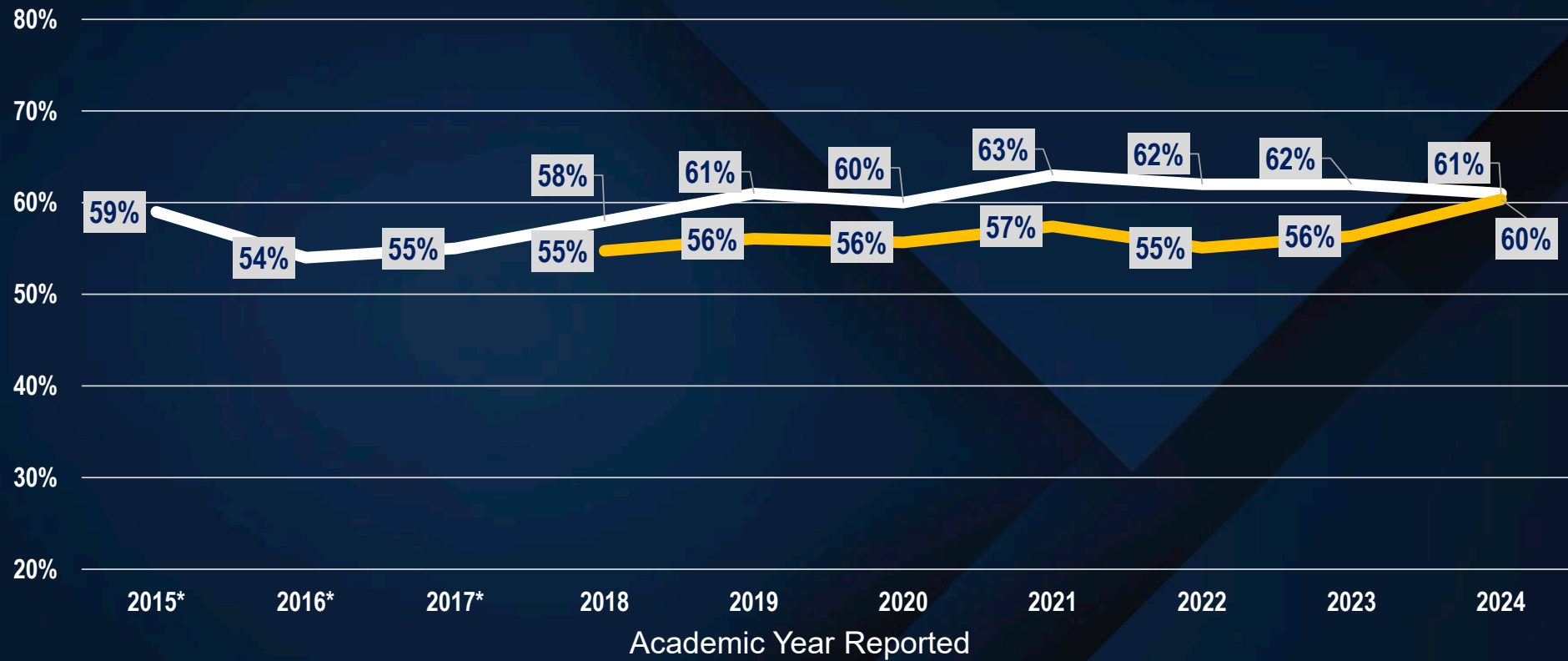

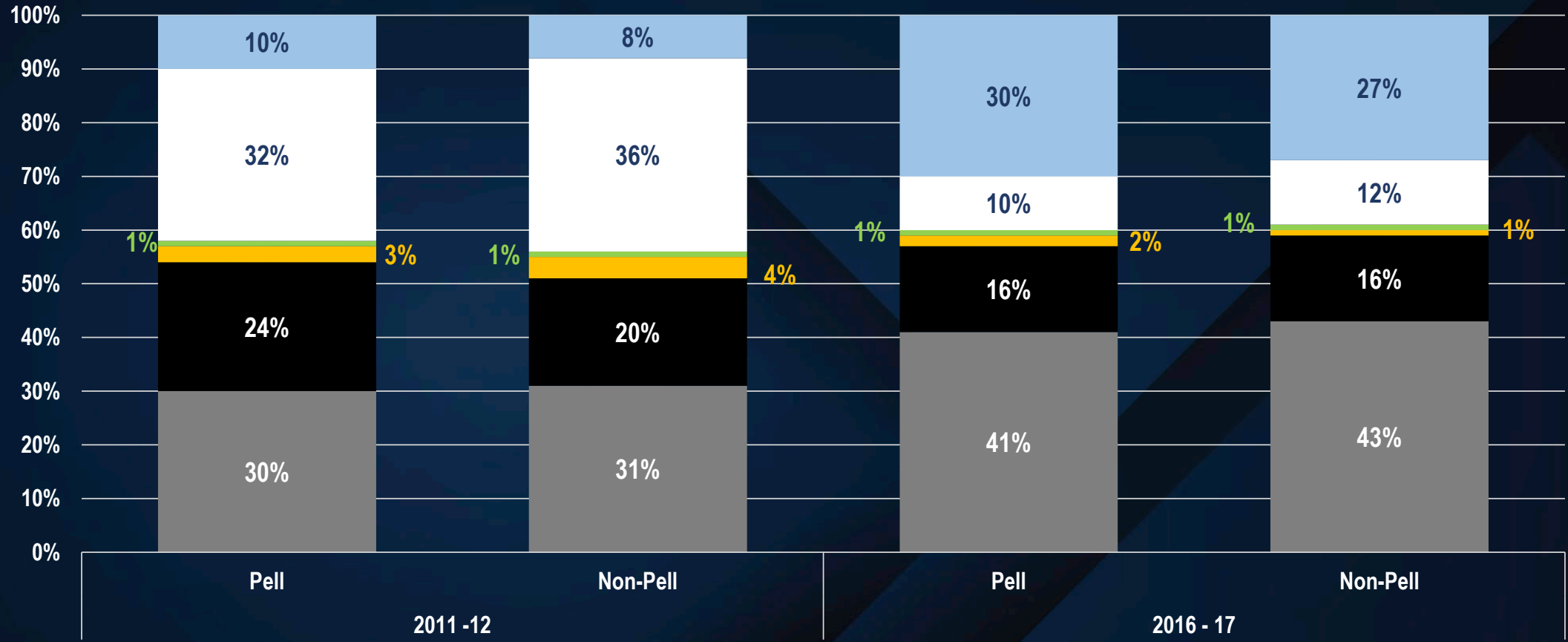
Graduation Rates (Performance Gap)

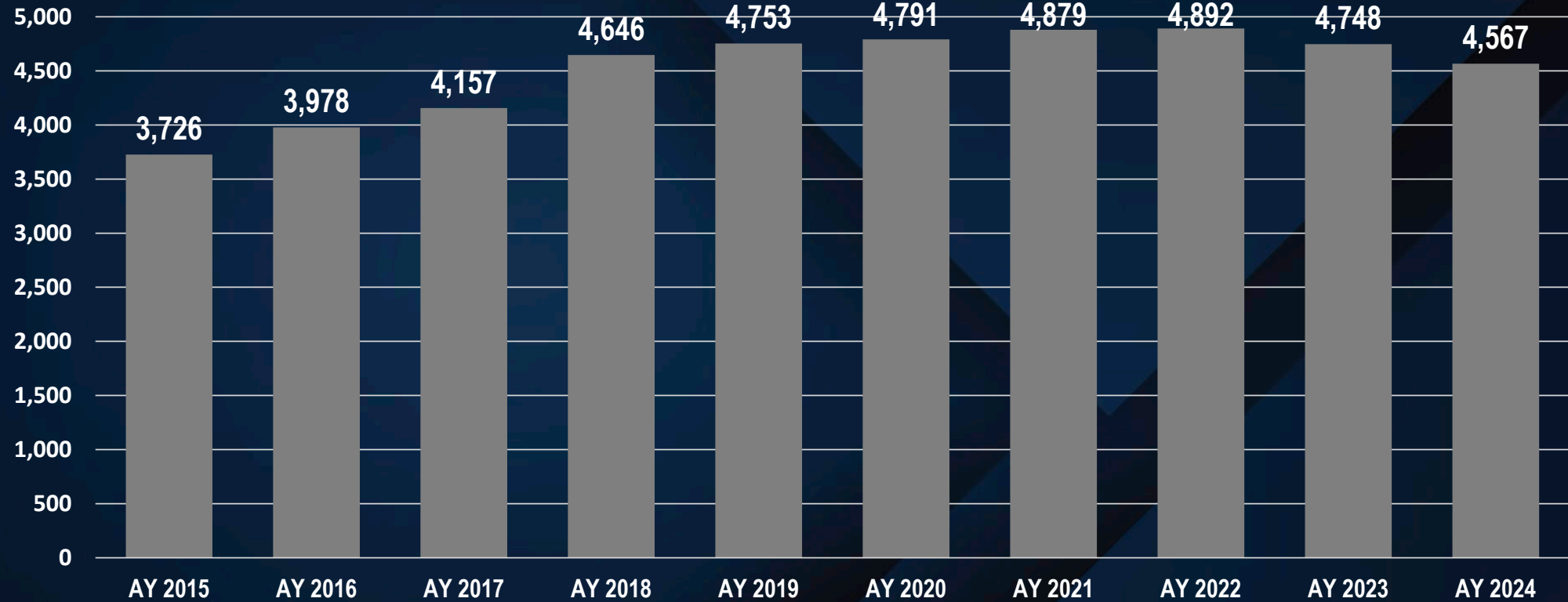

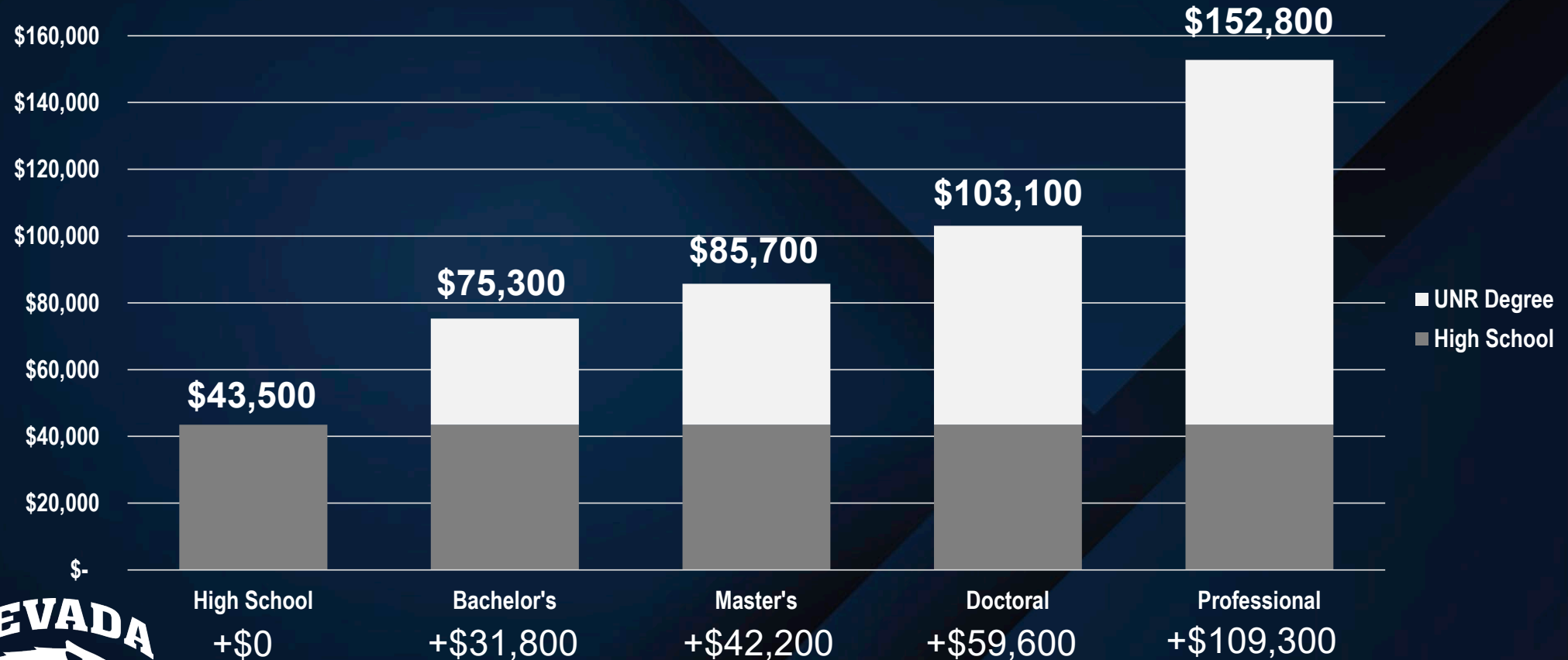
Number of Students Receiving a Degree or Certificate

Value of a University of Nevada, Reno Degree

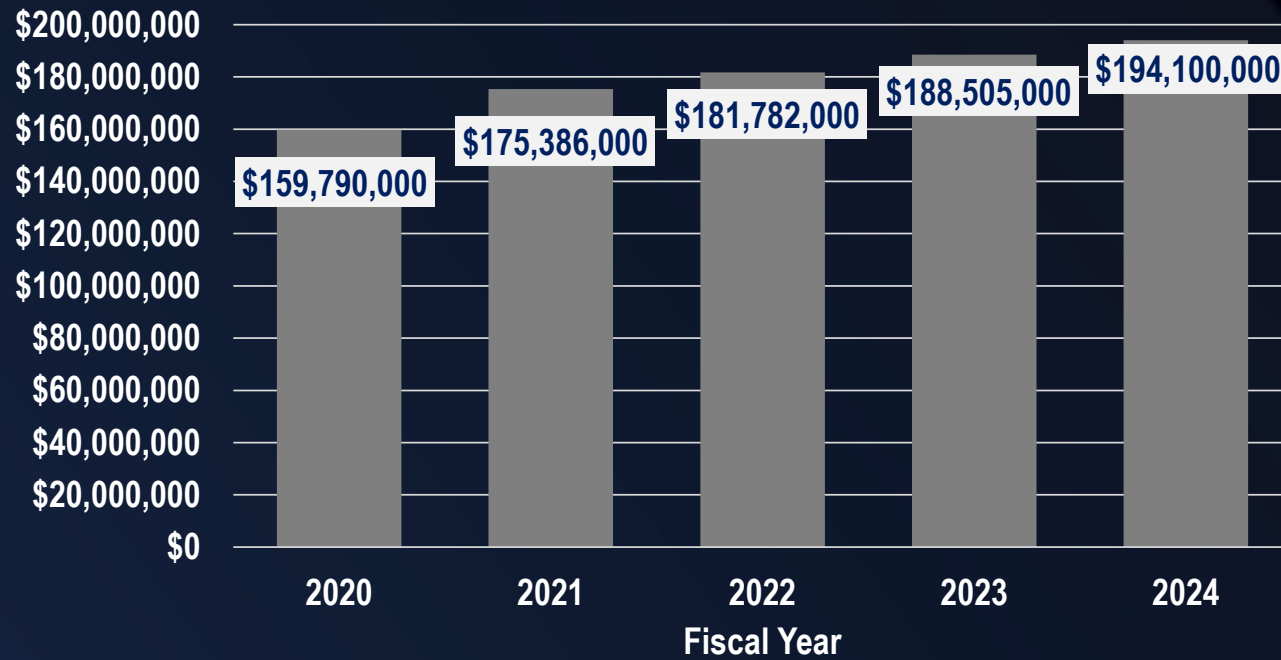


Incremental Wages From Nevada Earned Degrees

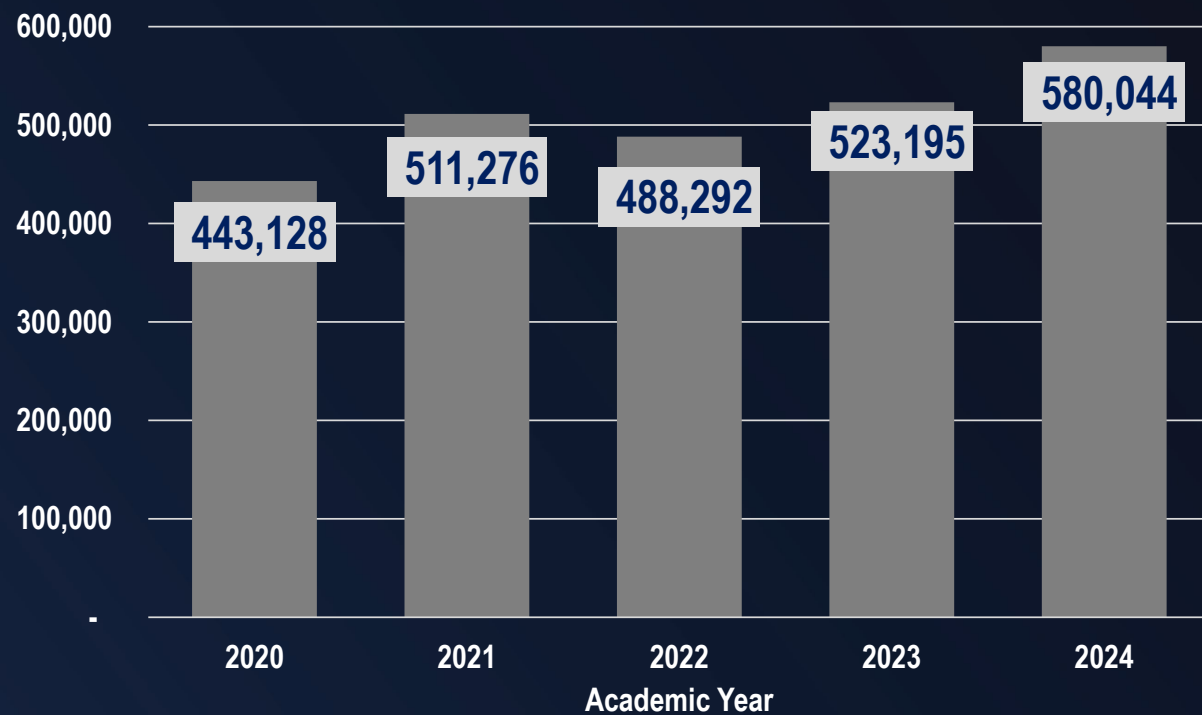

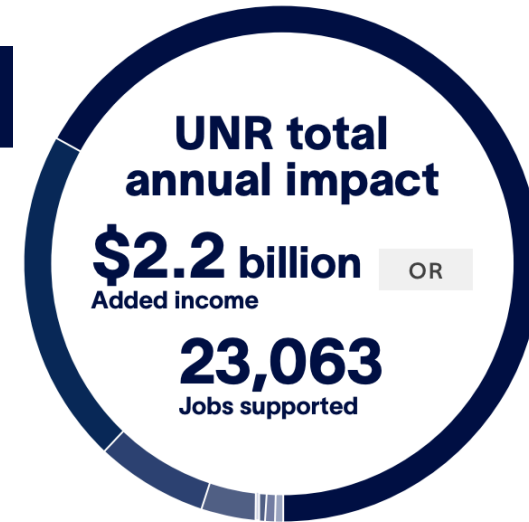

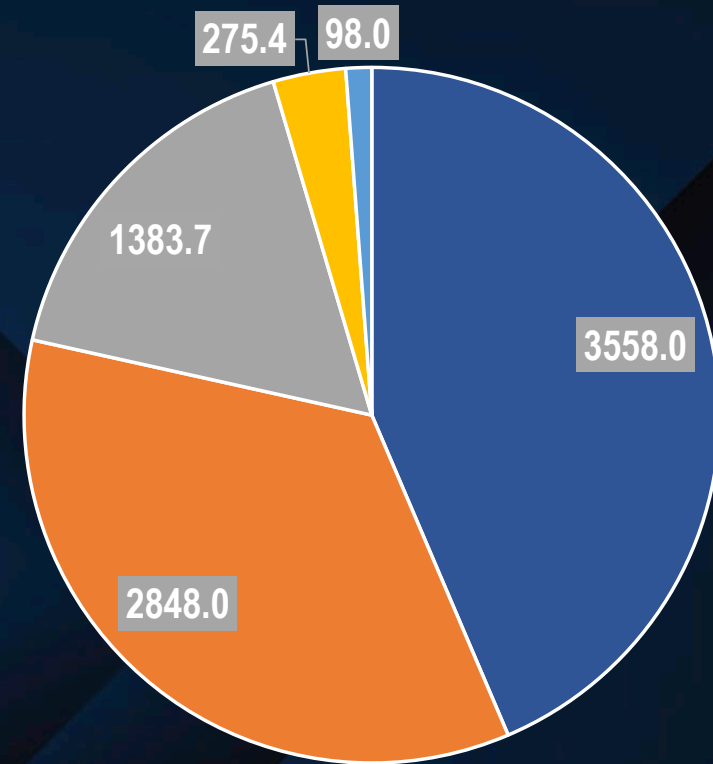
