4. OUTSOURCED CHIEF INVESTMENT OFFICER SERVICES

FOR POSSIBLE ACTION

Chris Viton, Vice Chancellor of Budget and Finance/Chief Financial Officer, will provide a summary of the recently completed Request for Proposals (RFP) solicitation for Outsourced Chief Investment Officer (OCIO) services, and will request that the Committee accept the recommendation of the RFP evaluation committee, approve the award for OCIO Services for the Endowment Fund to Cambridge Associates, and authorize the Chancellor to execute the services agreement. FISCAL IMPACT: Fees for advisory services on the Operating Fund are \$50,000 annually and OCIO fees for the Endowment Fund are 30 basis points on the first \$500 million investable assets and 26 basis points on the next \$500 million (approximately \$1.1 million annually at the current managed asset value of \$356.7 million). Fees are paid from the Operating Fund and Endowment Fund, respectively.
