This proposed two-year A.A.S. represents a practical, workforce-aligned approach that meets students where they are while preparing them for sustainable, family-supporting careers. Just as important, it strengthens Nevada's ability to delivery critical infrastructure and development projects by building a more reliable and skilled local talent pipeline.

This is exactly the kind of program that builds opportunity locally and drives long-term impact. At the same time, it creates a reliable pipeline for contractors, owners, and trade partners needed to sustain responsible growth across the region.

An example is WSU, which only offers 60 out-of-state seats each application cycle. Nevada also did not have a WICHE state deal for a very long time. Thankfully, that has changed because of Utah State, which we are very grateful for. However, that provides only 70 seats for Nevadans. Cost is another factor. Out-of-state tuition is a difficult pill to swallow. Some vet schools, like The Ohio State, offer in-state tuition after a year, but that makes those schools extremely competitive.

My classmates and I deserve better. We've deserved this vet school for years. We hold so much passion for animals and veterinary medicine. We will end the shortage of veterinarians in Nevada if you give us this opportunity. This conversation isn't just about opening a vet school. You're holding our dreams in your hands. We don't want to be in debt forever, and getting to pay in-state tuition lessens that burden. I'm a low-income, first-generation student. Being in college is already a miracle in itself. I'm willing to wait for the University of Nevada, Reno's School of Veterinary Medicine. This is the only way we can realistically pay for veterinary school.

The focus of my comments is to voice strong support for the proposed IP royalty and distribution formula...dividing the incoming royalty revenue between three parties

1. The pool of inventors: 40%
2. The inventors' academic departments: 25%
3. The institutional Proof of Concept Fund: 35%

The 40% of the royalty revenues going to the inventors is the median percentage of dozens of R-1 universities...including many in the Mountain West Conference. Importantly, the new distribution formula allocates 35% of the royalty revenue to the critical Proof of Concept Fund. This is the space between the initial laboratory creation and the scaled-up invention. Companies are typically not willing to accept all the risk involved in licensing an unproven patent. They are looking for at least some scaled up commercial viability. Without this POC fund...early inventions enter the "Valley of Death...where good ideas go to die".

I am asking the NSHE Board of Regents to support the proposed new allocation of Intellectual Property royalty revenues. This new formula will prove to be beneficial to: the inventors, the

inventors' academic departments, the broader university and indeed...the state of Nevada itself.

As there are no in-state options, Nevada students must compete for a very limited number of seats at out-of-state schools, often at much higher costs and with lower acceptance opportunities.

A veterinary school in Nevada would greatly improve access for students who are already training here. UNR has an excellent undergraduate foundation in the biological and agricultural sciences, and many students complete pre-veterinary coursework here. However, after earning our bachelor's degrees, we are forced to leave the state to continue our education. Creating a veterinary school would allow students to move directly from strong undergraduate programs at UNR into a professional program within the same institution.

In addition, Nevada already invests in programs that help pay for veterinary education in exchange for graduates returning to work in the state. While these programs are helpful, they still require students to relocate for several years of schooling, which can make it harder for graduates to establish long-term ties to Nevada. Training veterinarians within the state would make it more likely that they remain here to serve Nevada's communities, agricultural industries, and pet owners.

UNR already has the academic infrastructure, research environment, and student pipeline to support a veterinary program. Establishing a veterinary school would not only expand
