### Comment:

I'm an Assistant Professor of Public Policy at UNLV. Per my recent testimony to the Nevada legislature (see [youtube.com/live/aA1DaTOCveM?si=cd\\_vZl0zvK\\_E9zYH&t=4483](https://www.youtube.com/live/aA1DaTOCveM?si=cd_vZl0zvK_E9zYH&t=4483)) and related commentary to The Guardian (see <https://www.theguardian.com/technology/2026/jun/17/neoliberal-nightmare-my-ride-on-vegas-loop-elon-musk-answer-to-traffic-jams>), it has been found that The Boring Company has been lying to policymakers in Las Vegas, Nashville, and elsewhere around the world about what the Loop can deliver. Specifically, Tesla/Boring Company representatives have told policymakers that The Loop can move more passengers more quickly than standard rail (i.e., metro, light rail), despite this being physically impossible. Among other risks (i.e., Boring Company's numerous OSHA violations), boring a tunnel to UNLV in the form of a Loop stop will forfeit any future possibility (or at the least, complicate it) of a proper metro or light rail for the city, as infrastructure for both compete for the same physical space. Per my conversations with journalists covering the TBC's strong-arming of local governments in Nashville, I have also learned that The Loop is funded private investors whose interests are not building maximally-accessible transport infrastructure, but rather selling Loop design to the highest bidder—for example, real estate investors are among the top Loop investors, who push for Loop stops to be placed most proximately to properties they own, rather than where most people can use them. That tax dollars do not pay for the Loop is marketed as a "deal" to local governments when it in fact represents a raw deal for the government and public. Given the danger to the public posed by TBC's record of repeat OSHA violations and the forfeiture of

physical space that could be used for light rail infrastructure that is actually demanded by the public (see Minja Yan primary victory, on a light rail-centric platform), I strongly oppose the approval of a Loop stop at UNLV.

### Comment:

Those who do not learn from history are doomed to repeat it. The history here is well-documented. In 2025, the Clark County Water Reclamation District (CCWRD) issued Elon Musk's Boring Company a \$493,297.08 fine for dumping "drilling mud, drilling spoils, and miscellaneous solid waste" into manholes around Las Vegas and for feigning compliance while continuing to dump wastewater (a toxic liquid that collects at the bottom of tunnels) into the sewage system. The CCWRD found Musk's company in violation of federal laws and regulations; its subsequent fine owing to "the egregious nature of the violations, the substantial damage to district infrastructure, the district emergency resources expended responding to the Violations, and [Boring Company's] acknowledgement of responsibility for the Violations." An anonymous employee has said that other employees were disposing of the wastewater without first treating it, in spite of directives to do so, indicating a concerning lack of oversight. Furthermore, in September 2025, Nevada's Bureau of Water Pollution Control fined the Boring Company close to \$250,000 for violating environmental regulations nearly 800x since 2023, including for spilling untreated groundwater onto public roads and failure to report the spill to the proper authorities. The company was also issued three violations for exposing foundational pillars of the elevated monorail with Clark County accusing the company of doing work without a permit and creating a potential hazard. On top of all that, the company is under investigation by the Nevada Occupational Safety and Health Administration for incidents involving Boring Company employees being burned by the toxic chemicals in tunnel wastewater. I am a UNLV student, and I urge the board to not let this company receive

another red cent of our tax dollars nor another second of our time. They've proven themselves untrustworthy, negligent, and incompetent over and over again. Spare us this poisonous association.

### **Comment:**

The proposal presented by UNLV Interim President Heavey would authorize a suite of agreements giving The Boring Company construction access to UNLV property, authority to build the station, and operational control of the facility for an initial 50-year term, with the possibility of a second 50-year extension. The agreements also contemplate long-term access rights and operational responsibility for passenger service on campus. A central concern voiced by the community is whether The Boring Company has demonstrated the safety culture necessary for a project that will operate on a university campus used daily by students, employees, and visitors.

Nevada OSHA previously issued serious citations against the company related to tunnel construction activities in Las Vegas. Investigations and reporting regarding The Boring Company's Nevada operations have also raised broader concerns about workplace safety practices. Former employees described numerous injuries, alleged inadequate safety practices, and claimed that production schedules were prioritized over worker safety. Nevada OSHA inspectors issued multiple citations concerning workplace hazards, safety equipment, and training deficiencies. The Regents should therefore ask a straightforward question: if UNLV is being asked to enter into a relationship that could last 50 to 100 years, why rush approval before requiring a stronger safety record and independent monitoring? A prudent alternative would be to defer approval until The Boring Company demonstrates several years of incident-free operations, submits to independent third-party safety audits, publicly discloses OSHA

inspection results, and agrees to enhanced safety oversight by UNLV and NSHE. Until those safeguards are in place, granting a decades-long operational foothold on a university campus would expose students, employees, and the institution itself to unnecessary risk.
