BOARD OF REGENTS BRIEFING PAPER

1. Agenda Item Title: <u>UNLV Request for Approval of Employment Contract for Cody C. Hughes, D.M.D., Assistant Professor-In-Residence (Pediatric Dentistry).</u>

2. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

Cody C. Hughes, D.M.D., has accepted an offer of employment with a salary of \$130,000 as an Assistant Professor-In-Residence (Pediatric Dentistry) in the School of Dental Medicine conditional upon his salary above the range being approved by the Board of Regents. Salaries at hire in excess of the NSHE faculty salary schedule require the approval of the Board of Regents.

3. SPECIFIC ACTIONS BEING RECOMMENDED OR REQUESTED:

President David Ashley requests Board of Regents' approval for the employment salary above schedule for Cody C. Hughes, D.M.D. in the UNLV School of Dental Medicine, as an Assistant Professor-In-Residence (Pediatric Dentistry).

4. IMPETUS (WHY NOW?):

- The UNLV School of Dental Medicine must offer a market-competitive contract in order to recruit strong health sciences and research active faculty.
- Specialty faculties are necessary for accreditation for the School of Dental Medicine.
- Market values require a salary of at least \$130,000 or higher, for this important position.
- Search process has taken 9 months due to limited number of qualified applicants.

5. BULLET POINTS TO SUPPORT REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:

- The appointment of Dr. Hughes will directly support the School of Dental Medicine's required commitment to the pre-doctoral Pediatric Dentistry Program and Pediatric Dental Residency Program.
- Dr. Hughes' education includes, but is not limited to the following;
 - o UNLV School of Dental Medicine, 2007
 - Indiana University School of Dentistry Pediatric Dentistry Residency Program, Riley Hospital for Children, Certificate in Pediatric Dentistry, July 2009 (expected)
 - Indiana University School of Dentistry Pediatric Dentistry Residency Program, Riley Hospital for Children, Master of Science in Dentistry, July 2009 (expected)
 - Extended Orthodontic Courses.
- Dr. Hughes has conducted research at both the UNLV School of Dental Medicine and the Indiana University School of Dentistry.
- Dr. Hughes received numerous leadership awards while a student at the School of Dental Medicine.
- Dr. Hughes Curriculum Vitae attached for reference.
- The NSHE Faculty Salary Schedules are:
 - O Dental Medicine Faculty Assistant Professor (12 Month) \$106,100 Maximum
 - o Medicine M.D. Programs (12 Month) \$184,224 Max. (FY 2007-08 Salary Schedule)
 - Medicine M.D. Specialty (12 Month) \$341,089 Max. (FY 2007-08 Salary Schedule).
- The national average annual salary for a Pediatric Dentist is \$191,000. The range is \$104,000 to \$315,000.
- Current Board policy (at Title 2, Ch 5, Section 4.2) permits extending contract duration beyond twelve months and salary above schedule, if approved by the Board of Regents, upon justification by the institutional president which establishes that the candidate is unlikely to accept employment without an exception to the contract duration in consideration of relevant criteria such as the candidate's extraordinary qualifications and experience, the competitive nature of the field or discipline.

6. POTENTIAL ARGUMENTS AGAINST THE REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:

Approving individual contracts above salary schedule may cause inequity between faculty in the School of Dental Medicine.

7. ALTERNATIVE (S) TO WHAT IS BEING REQUESTED/RECOMMENDED:

The salary is disallowed and the recruitment of high-end specialty faculty is deferred until salary schedule issues are redefined.

Do not hire a Specialist in Pediatric Dentistry for the pre-doctoral program and Pediatric Residency Program, presenting accreditation issues.
