






Early discussions with Faculty Senate identified primary concerns as Advising, Class Rosters and the Gradebook.

Plan vs. Major - some institutions are planning on replacing the word "major" in their publications and communications with students, to make sure when the student goes into self service they will be familiar with the terminology they will see. However, some institutions are not planning on changing their wording because it is a nationally recognized word and they think that it would confuse the student NOT to use "major". Faculty should become familiar with their institution's philosophy.



- The Faculty Senate can play a role in this governance by participating on key design reviews and focus groups




