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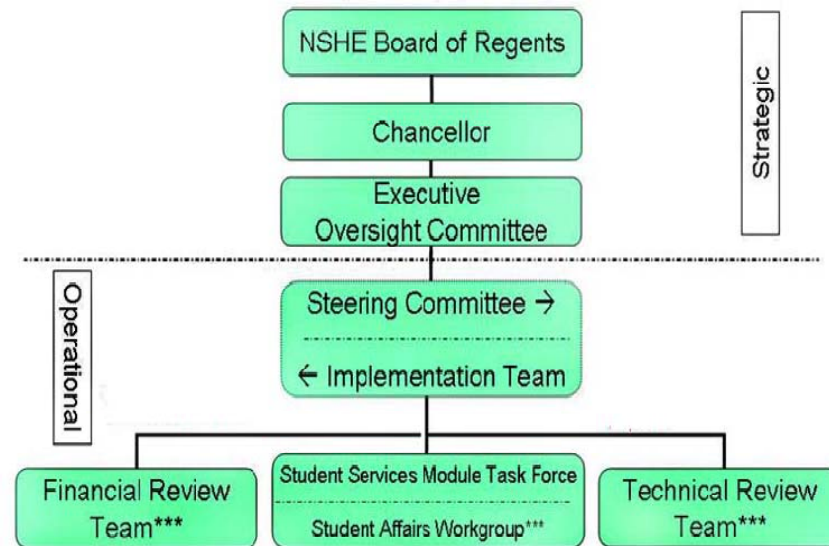
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- Governance – iNtegrate operates using a governance structure that utilizes existing governance structures to get its work done and to make decisions
- The Faculty Senate can play a role in this governance by participating on key design reviews and focus groups



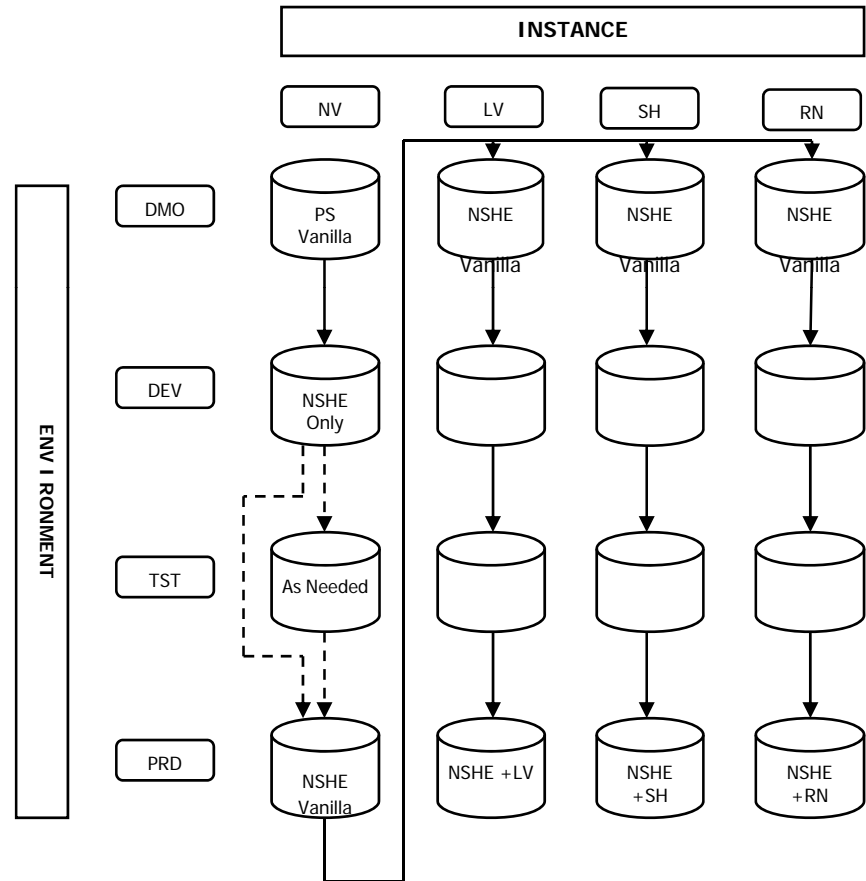
