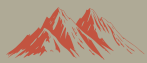

**Expanding true affordability and opportunity for every Nevada student.
We believe higher education should be accessible regardless of background or
institution.**

Key priorities:



Advocate during the Nevada Legislative Session for increased higher education investment, including stronger NSHE funding



Advocate for expansion of the Millennium Scholarship and support opt-in scholarship expansion programs for Nevada students



Protect and strengthen student access funds across all campuses



Push for transparent and fair student fee structures, including unnecessary fee reduction and accountability



Advocate for improved transportation access through stronger RTC partnerships in Southern Nevada



Advocate for affordable and stable student housing across Nevada institutions




Advocate for ADA Advocacy and deferred maintenance funds to improve accessibility

COMMUNITY

Building a safer, more connected, and more supported student experience across Nevada.

We will strengthen collaboration and improve the day-to-day student experience statewide.

Key priorities:

-  Expand statewide collaboration between student governments and campuses
 - Focus on a statewide project to fundraise and advocate for
-  Improve campus safety through better lighting, infrastructure, and coordinated safety personnel through advocacy
-  Strengthen regional student engagement and campus life programming across NSHE institutions
 - Expand access to essential services, including:
 - Immigration and legal support resources
 - Mental health services
 - Basic needs programs
-  Improve communication and unity between student governments statewide

TRUST

Ensuring accountability, transparency, and effective governance in higher education leadership. Students deserve a system that is transparent, responsive, and accountable.

Key priorities:



Institutionalize regular NSA leadership meetings



Strengthen student voice during Board of Regents processes, including continued direct questioning and advocacy at meetings



Expand NSA transparency through formal communications structures, including:

- An official NSA Communications Coordinator role (Non-SBP)
- A consistent public-facing NSA presence (e.g., Instagram + updates)



Advocate for NSHE advanced discussions with NSA regarding potential fee proposals in advance to ensure responsible use of student dollars, as well as the fiscal state of the system




Build trust through consistent reporting of outcomes from resolutions and advocacy efforts on our campuses

COMMITTEES

Implement a committee structure that fosters collaboration across Nevada student governments. Committees will be advisory only, ensuring that all decisions remain with the full Nevada Student Alliance

 Members may participate directly or designate a representative, respecting the demands of each student government


 Committees will meet as needed, with most work occurring between monthly NSA meetings to maintain efficiency (1 to 2 if necessary)

- This structure will allow NSA to act continuously, rather than only during monthly meetings


 By organizing our work around key priorities, Access, Community, and Trust, these committees will:

- Advance legislative advocacy during session
- Develop solutions to affordability, safety, and student life challenges
- Strengthen coordination with the Board of Regents and NSHE leadership
- Keep our student governments aligned when necessary
- Meet with NSHE and Institutional Leadership to enhance student government input and oversight


Student Affordability & Access Committee (Access):

- 
- Focuses on tuition, fees, financial aid, and State Scholarships like the Millennium, developing solutions to improve college affordability across Nevada for all institutions.










Student Life & Campus Safety Committee (Community):

- 
- Addresses student experience issues including housing, campus safety, facilities, and overall student well-being for all institutions.

Legislative and System Affairs Committee (Trust):

- 
- Coordinates statewide advocacy during the legislative session, tracks key bills, and organizes student engagement to advance NSA priorities during session. St Also ensures alignment between resolutions and real policy outcomes.
