## 3. TASK FORCE ON POWER-BASED VIOLENCE <u>INFORMATION ONLY</u> AT INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION AVAILABLE APPOINTMENT

Director of Policy Terina Caserto will discuss NRS 396.141 and its creation of the Task Force on Power Based Violence at Institutions of Higher Education. Pursuant to NRS 396.141(1)(c), the Task Force on Power Based Violence at Institutions of Higher Education includes fourteen members appointed by the Board of Regents, including the following:

- "...(5) One student, appointed in consultation with the Nevada Student Alliance or its successor organization, who represents a group or organization that focuses on multiculturalism, diversity or advocacy at a state college or community college; [and]
- (6) One student, appointed in consultation with the Nevada Student Alliance or its successor organization, who represents a group or organization that focuses on multiculturalism, diversity or advocacy at a university..."

The Task Force will have openings that need to be appointed for one student member from either UNR or UNLV. Terina will discuss the process and timeline of how a recommendation will be made at a future meeting.
