The Committee may take action based on the report and recommendations, including making recommendations to the Board to change the asset allocation, fund managers and/or strategic ranges for the pooled funds.

**5.       OUTSOURCED CHIEF INVESTMENT                               FOR POSSIBLE ACTION**  
**OFFICER SELECTION**

The Committee will review the recommendations from the Vice Chancellor for Finance, Vic Redding, and the RFP Evaluation Committee regarding selection of one or more Outsourced Chief Investment Officer(s) (OCIO) to manage the System's Operating and/or Endowment Funds upon expiration of the current contract for advisory services on September 30, 2016. The following bidders may be discussed and/or may provide a presentation relating to their bid:

- Cambridge Associates
- Russell Investments

The Committee may recommend the Vice Chancellor for Finance to enter into contract negotiations with one or more bidders for OCIO services, and may recommend the Chancellor be authorized, after consultation with the Committee Chair and review by the Vice Chancellor for Legal Affairs, the authority to enter into one or more agreements for OCIO services for all, or a portion, of the Operating and/or Endowment Funds; or any other related action.
