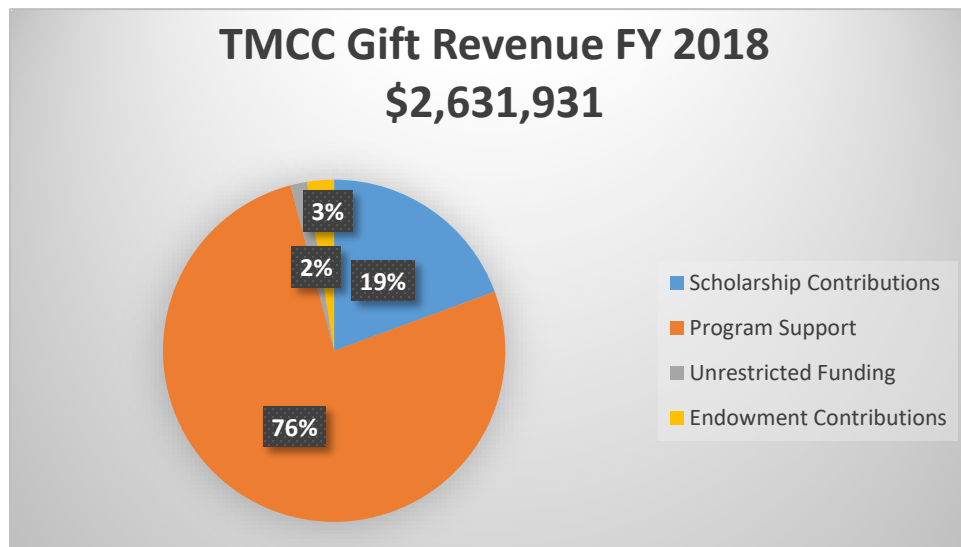

Mission of the TMCC Foundation

The Truckee Meadows Community College Foundation was incorporated in 1982 to solicit, receive and manage funds for the benefit of the College. Funds received by the Foundation are used to aid, support and assist in the maintenance, promotion, growth and improvement of the College, its affiliates, faculty, staff, students and facilities.

Gift Report

The Foundation had another successful year of fundraising for the year ending June 30, 2018 (FY18). A total of \$2,571,933 was raised through 520 gifts of cash and stock from 390 individuals, corporations and foundations. An additional \$59,998 of gifts-in-kind were raised bringing the total raised to \$2,631,931. See pages 4-6 for a listing of contributions.



During fiscal year 2018, the TMCC Foundation was instrumental in a number of college achievements:

- **Renovations**

Thanks to support from the William N. Pennington Foundation through a grant of \$1,640,122.00, renovations to TMCC's Dental programs at the Dandini Campus are underway. The first part of the project includes moving the Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) Program from the Dandini Campus to the Meadowood Center, which was completed in early October. The next phase

includes the renovation of the Dental Clinic at Dandini that will provide an expansion of the Dental Assisting and Dental Hygiene programs along with a new dedicated clinic for the Adopt a Vet Dental (AAVD) program. AAVD is a non-profit organization in our community that TMCC dental programs partner with to provide free dental services for veterans in our community and valuable training opportunities for our students. The final phase of the project includes a new Anatomy and Physiology Lab at the Dandini campus. The entire project will be completed by summer 2019.

- **Scholarship Support**



Jacobs Presidential Scholars Reception – April 28, 2018

The Foundation continues to make scholarship support for our students a top priority. In FY 2018, the Foundation raised \$576,905 in support of annual scholarships and endowments. Actual scholarships awarded in FY 2018 totaled \$734,984, which is another record year for the Foundation. A total of 696 scholarship awards were distributed to 558 students, which is a 20% increase in the number of students who were awarded from the previous year.

Each October, the Foundation holds a Legacy Scholarship Reception to honor scholarship donors and recipients. At the October reception, more than 400 students were recognized for their achievements and many had the opportunity to meet the donor of the scholarship they received.

In April 2018, we held our second scholarship reception at the William N. Pennington Applied Technology Center for students in the Jacobs Presidential Scholars Program (JPS). Thirty-nine students attended the Saturday reception that honored the Maxine S. Jacobs Foundation and the recipients of the Jacobs scholarship. The JPS Program began in 2013 and supports unemployed or underemployed non-traditional adult learners who are in need of learning or upgrading their job skills in order to gain or enhance their employment. The purpose of this program is to increase college and work readiness of the participants and lay a foundation for future success. Thanks to the generous support of the Herb and Maxine Jacobs Foundation, the program is able to provide staff to assist with wrap around services to participants, including one-on-one success coaching and job preparation and career development assistance.

- **Endowments**

As of June 30, 2018, the value of TMCC's 128 endowments totaled \$11,115,348. During fiscal year 2018, three new endowments were established and donations to the endowment totaled \$66,608.00.

New Initiatives:

- **1971 Society**

A new leadership giving initiative was created last fall, the *1971 Society*. The Society is based on the year that TMCC became a Community College. Donors to the Society provide an investment that allows TMCC to meet and exceed our high standards in academic excellence, access to lifelong learning, student success and stewardship of resources. Currently, there are 23 members of the Society with donations ranging from a minimum of \$500 to \$5,000.

Financial Review:

The Foundation continued to retain the services of Pangborn & Co., Ltd. to perform an independent audit for the year ending June 30, 2018. We are pleased to note that the review produced a positive management letter with no major exceptions noted.

Foundation Board of Trustee Candidates:

The Foundation continues to cultivate board members who are strong advocates for TMCC and who provide excellent input and support for both the Foundation and College.
