1. AGENDA ITEM TITLE: <u>HANDBOOK</u> Revision, Deletion of Organizational Units MEETING DATE: <u>December 5-6 Meeting</u>
2. BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:
Existing Board policy requires Board approval of certain program and organization unit proposals under <i>Title 4</i> , <i>Chapter 14</i> , <i>Section 7</i> . At the request of the Council of Presidents, the Board amended <i>Title 4</i> , <i>Chapter 14</i> , <i>Section 7</i> during its November 29-30, 2018 meeting. The approved revision provides that internal administrative changes, including the addition or deletion of a department, do not require Board approval. The revision also included the addition of definitions of organizational units, including center, institute, college, department and school. Lastly, the revision clarified that agreements with non-NSHE degree-granting higher education institutions that do not meet the requirements for review currently outlined in Board policy do not require submission to the Chancellor and Board of Regents for review and approval.
Upon review, it was determined that <i>Title 4</i> , <i>Chapter 14</i> , <i>Section 11</i> was inadvertently not revised when the original proposal was approved.
3. SPECIFIC ACTIONS BEING RECOMMENDED OR REQUESTED:
Amend <i>Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 11</i> to bring into alignment with the amended <i>Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 7</i> , which provides that internal administrative changes, including the addition or deletion of a department, do not require Board approval.
4. IMPETUS (WHY NOW?):
Review of <i>Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 7</i> and <i>Section 11</i> resulted in the finding of a discrepancy in policy. <i>Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 7</i> was amended with an oversight to <i>Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 11</i> . The two sections are parallel and should have been revised at the same time.
 5. POLICY PROPOSAL TITLE 4, CHAPTER 14, SECTION 11 Deletion of Organizational Units

Additions appear in *boldface italics*; deletions are [stricken and bracketed]

Section 11. <u>Deletion of Degrees, Majors, Programs, [Departments,] Schools, Colleges, Centers or</u> Institutes

- 1. It is the policy of the Board of Regents that the deletion of any degree, major, program, [department], school or college, center, institute or other [structural] organizational units must be approved by the Board of Regents if the Board's approval was required for its implementation in accordance with Title 4, Chapter 14, Section 7. Internal administrative changes, including but not limited to the elimination of departments, do not require approval by the Board of Regents.
 - a. Proposals for deletions, other than those internal administrative changes as specified above, will be forwarded to the Office of Academic and Student Affairs in the Chancellor's Office prior to the Board of Regents' meeting to allow for review by the Academic Affairs Council, which will submit recommendations to the Chancellor for action by the Board of Regents.
 - b. The format for proposed deletions shall be provided by the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs.
- 2. The Board of regents shall have the power to terminate or delete any degree program, major, department, school, or college, and shall consult with the appropriate President before such termination (B/R 10/01)
