


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


TMCC: A Comprehensive Community College


Advising

- Transfer degree-seekers comprise 77% of our student body
- University Transfer degrees comprise **72% of degrees** we award.
- **63% of students** earning a transfer degree at TMCC transfer to another institution to continue their education.
- Example of transfer majors: Engineering, Fine Arts, Psychology






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Fall Enrollment



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High School Outreach & Dual Enrollment


- Over the last five years, TMCC has experienced a 600% increase in high school students taking dual-enrollment courses
- TMCC is home to TMCC HS in partnership with WCSD (N= 233)
- **31%** of high school students enrolled in a dual-enrollment program while in high school continue at TMCC after high school graduation
- High School seniors receiving awards from TMCC has increased from **12 to 76** in the last five years
- TMCC serves 60 high schools; 33 in Washoe County, 19 in other Nevada areas and 4 out of state








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
IPEDS 150% Graduation Rate



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
IPEDS 150% Graduation Rate with Peer Comparisons



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Students Receiving Degrees and Certificates




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
Students Receiving Degrees or Certificates with Peer Comparisons 2018-19

Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates (Full-Time)



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Fall-to-Fall Retention Rates (Part-Time)




Fall Enrollment by Ethnicity



- Characterizing the **microbiome of the Truckee River**


In the last 3 years, TMCC has received **\$1,276,580 in grants** to support undergraduate research.
