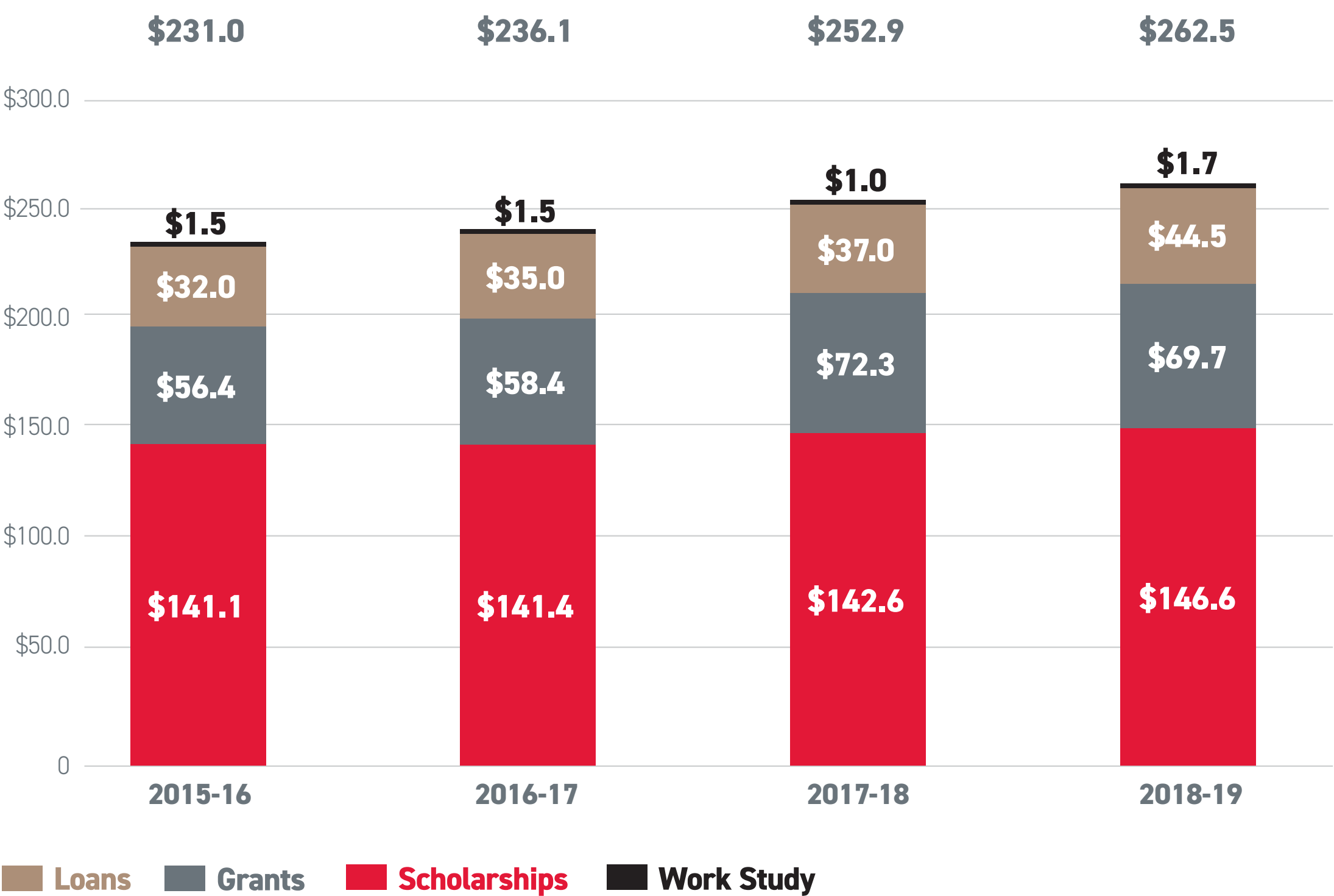

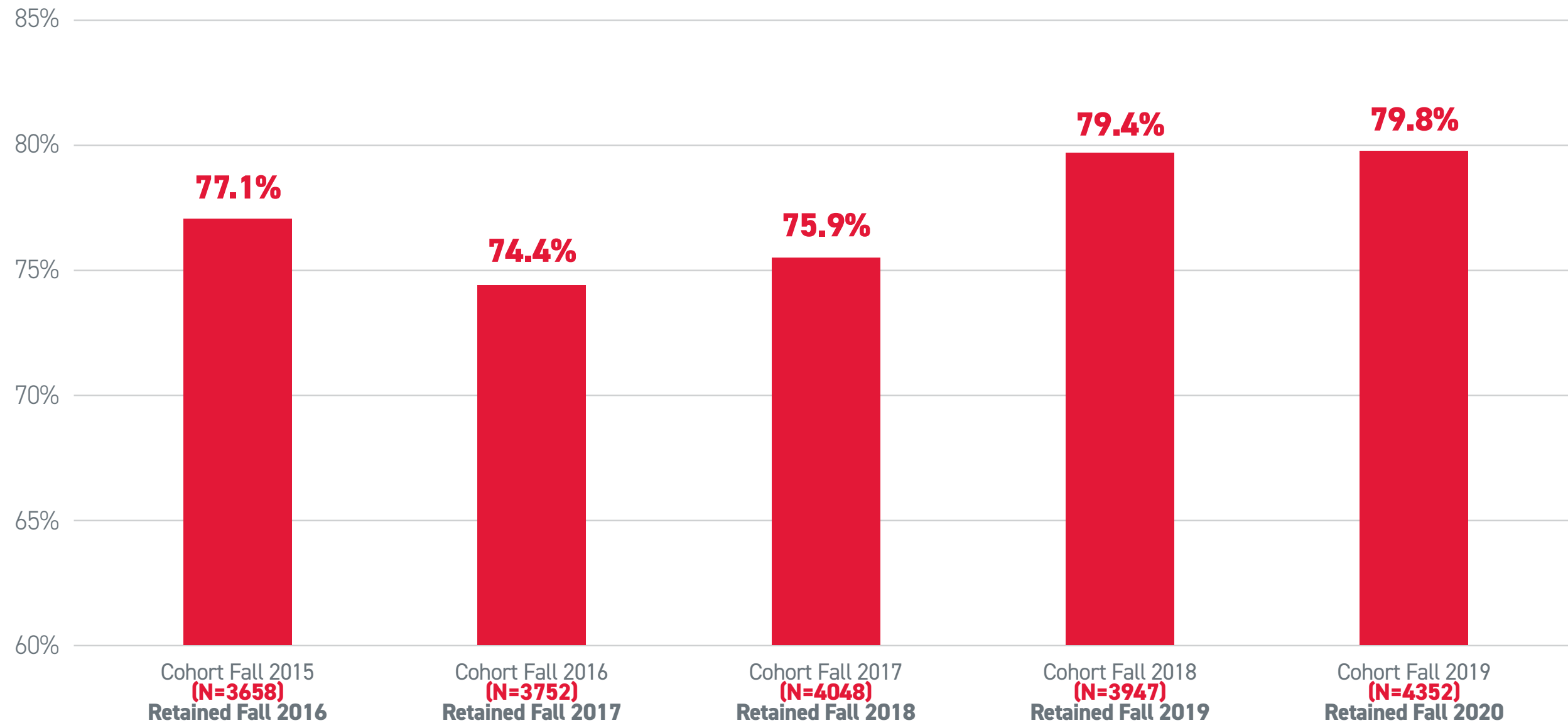

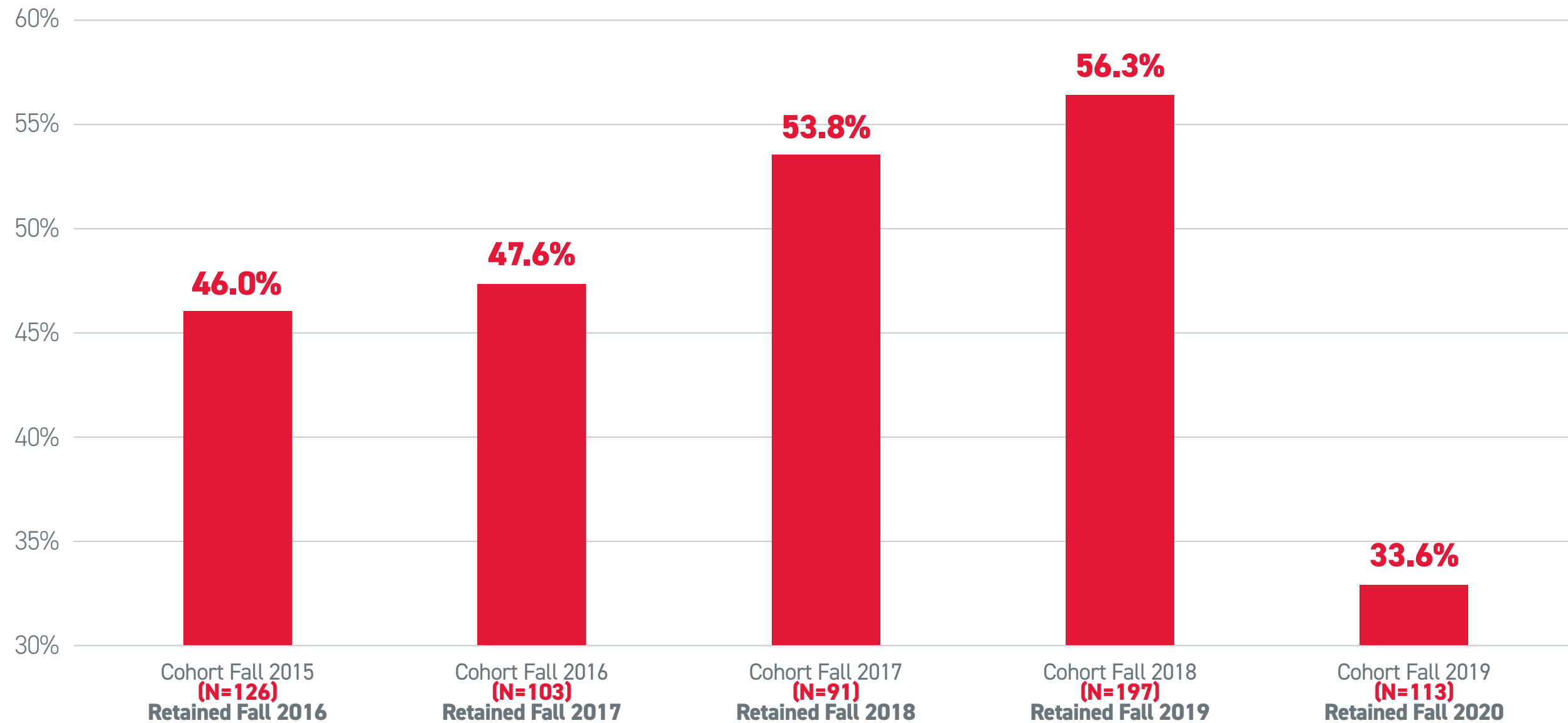

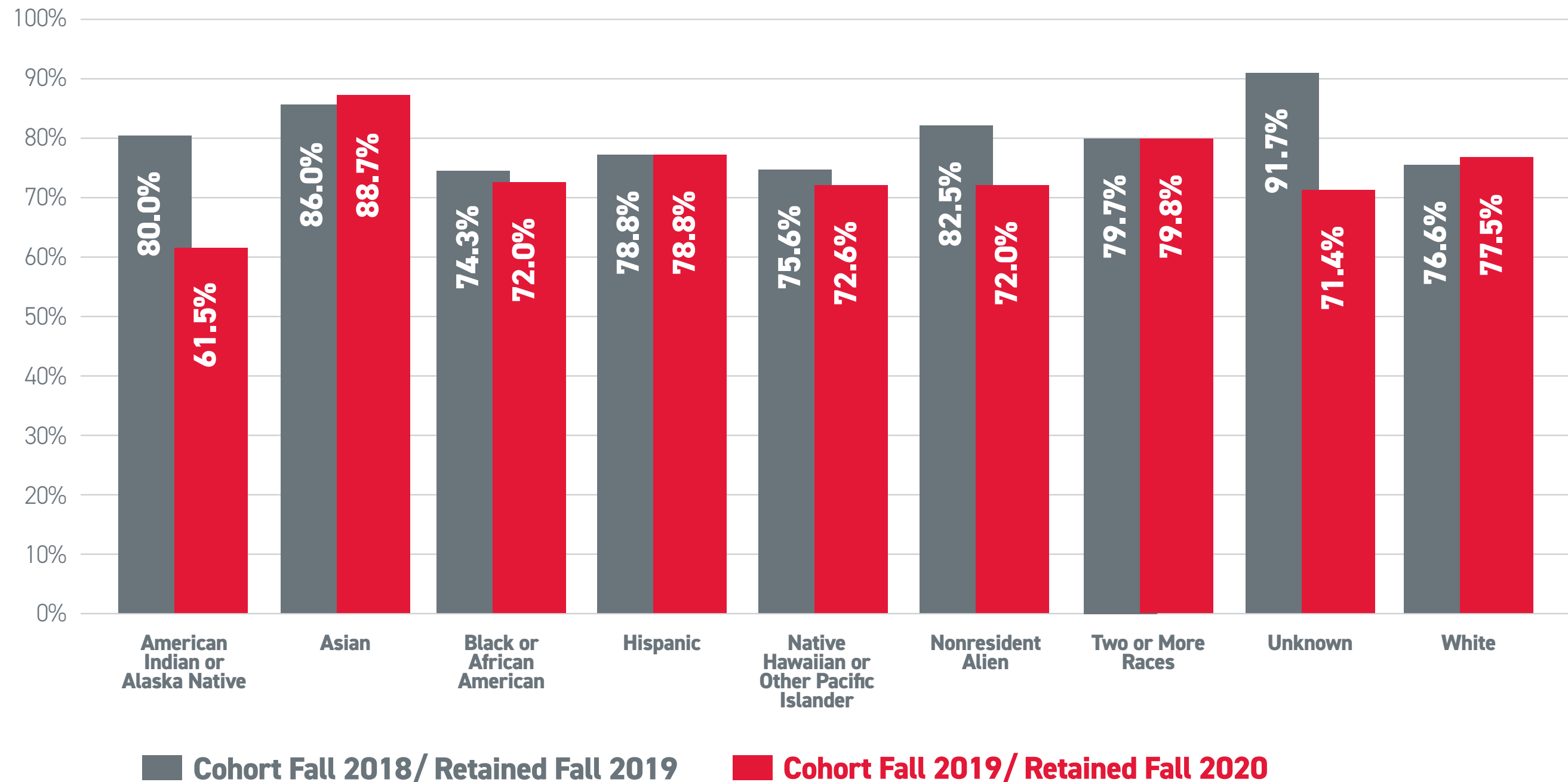

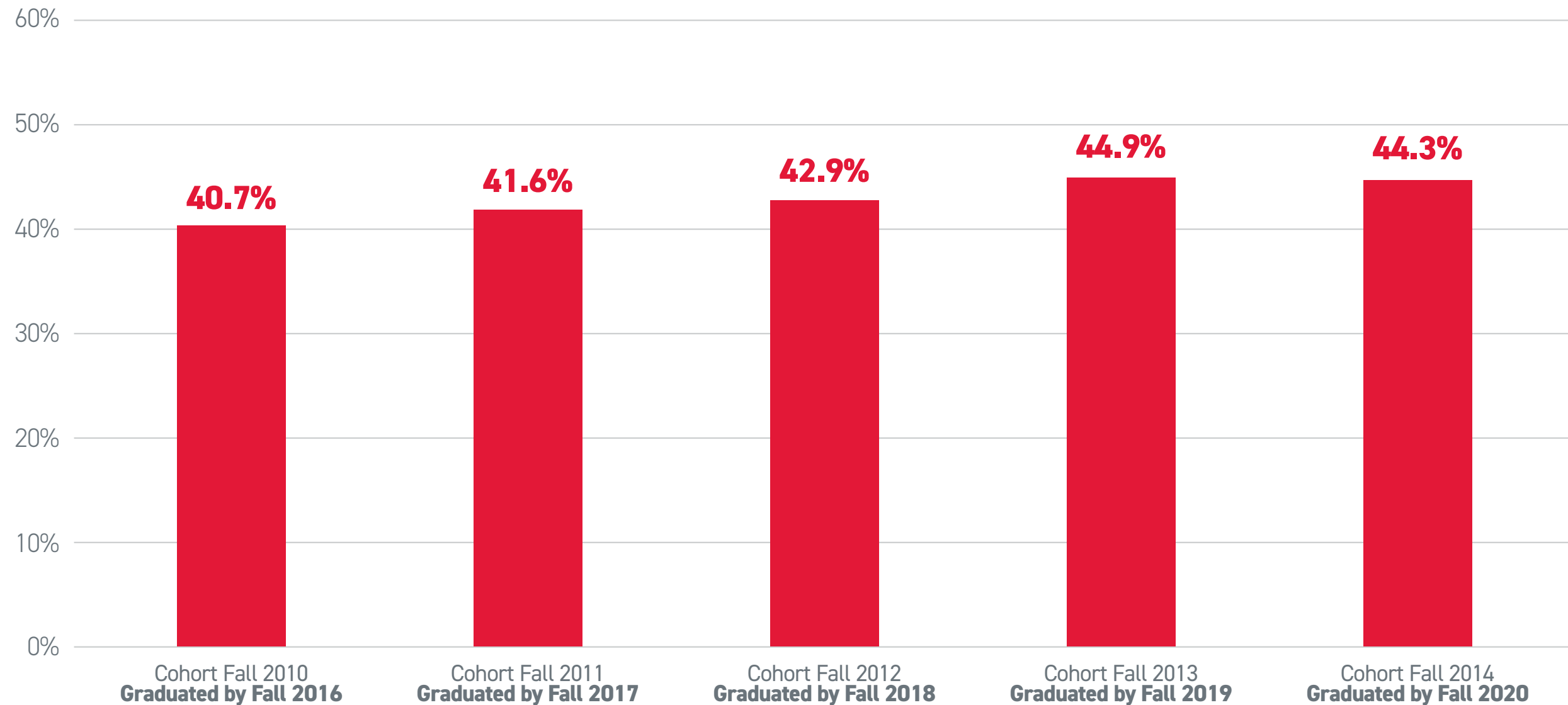

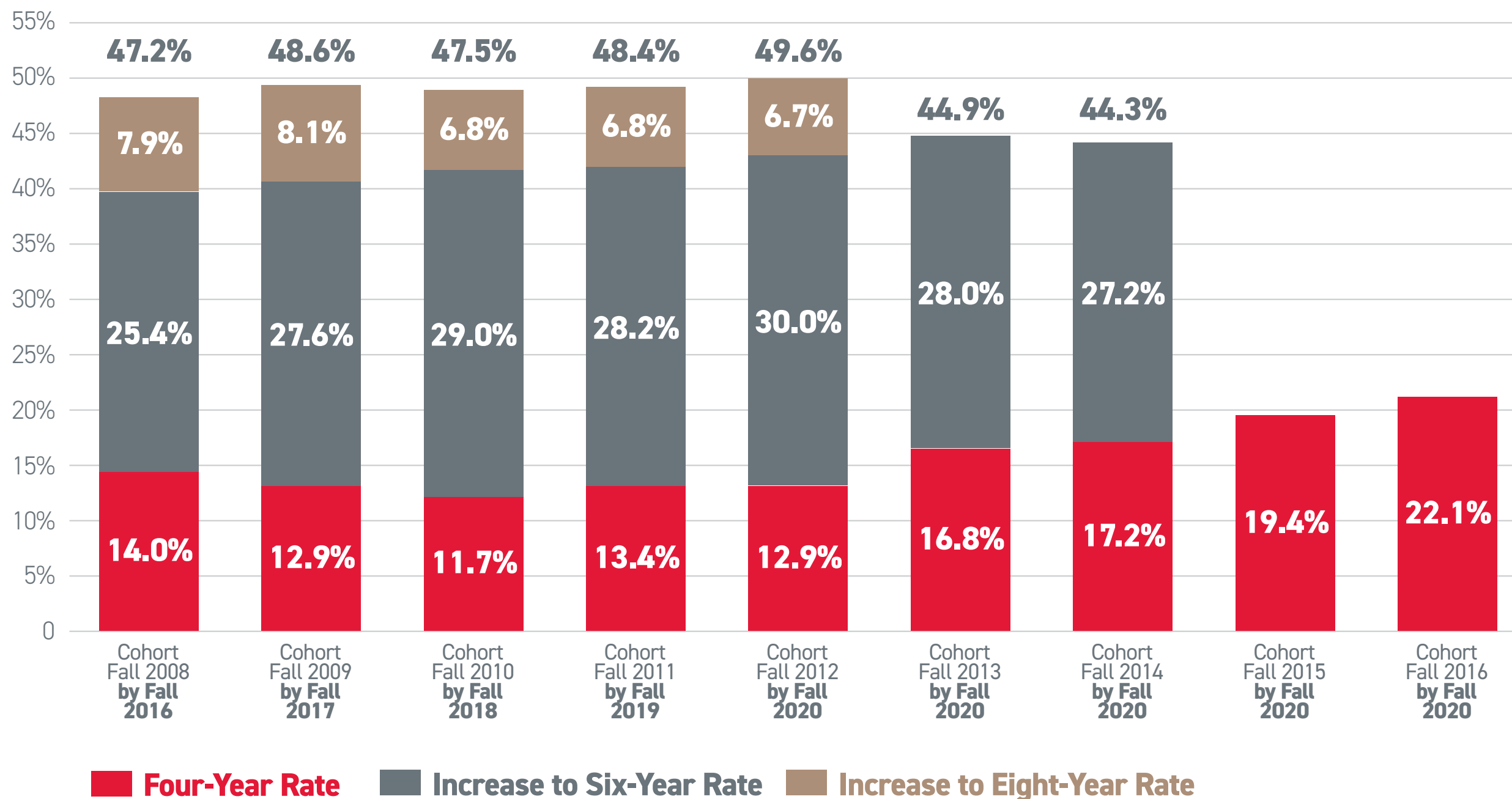

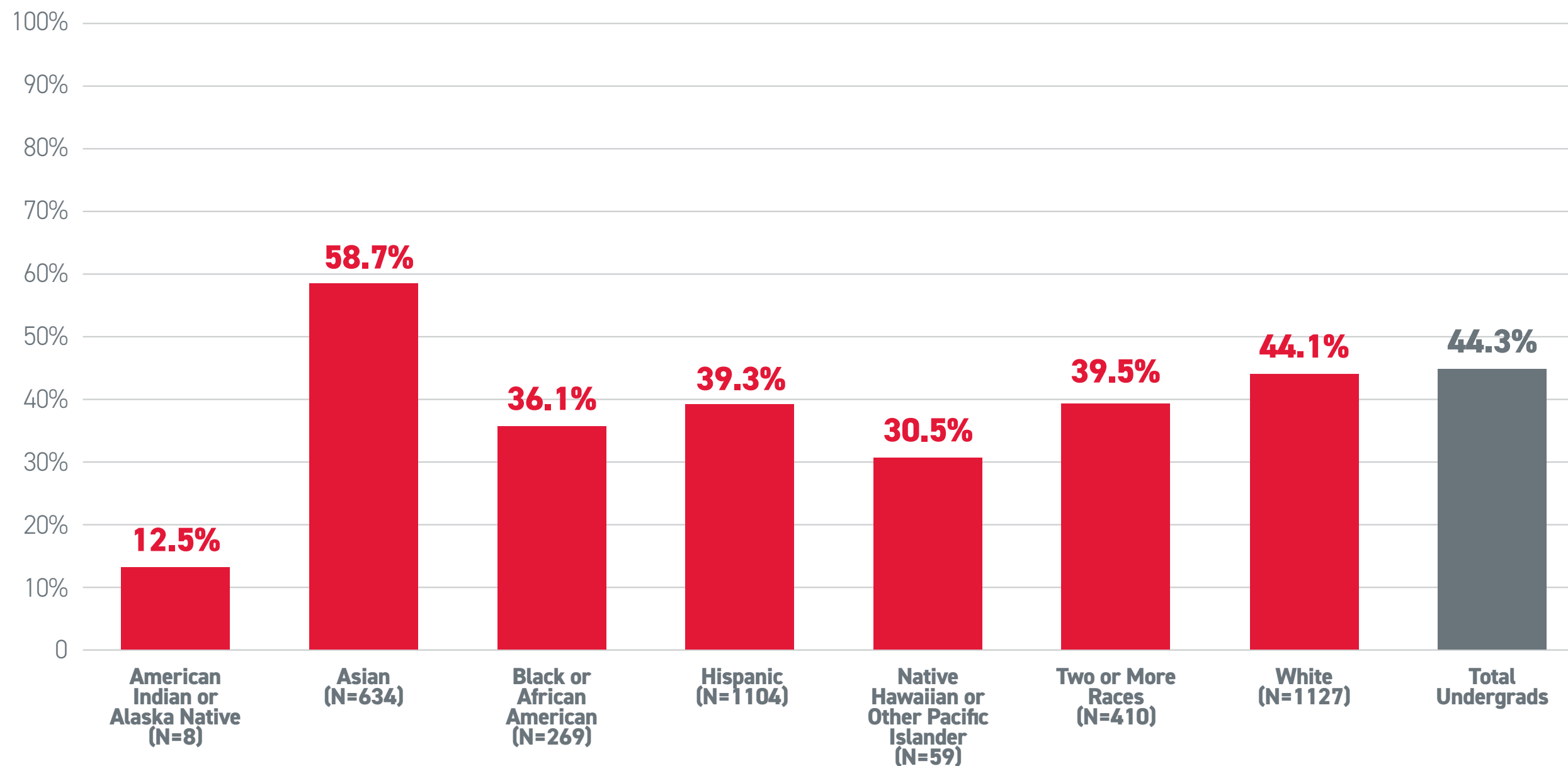

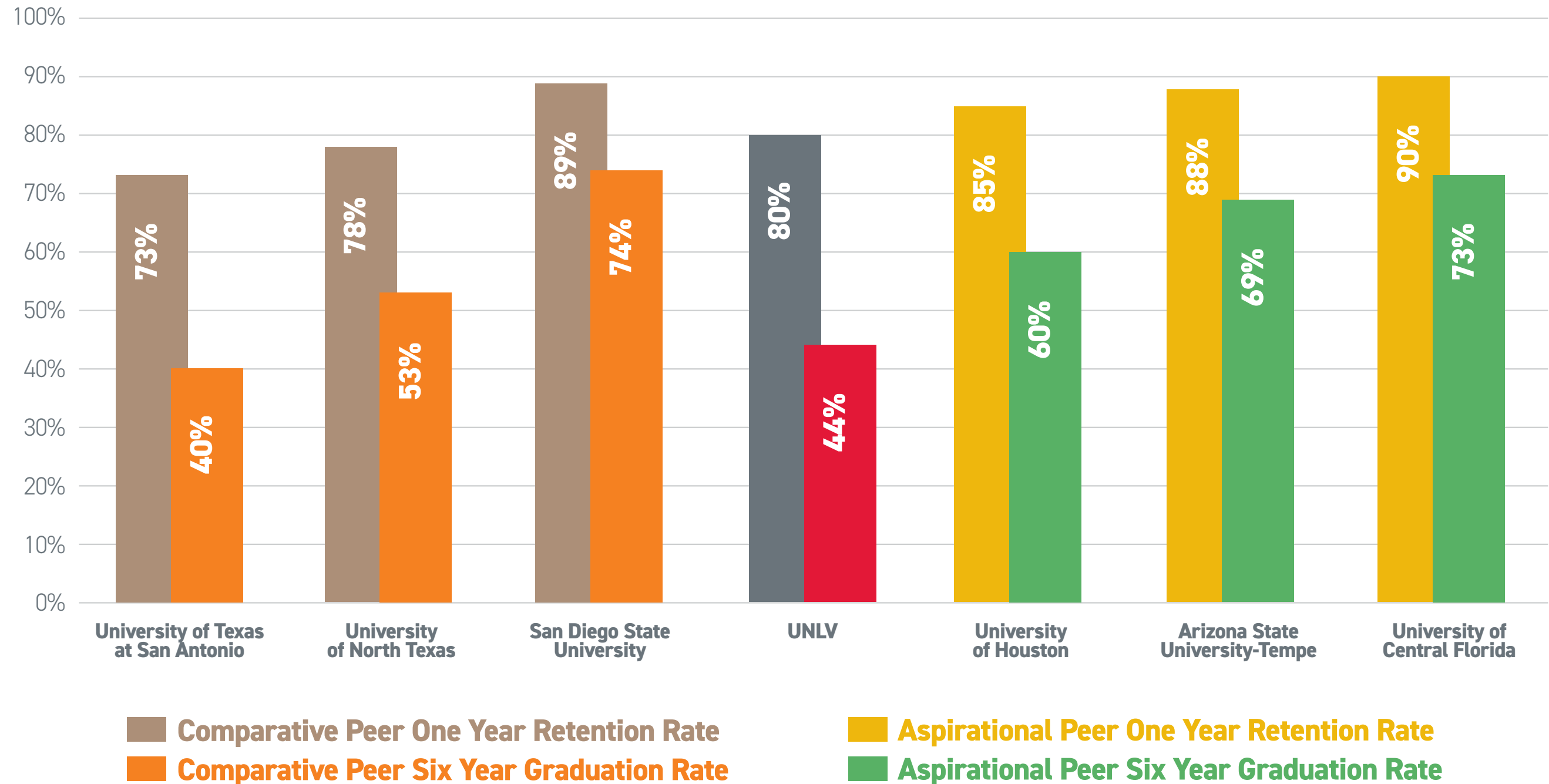

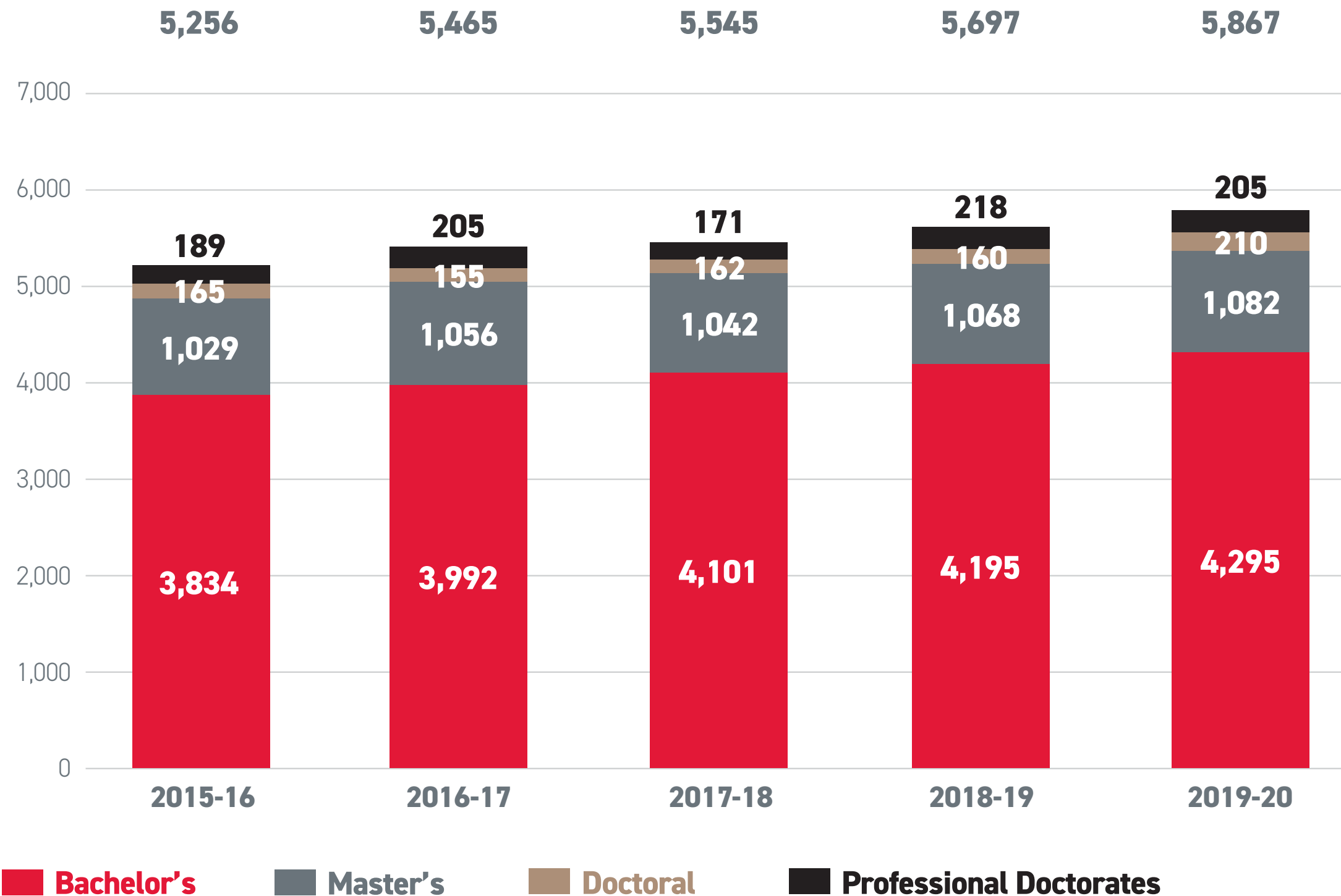

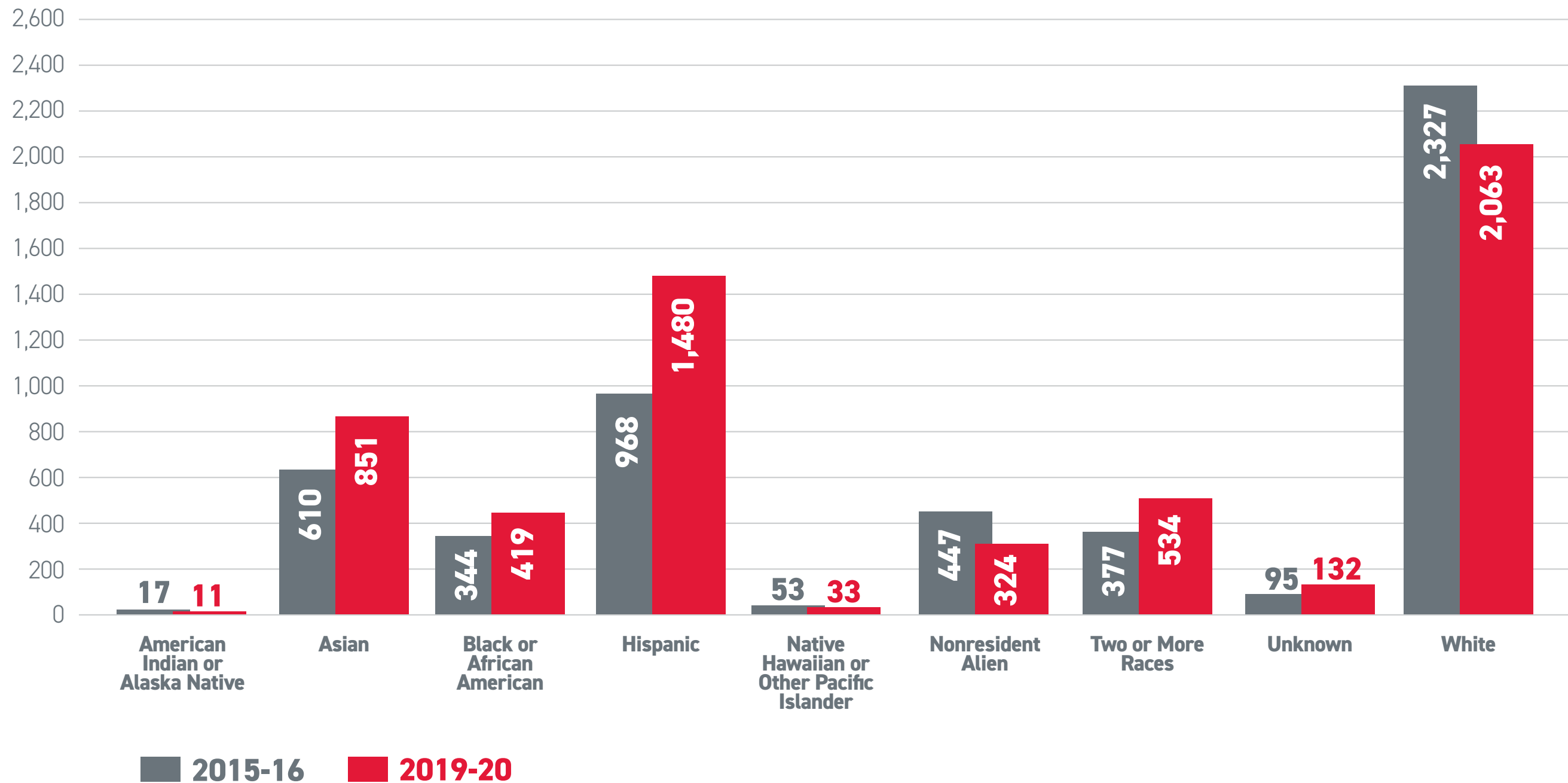

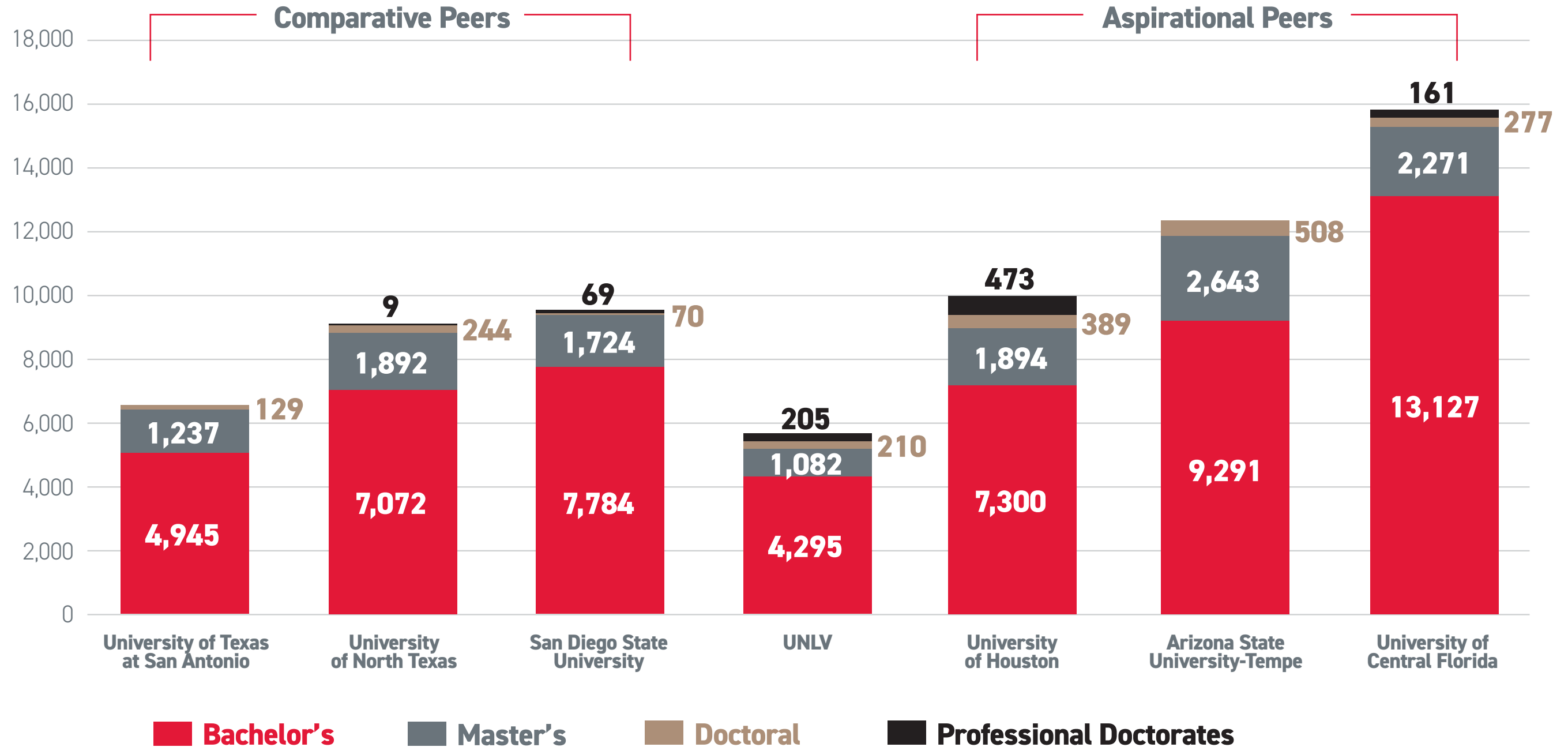

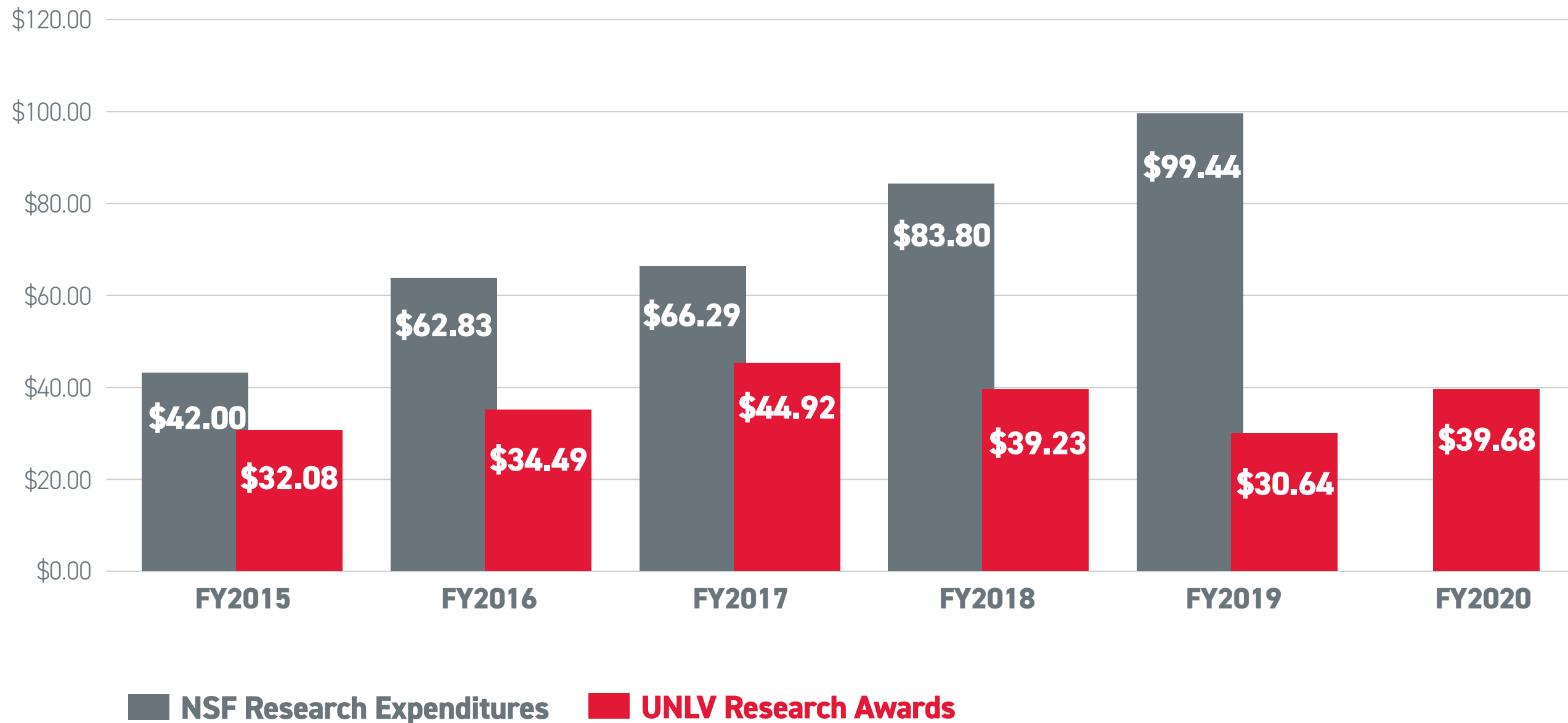

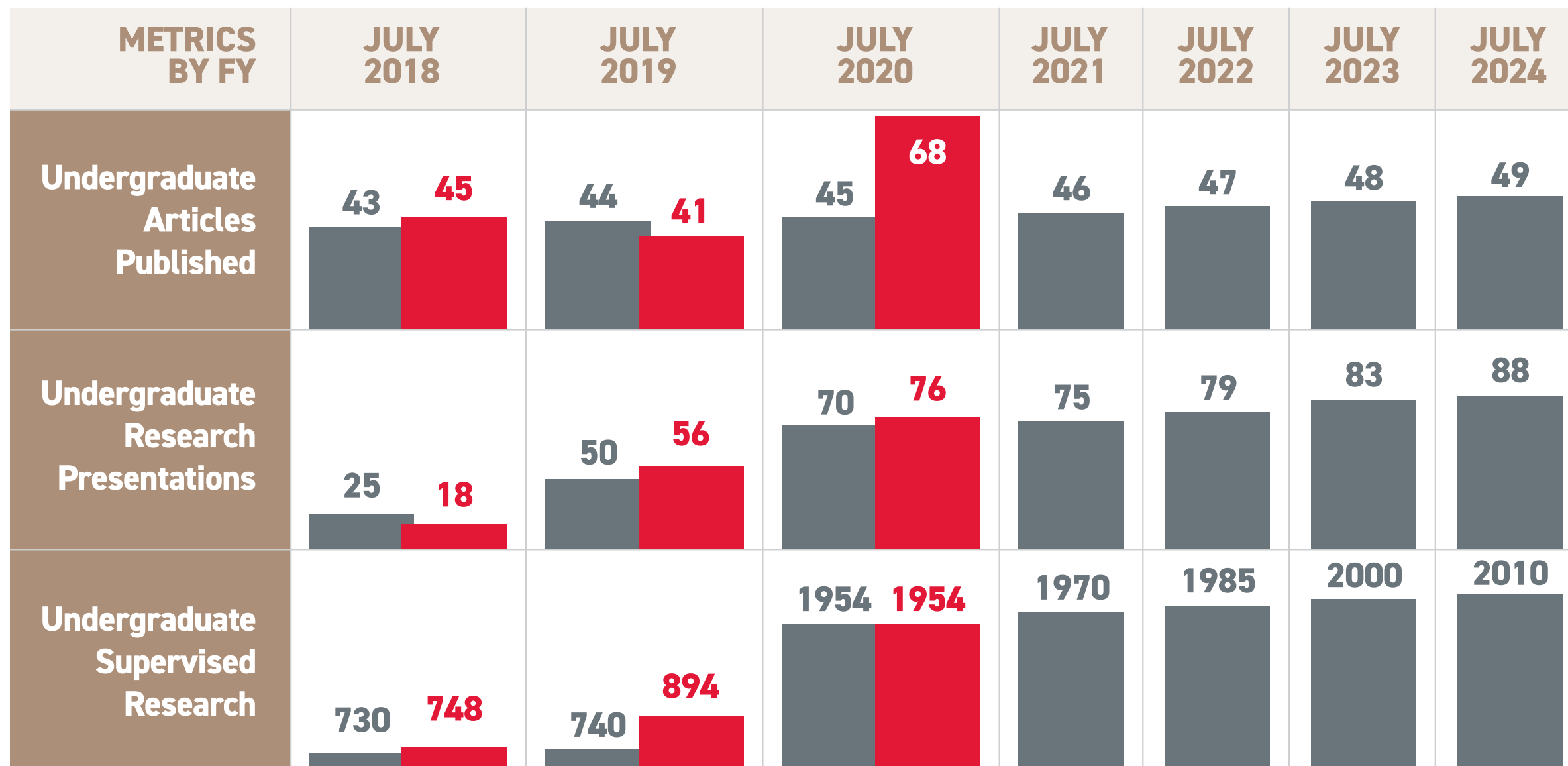
RESEARCH EXPENDITURES and AWARDS

in Millions of Dollars

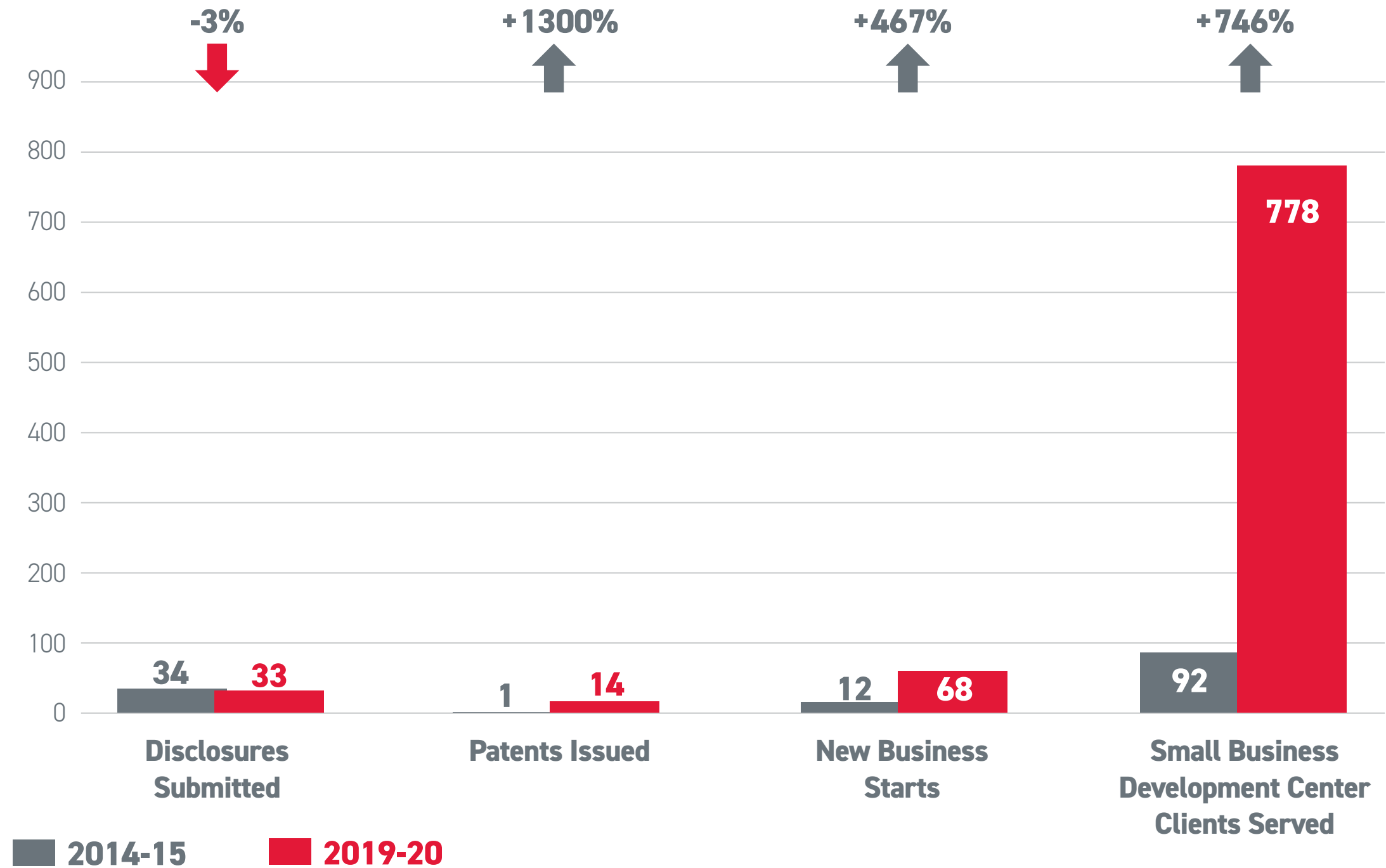

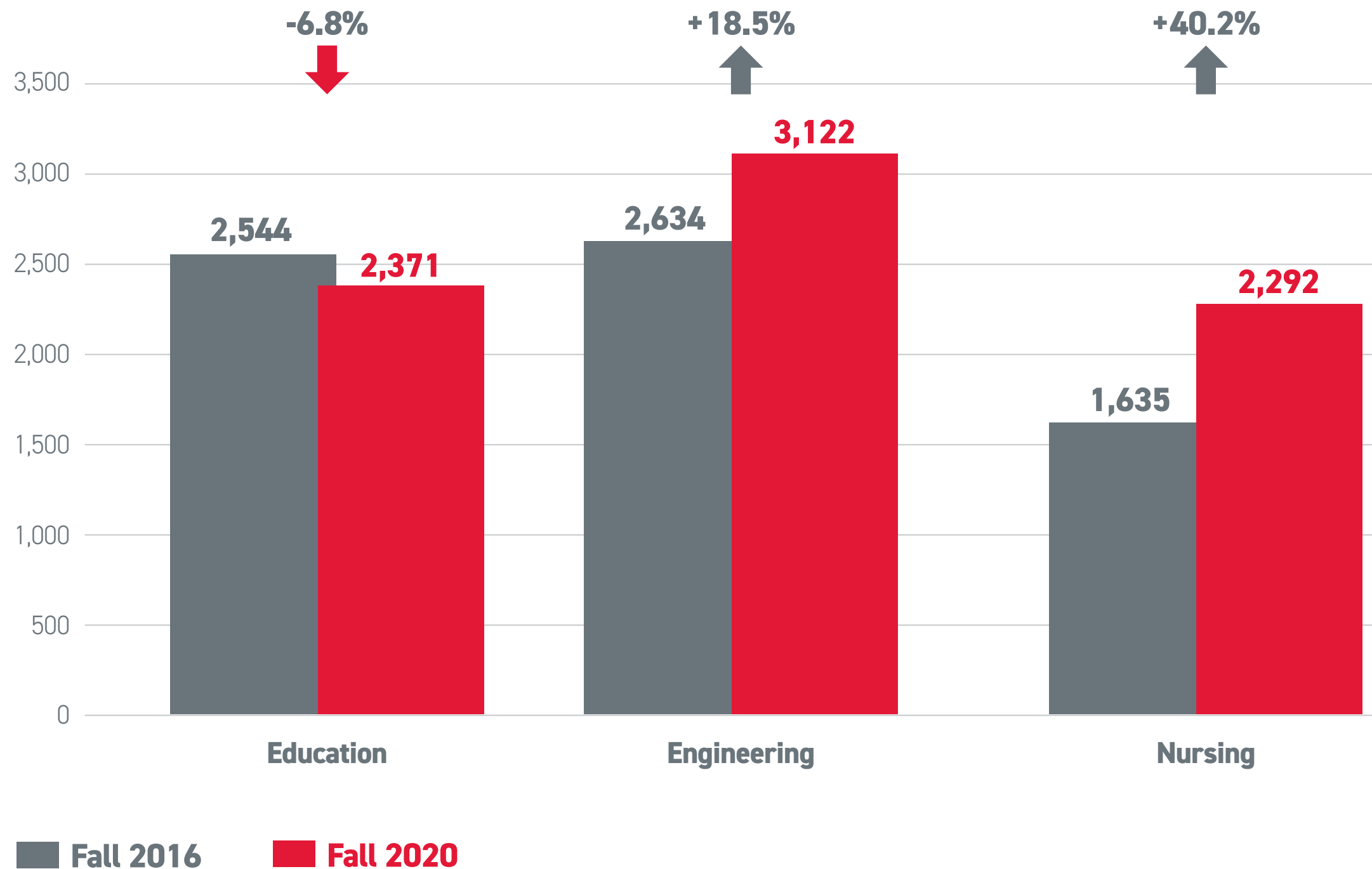

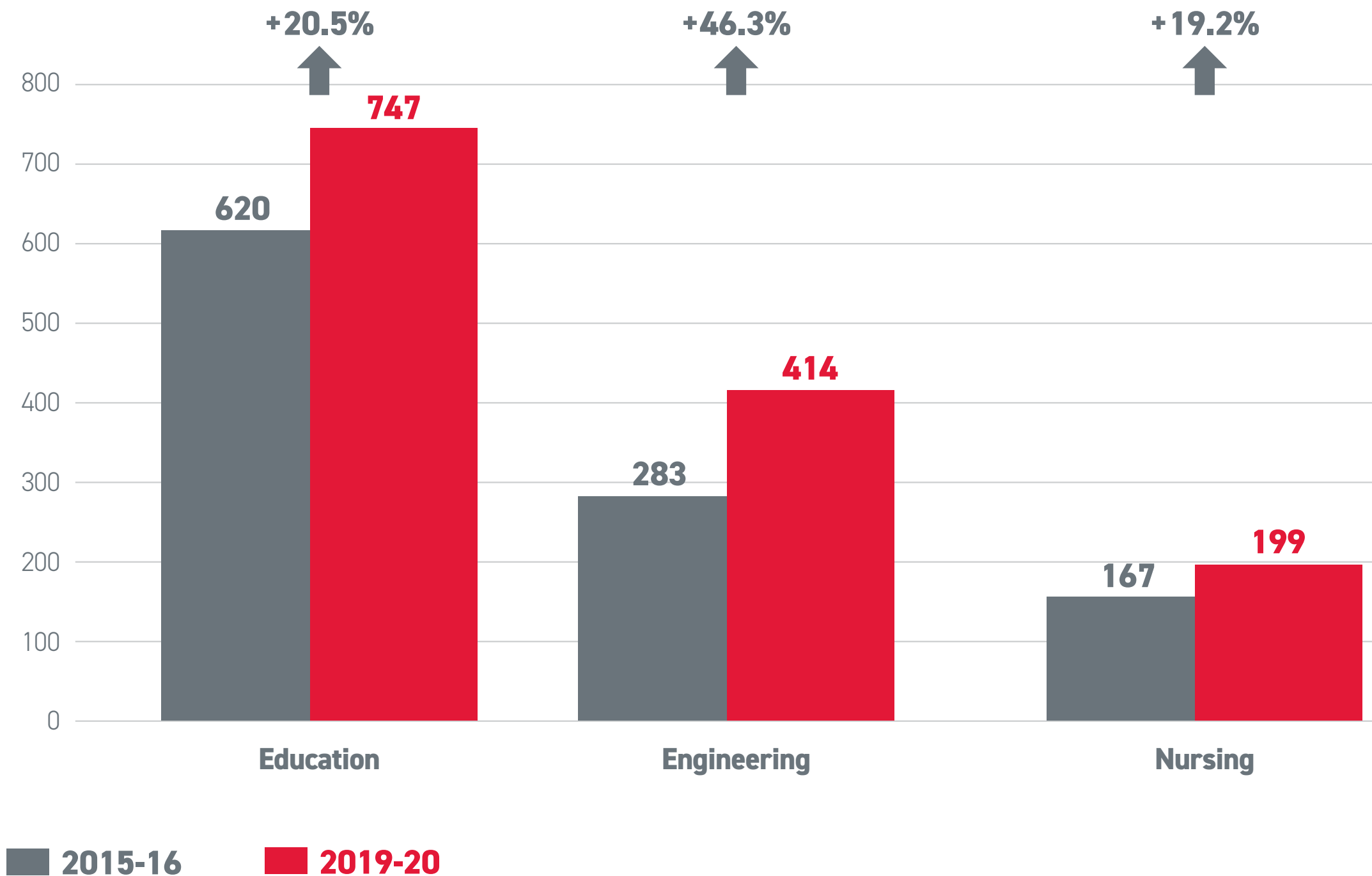

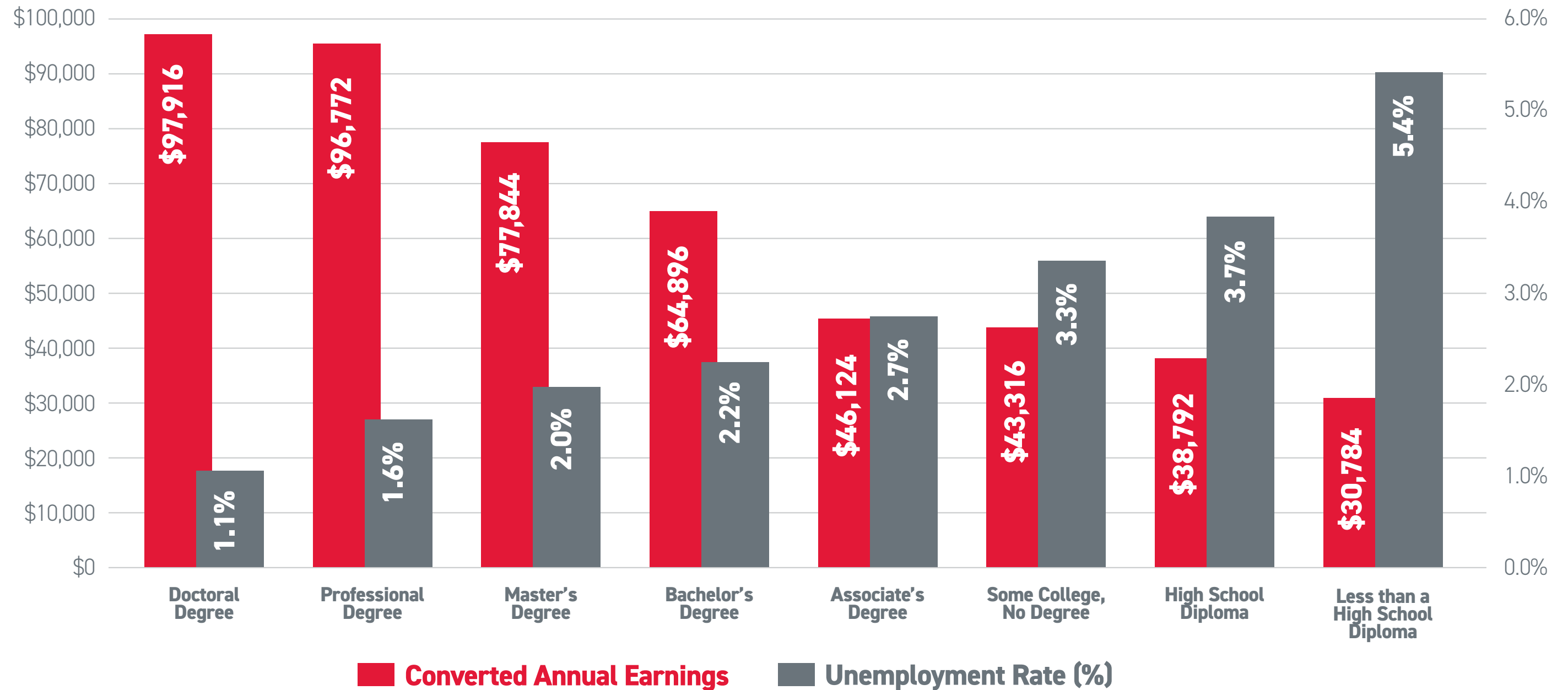

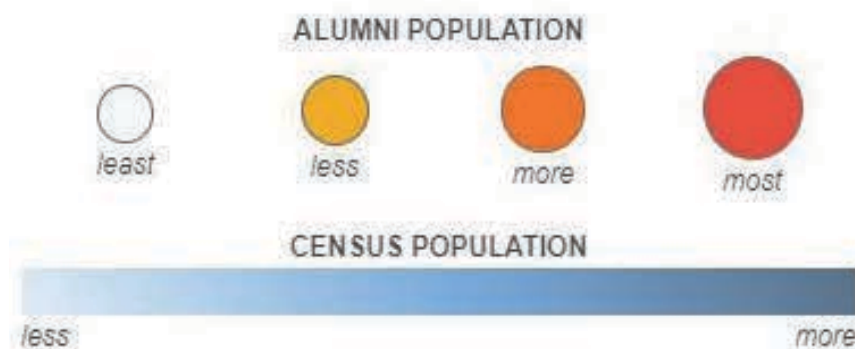
Percent of 18 to 64 year olds who have attained a bachelor's degree or higher in NV is 20%, ranked next to last out of all states and D.C.

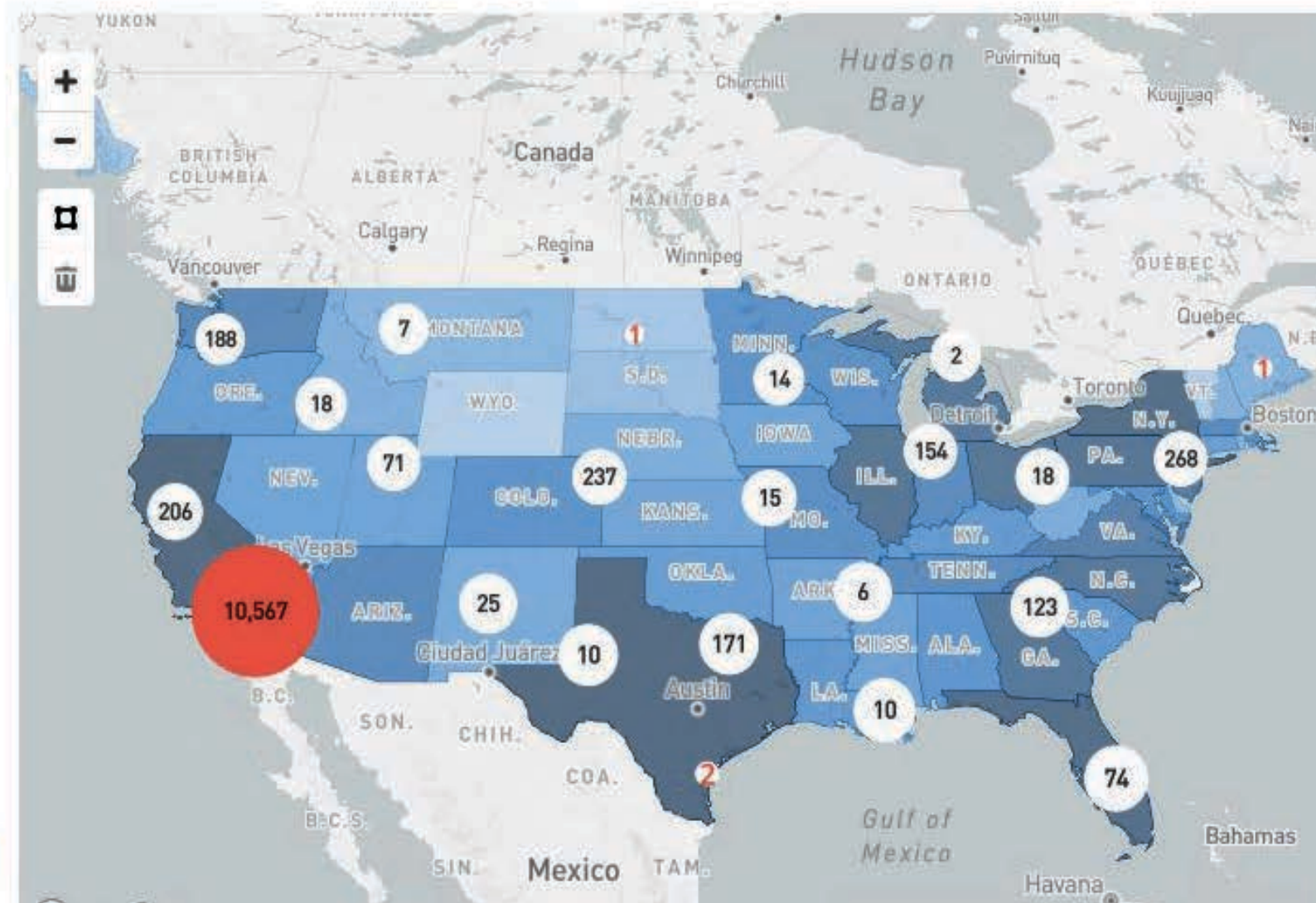

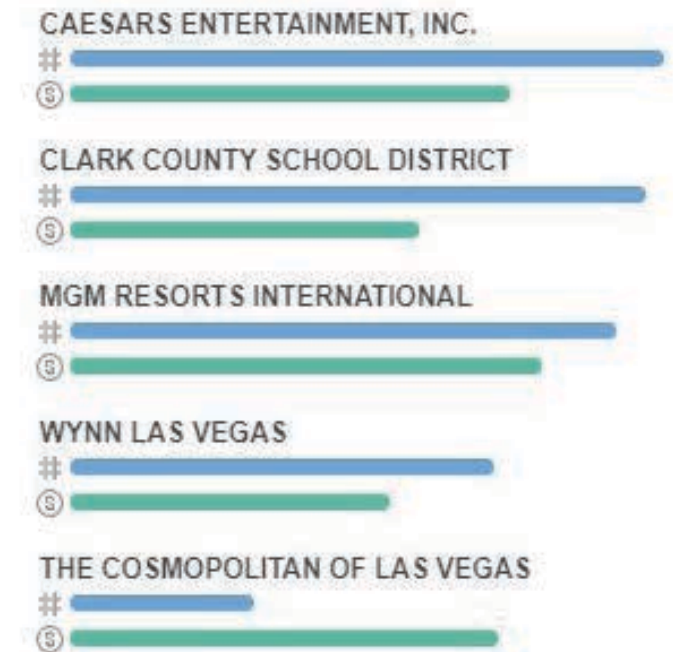
Alumni Geography

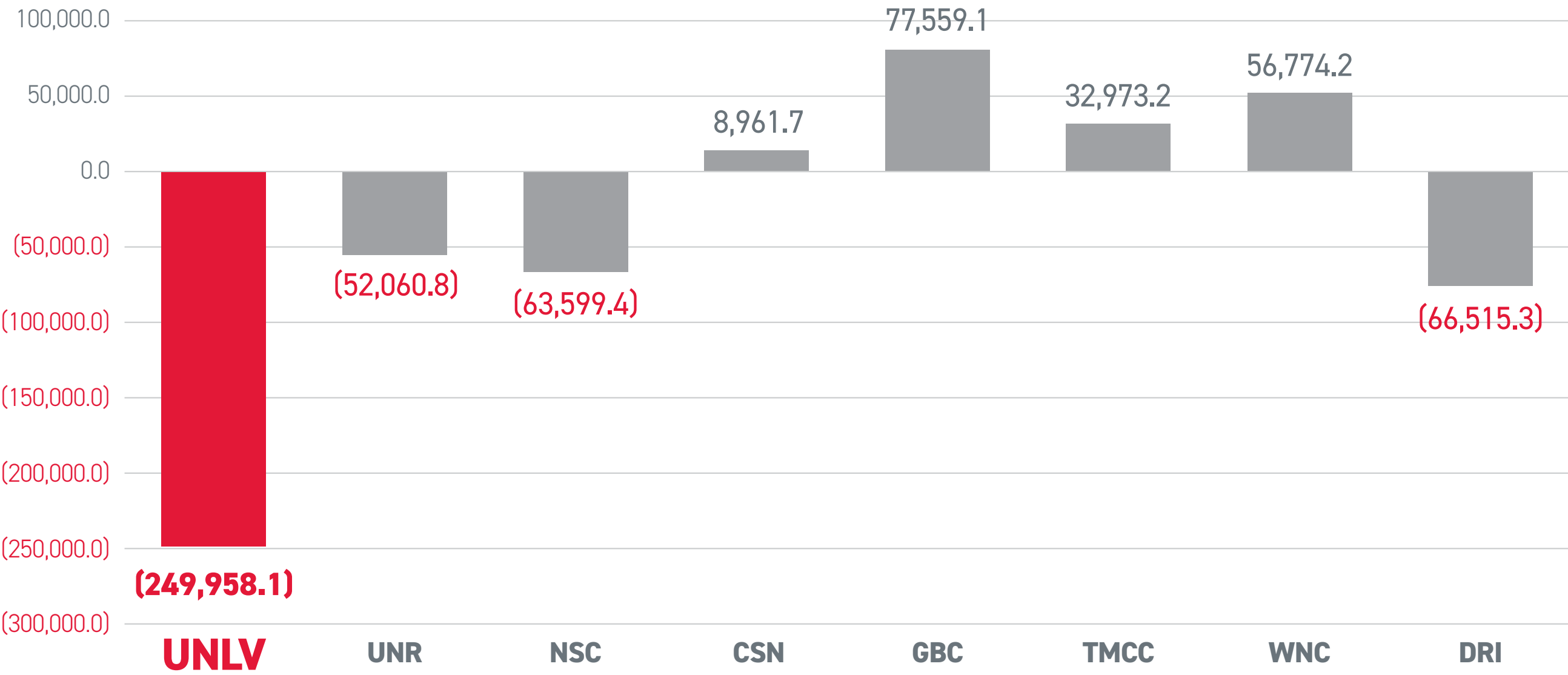
