


IN FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED BY NEVADA STATE COLLEGE TO STUDENTS IN 2017













With Institutional Peer Comparisons For The Most Recent Reporting Year










Degrees Granted

Number of Students Receiving a Degree or Certificate








Number of Students by Race/Ethnic Categories





Number of Students Receiving a Bachelor's Degree







First-Time, Part-Time Students








One-year Retention








