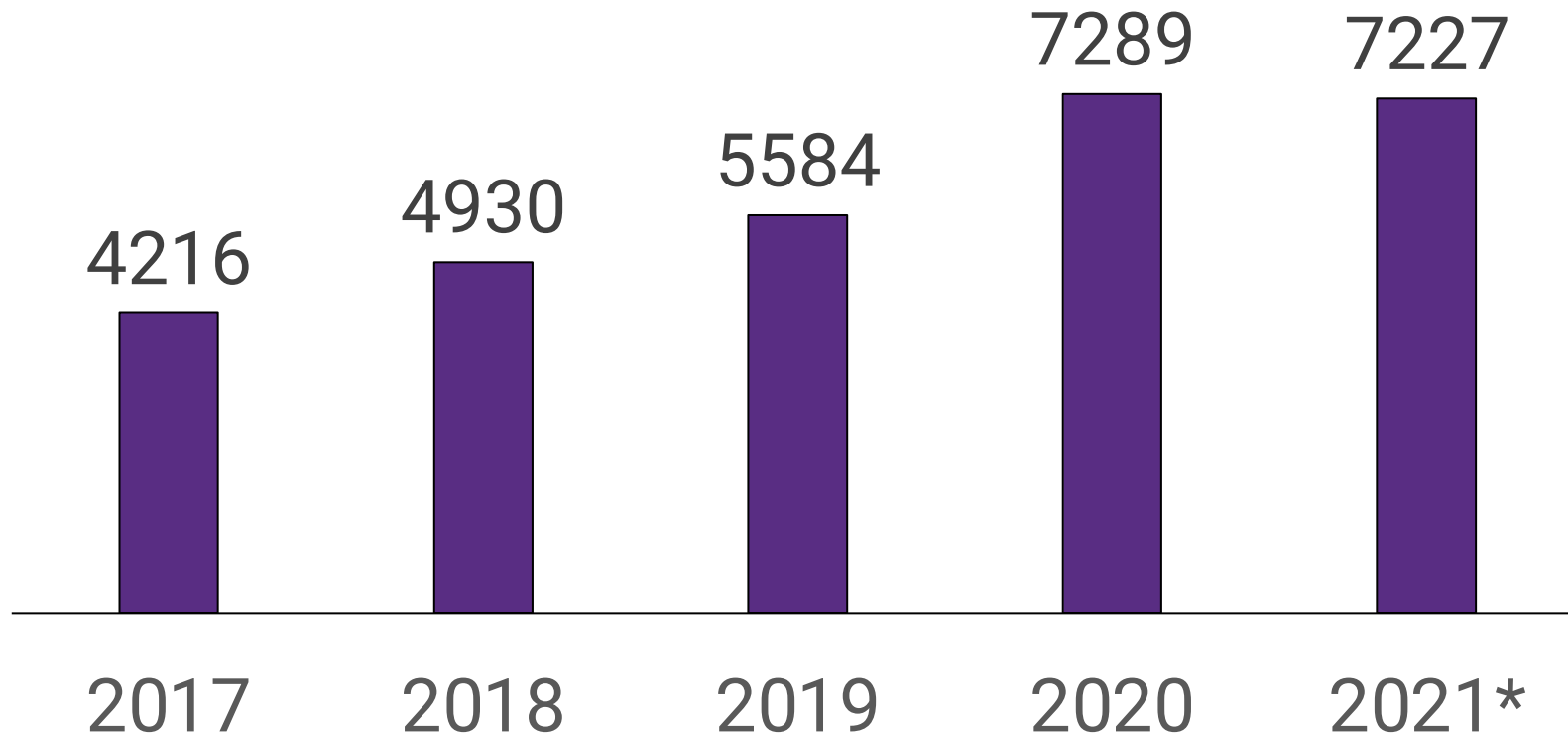

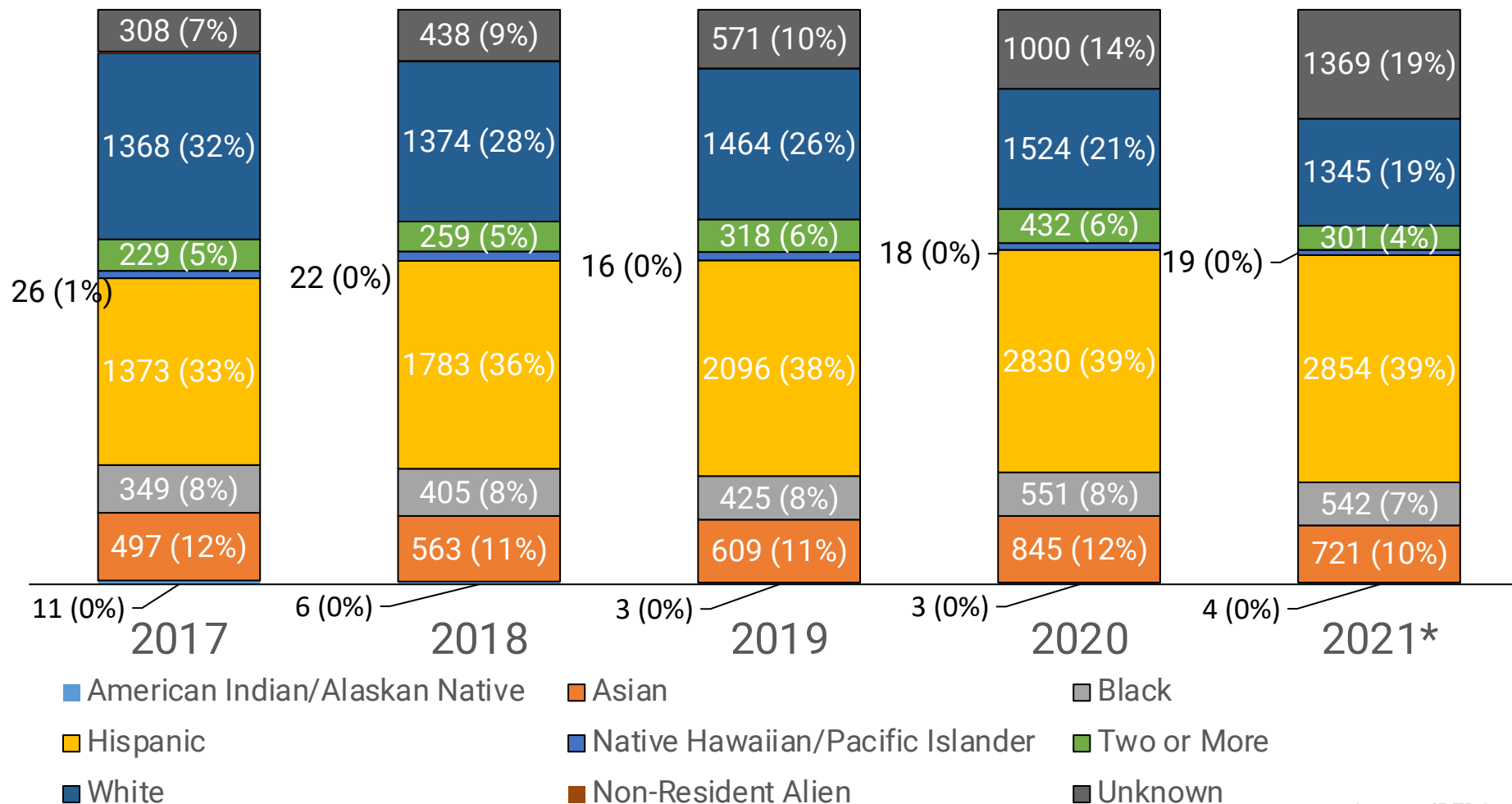

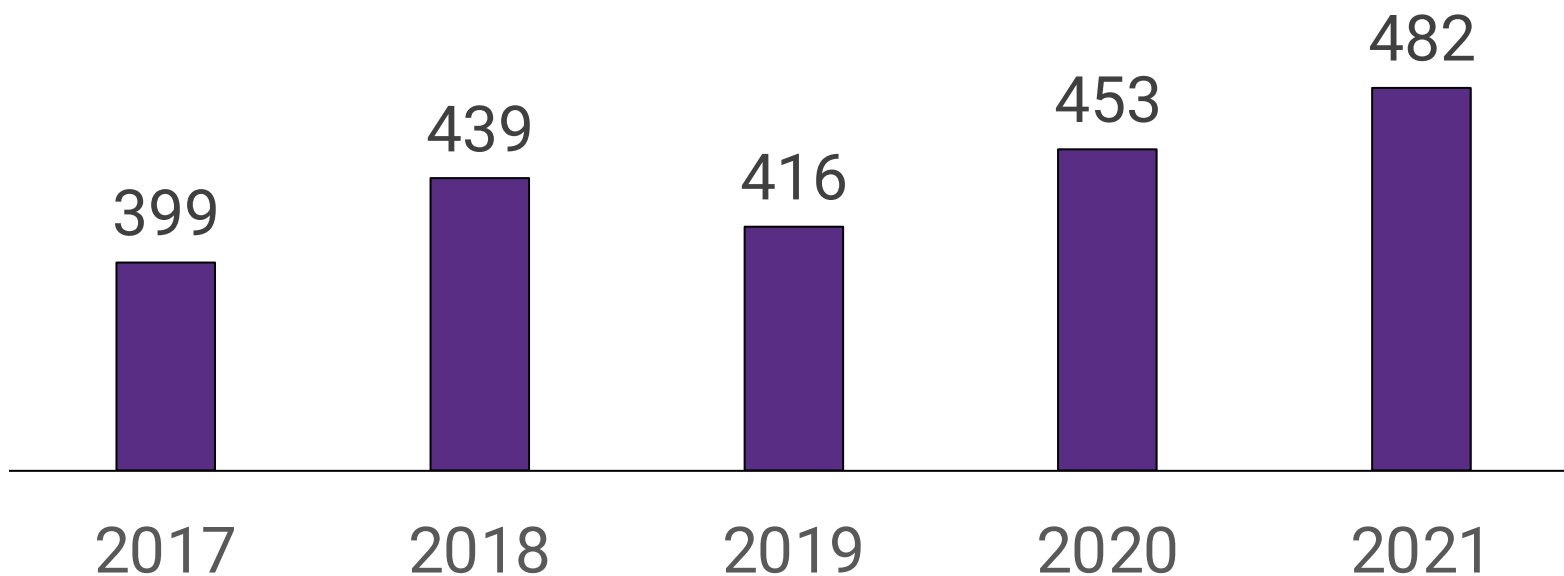

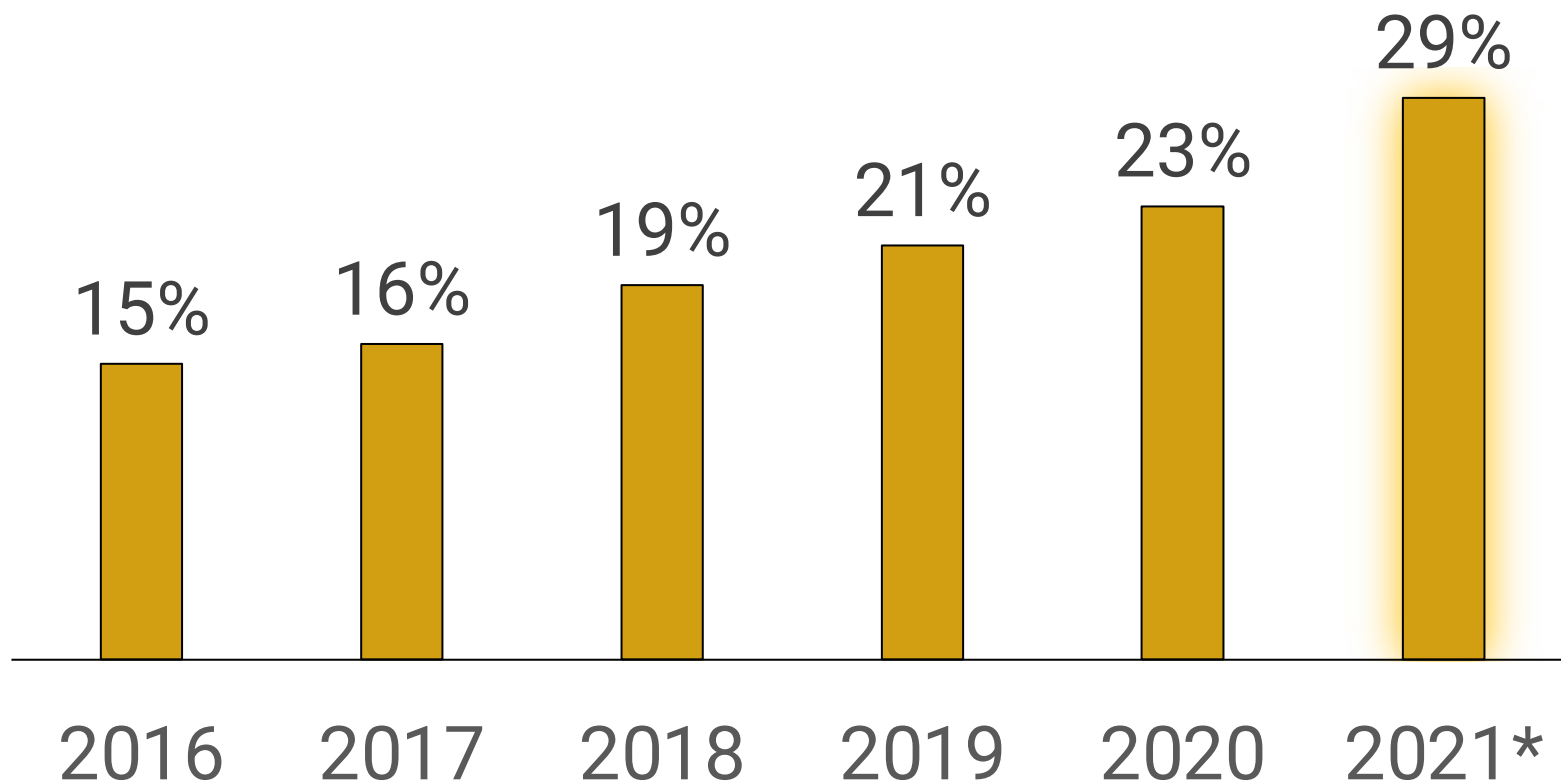

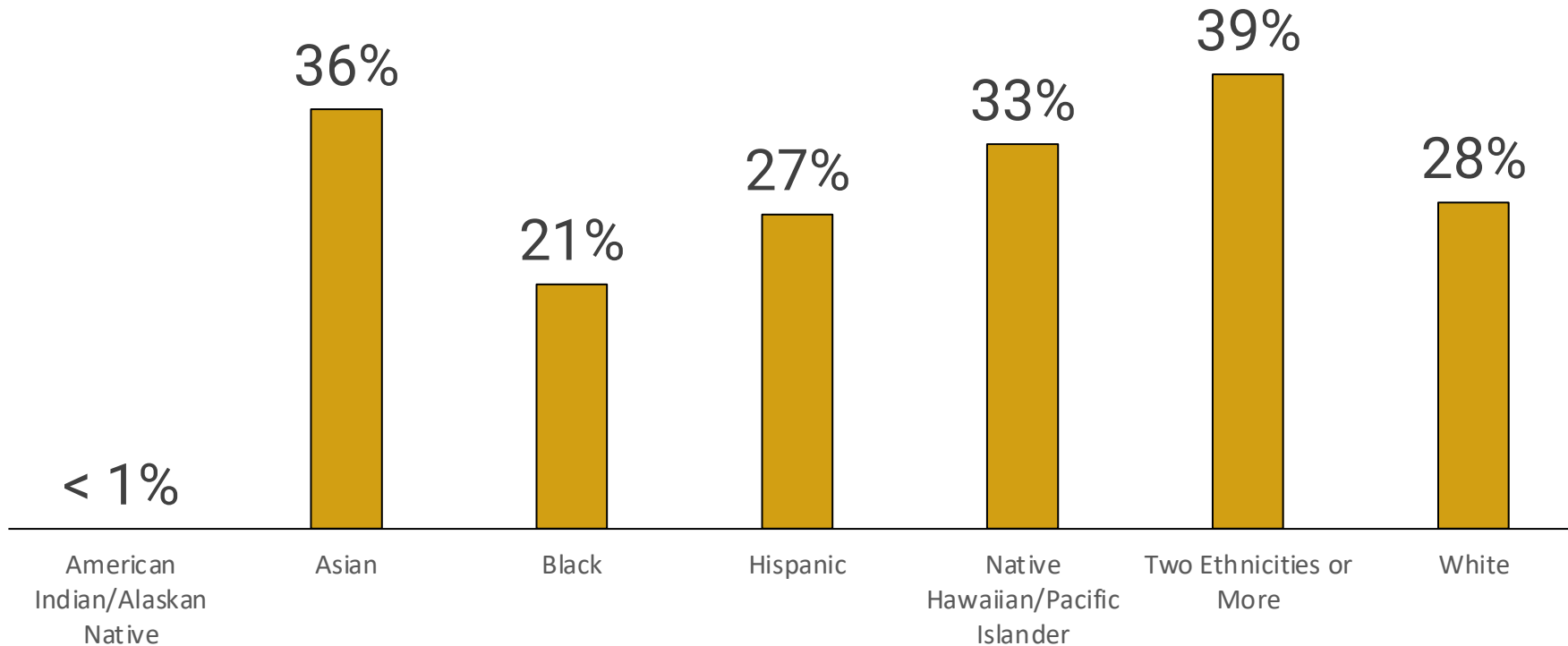

By Race/Ethnic Categories for Fall 2015 Cohort



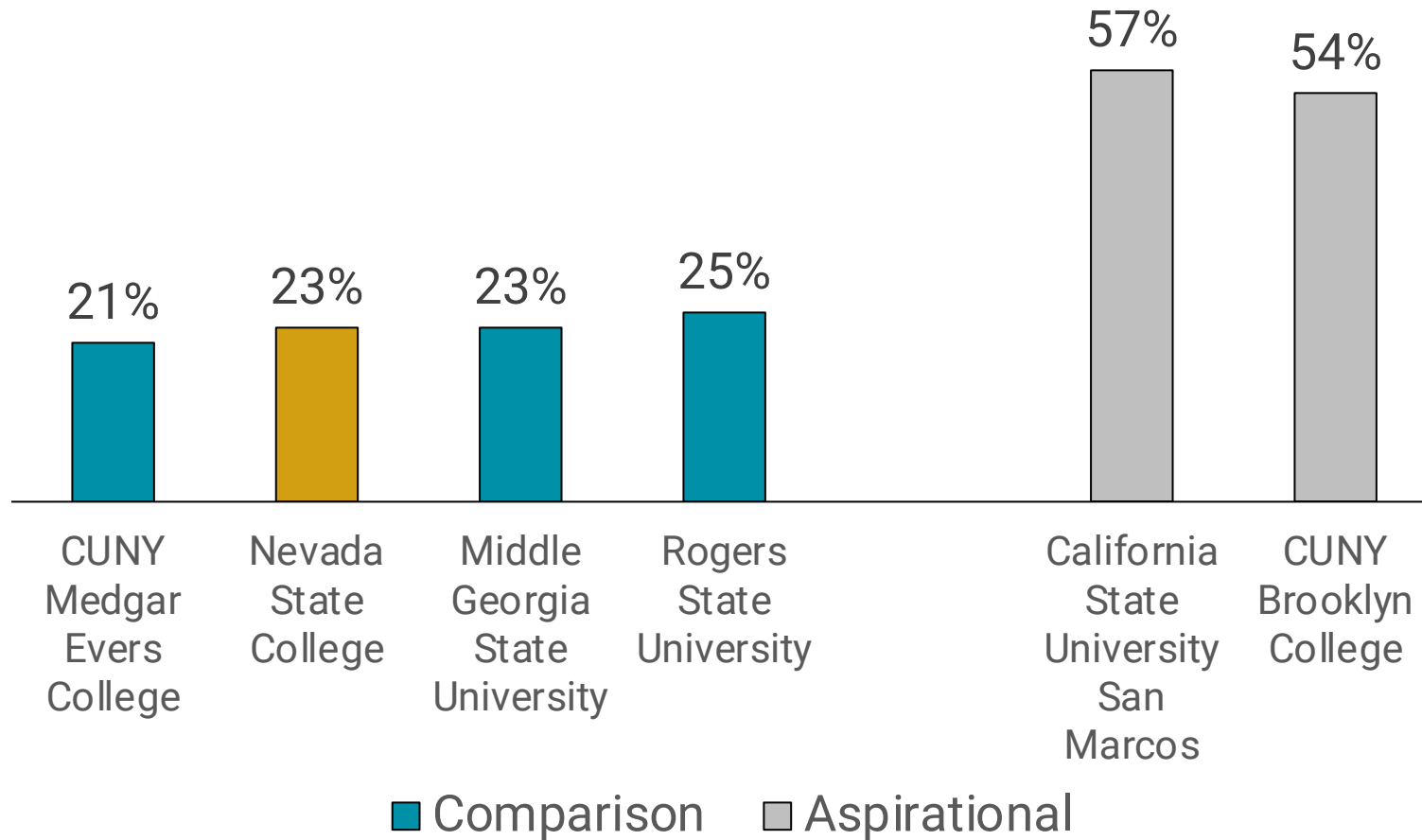

With Institutional Peer Comparisons For The Most Recent Reporting Year

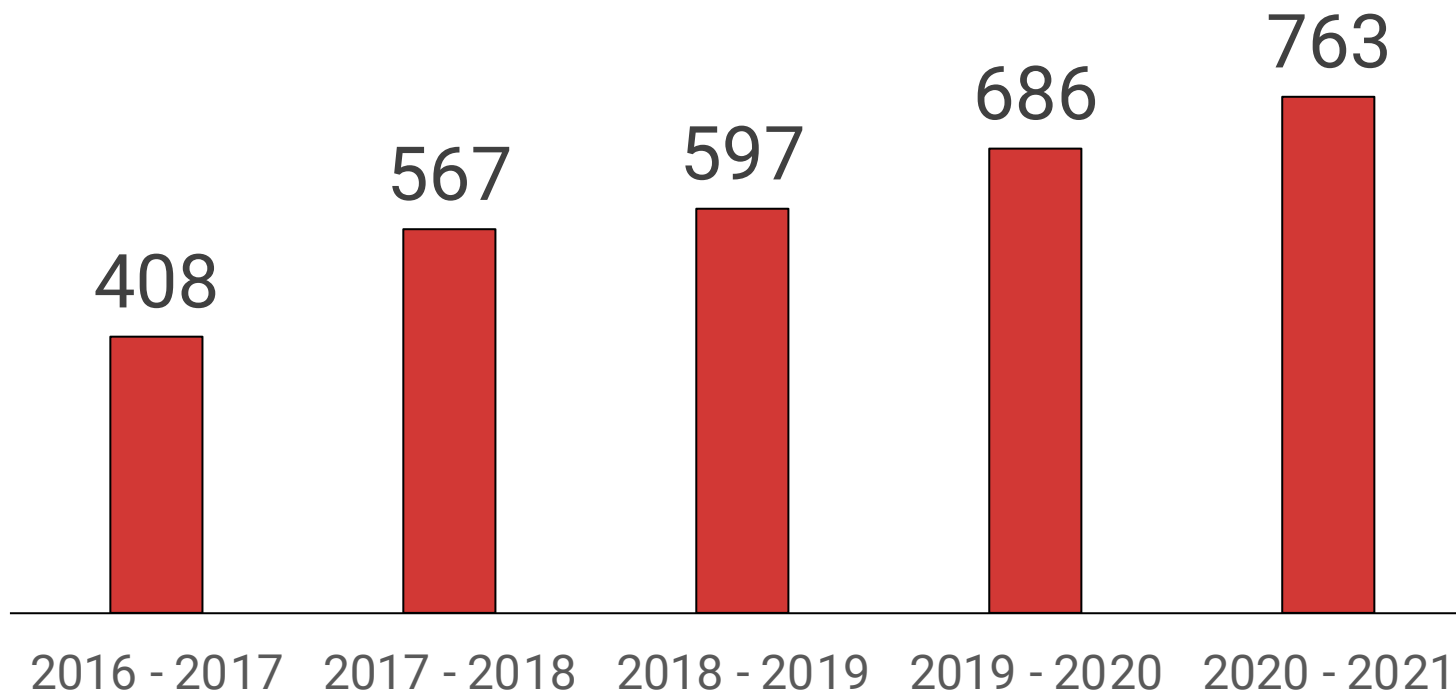






# Degrees Granted

Number of Students Receiving a Degree or Certificate



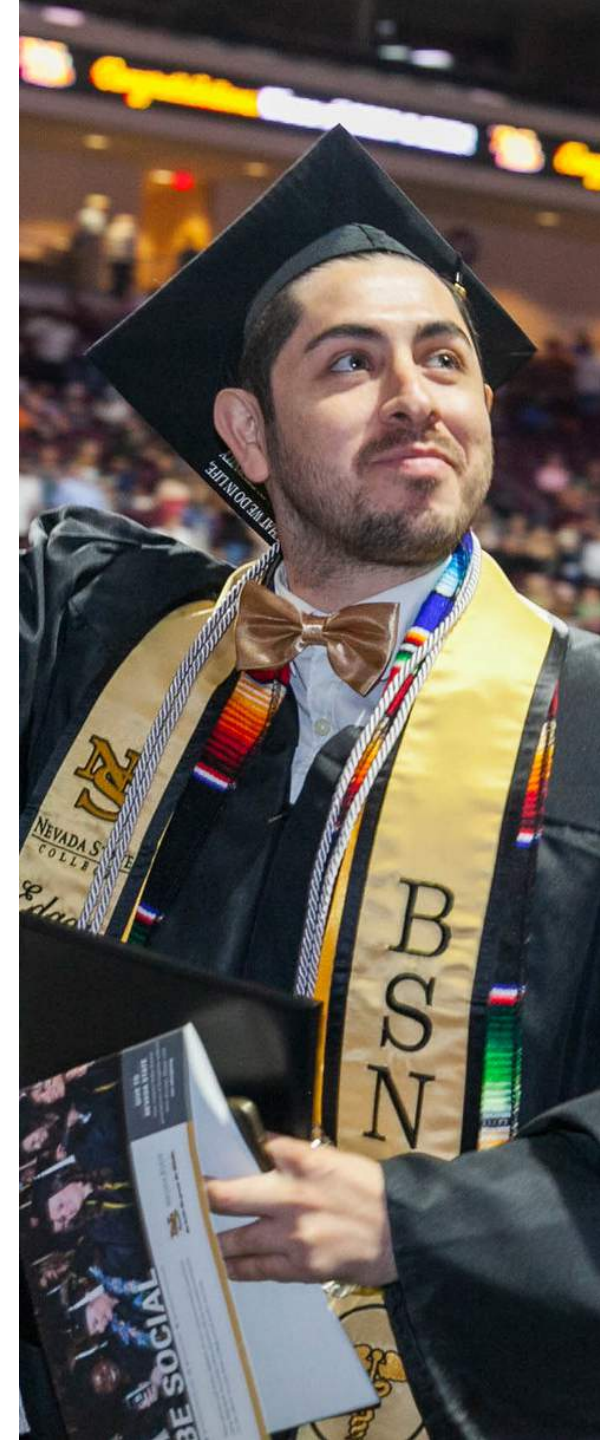
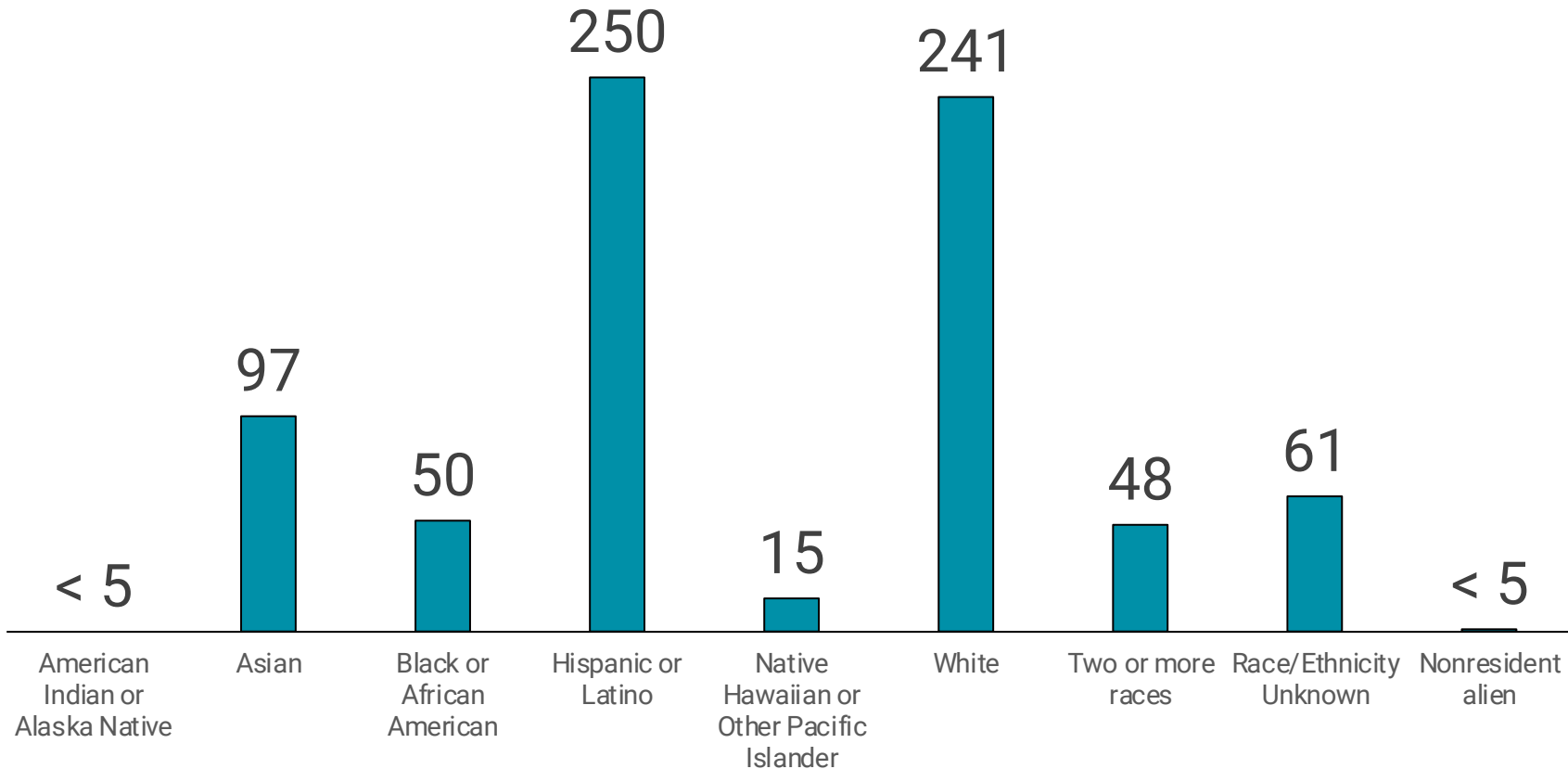

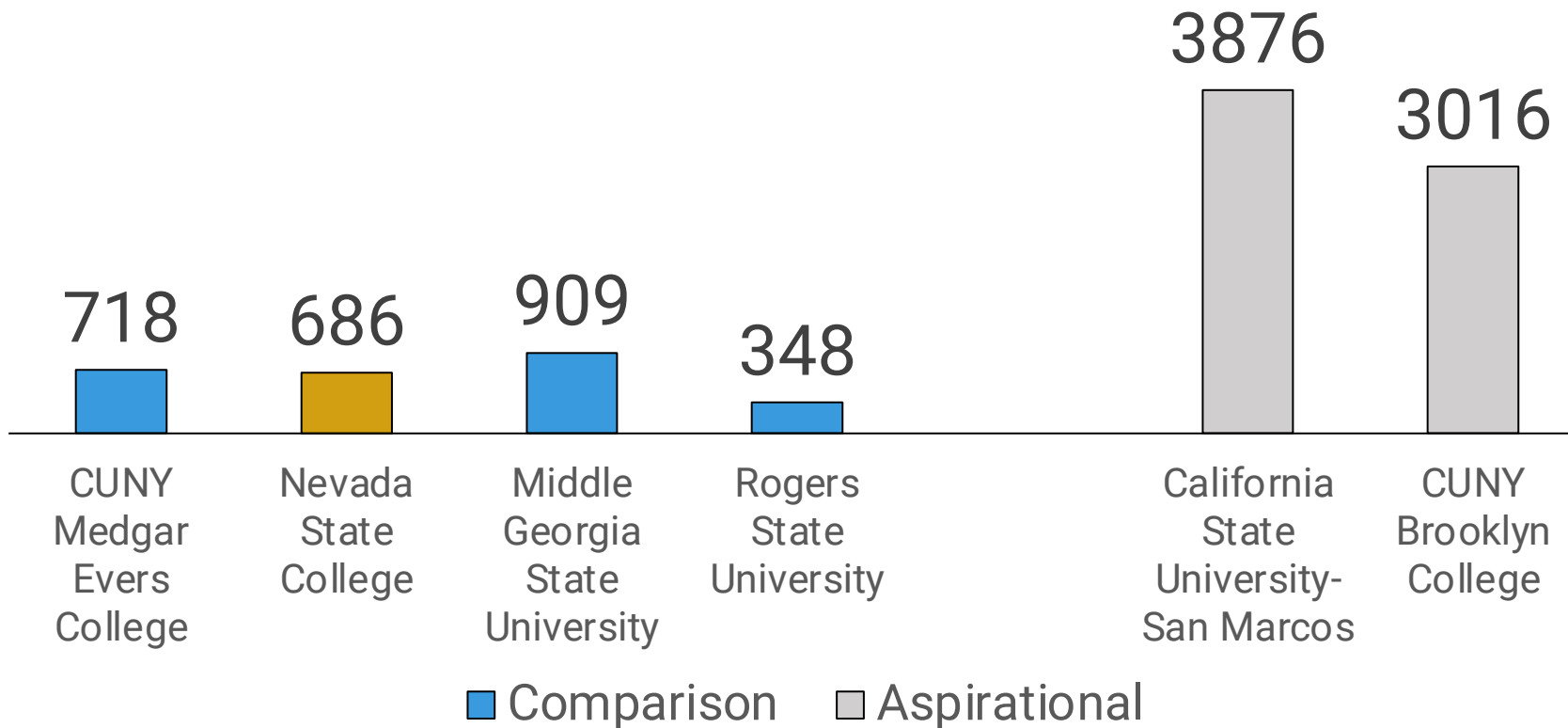
Number of Students by Race/Ethnic Categories

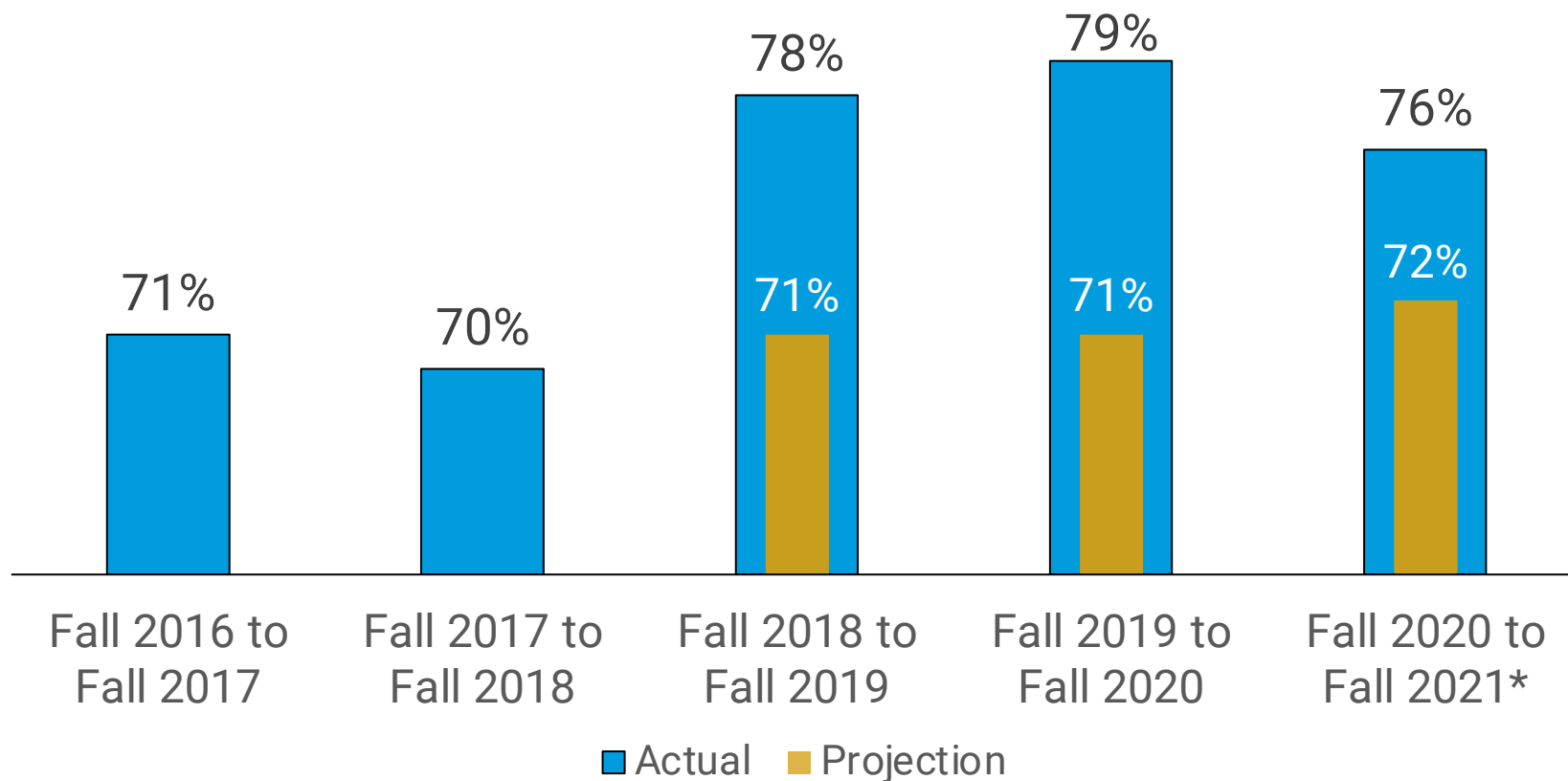
Number of Students Receiving a Bachelor's Degree

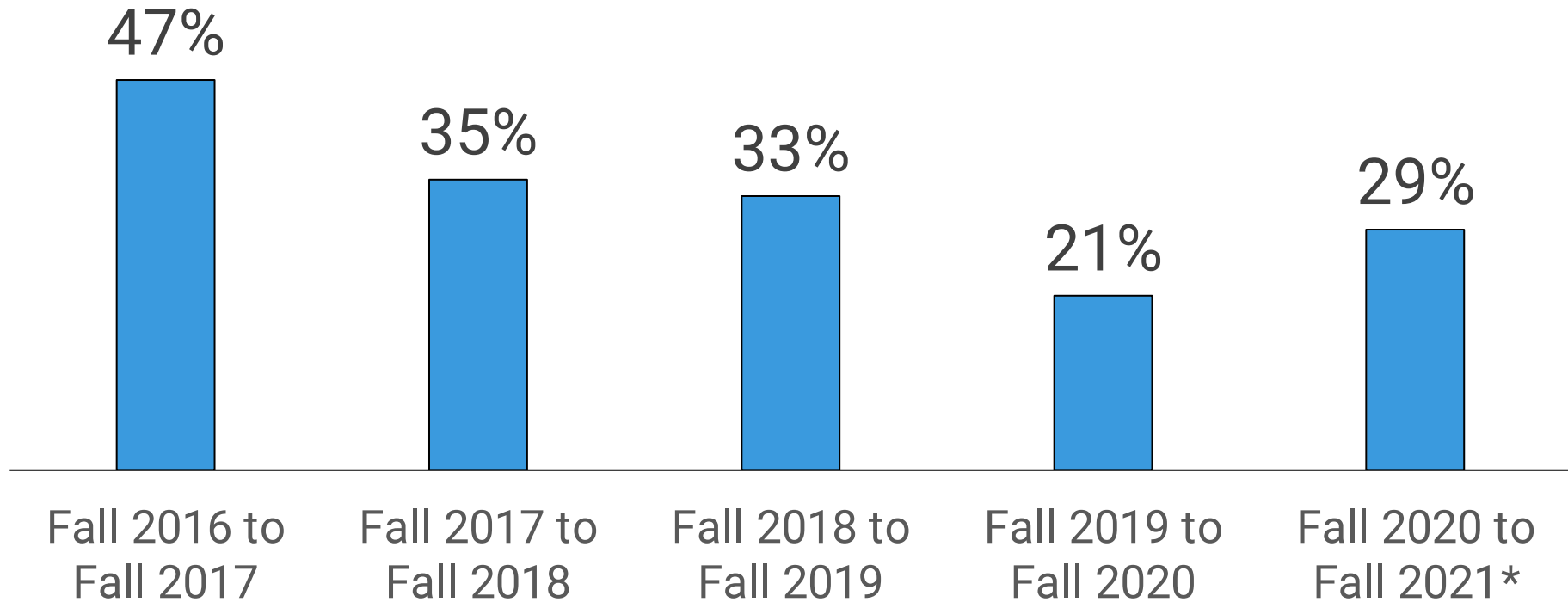

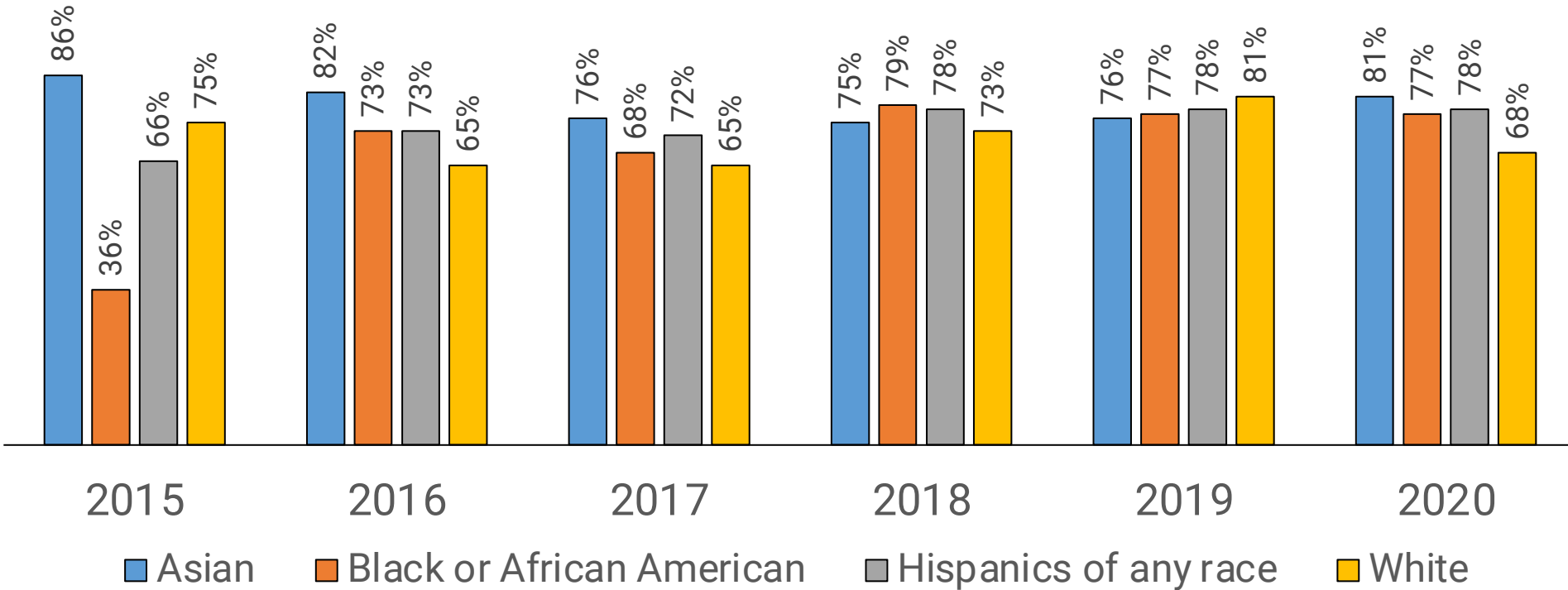






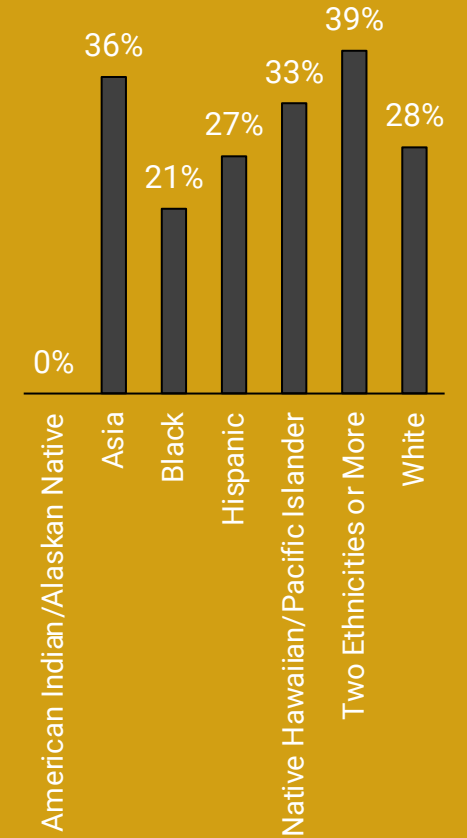
# One-year Retention

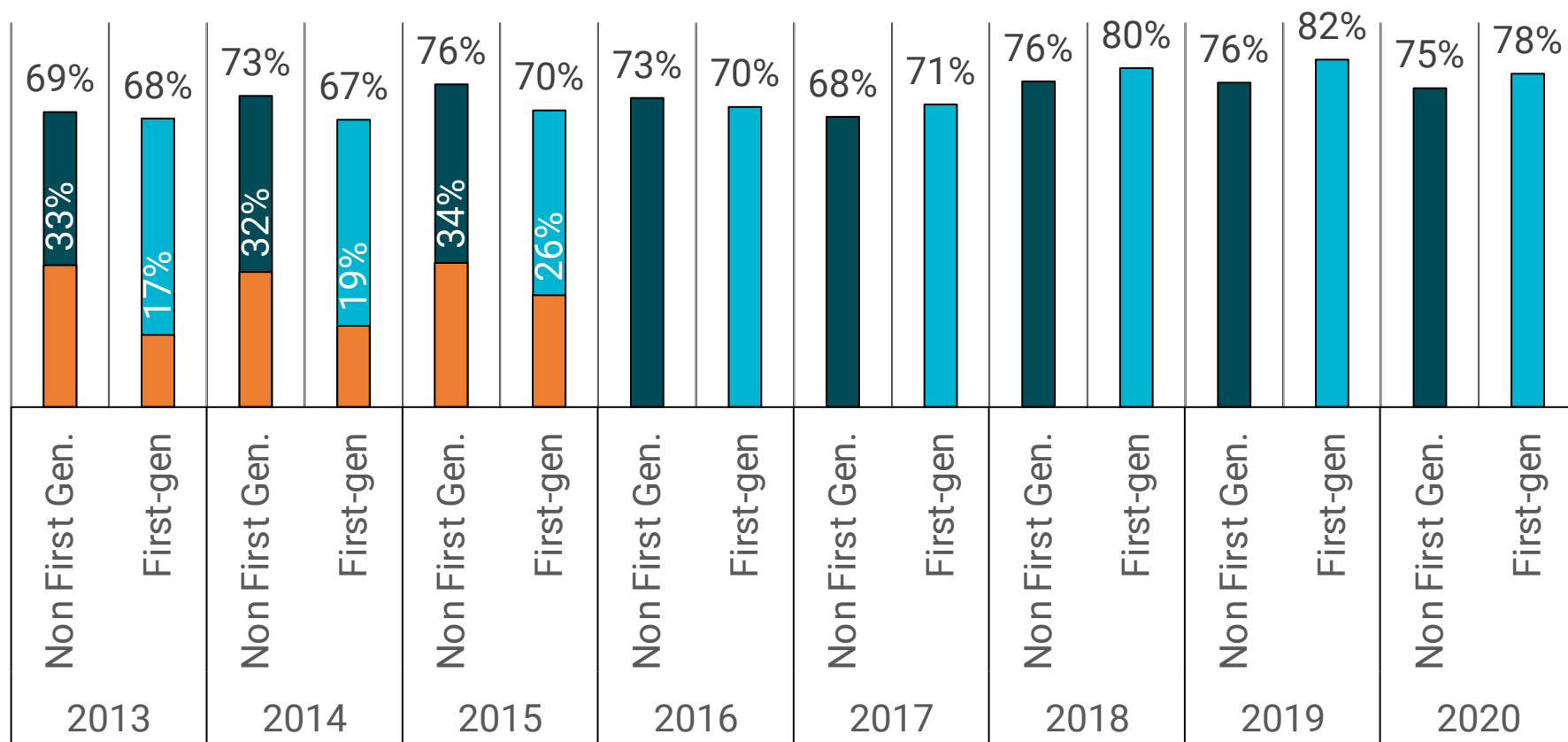

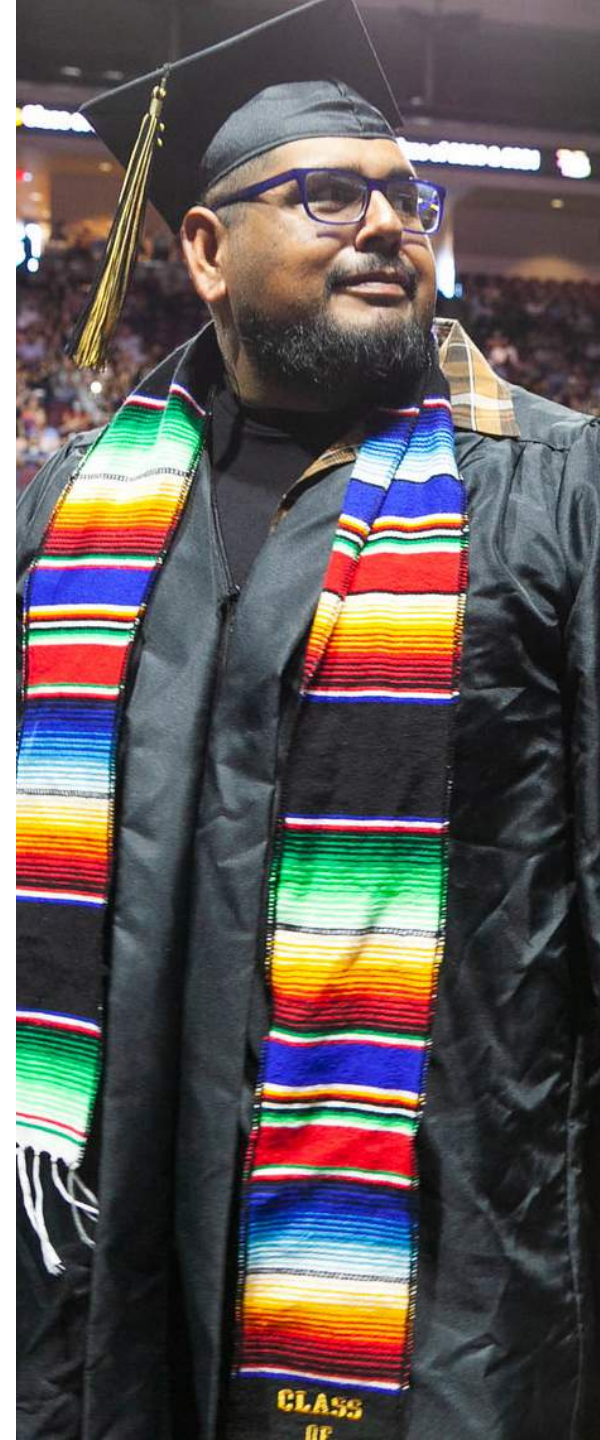
