# **System Administration Organization**

- Provide support to the Board of Regents in their charge of providing direction and coordination for the various activities of the campuses and other units of NSHE
- Organized by Functional Unit
  - Chancellor
  - Academic and Student Affairs
  - Government and Community Affairs
  - Workforce Development
  - Legal
    - Human Resources
    - Retirement Plan Alternative Administration
    - NSHE Risk Management/ Insurance
  - Finance
  - Board of Regents Administration
    - Chief of Staff and Special Counsel
    - Internal Audit



## **System Administration Budgets**

- Non-formula state budget
  - Separate budget account
  - Funded on a line-item basis
  - No automatic provision for 'caseload growth'
- Non-state budget sources
  - Campus Assessment
  - Investment Income / Investment Management Fee
  - Reimbursements for shared services
  - Enterprise Funds (Insurance and Retirement Plan)
