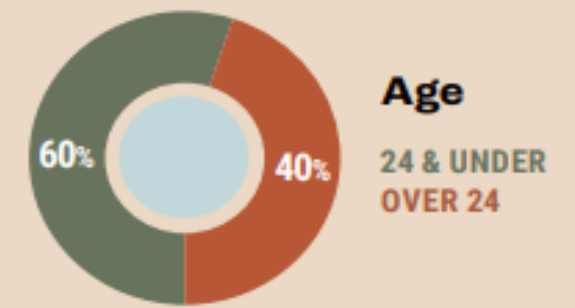
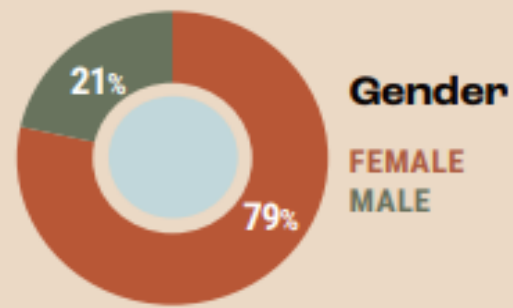

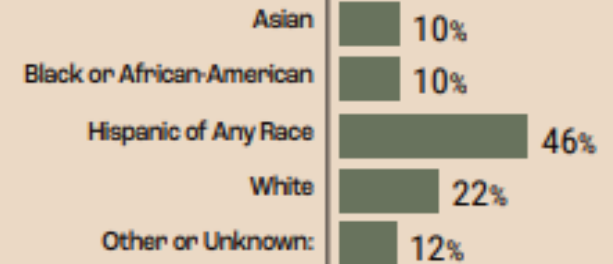
Total dollar amount of financial aid & scholarships awarded in 2021/2022

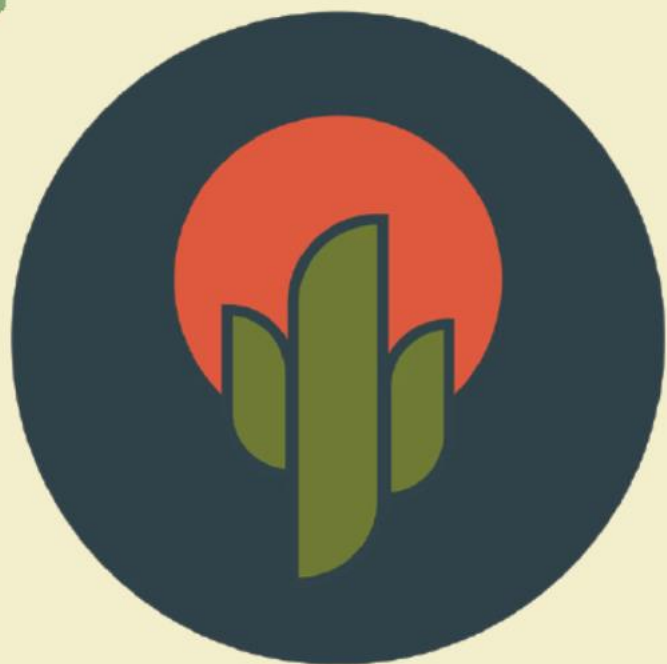
