- Campus Victim Advocate (CVA) program provides free support and services to survivors of power-based violence
 - WNC partnership with Crisis Support Services of Nevada
 - On/off-campus resources and referrals
- Wildcat Wellness
 - 24/7 Support line for students
 - Mental health and wellness resources for students and employees
- Employee Assistance Program
 - ComPsych Guidance Resources
 - 24/7 Support Resources & Information

Services in Our Area

- Support victims by providing information on community resources including Counseling, Mental Health, and other Community Partner resources in our service area
- Information on free and/or reduced cost legal services in our service area



Complaint Procedures

NSHE Policy Against Unlawful Discrimination and Harassment; Complaint Procedure

- Conduct that does not constitute Title IX Sexual Harassment
- Sexual Harassment under Title IX

Complaint procedure in NSHE Code Rules of Conduct and Procedures for Students

- All other allegations

Remedies, interim measures, and supportive measures

- Including but not limited to those outlined in the NSHE Policy Against Unlawful Discrimination and Harassment; Complaint Procedure



University Police Services at WNC

Services On-Campus and Through University Police Northern Command

- Take and investigate police reports including:
 - Harassment and threats
 - Stalking
 - Sexual assault
 - Dating/domestic violence
 - Assault/battery
- Victim Advocate Services
 - Information
 - Legal
 - Support
- Crime Reporting - Clery Act
 - Daily crime logs detail crimes within the past 60 days
 - The Annual Security Report contains crime statistics and safety information over the last three years
