4. INVENTORY OF SERVICES AND GAPS ANALYSIS **INFORMATION ONLY**

Chair Dr. Elizabeth Gunn will lead Task Force members in a follow up discussion and gaps analysis based on presentations at the March 26, 2024, meeting by representatives from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, University of Nevada, Reno, College of Southern Nevada, Great Basin College, Nevada State University, Truckee Meadows Community College, and Western Nevada College regarding the services available on their campuses for victims of power-based violence. Power-based violence refers to any form of interpersonal violence intended to pressure, control, intimidate, or harm another person through the assertion of power over the person. The term includes, without limitation: dating violence; domestic violence; family violence; gender-based violence; violence based on sexual orientation or gender identity or expression; sexual assault; sexual harassment; sexual exploitation; stalking; or the observation of another person who is naked or engaging in sexual activity without his or her consent, including, without limitation, voyeurism.
