6.9.6 Advisors, Attorneys.

(a) The person charged may be accompanied by one advisor of the person's choice, who may represent and advise the person [act on the charged person's behalf] and may present the evidence on the person's behalf. The person charged must give written notice of the name and address of the advisor, and whether the advisor is an attorney, to the administrative officer no later than 5 college working days before the time set for the hearing. An advisor will not be permitted at the hearing without such notice.

(b) Should a person charged advise that the person will be accompanied by an attorney as advisor, the administrative officer shall [may] advise the Vice Chancellor for Legal Affairs so that an attorney will [may] be present at the hearing to represent and advise [act as advisor for] the administrative officer and to present the evidence on behalf of the administrative officer.
