g. Capital Construction

(11) Nothing in this section prohibits a contracting body from requiring bonds. (B/R 10/02)

h. Joinder (or Mutual Use of Contract) Capability – With the agreement of the vendor, the UCCSN may join, or mutually use, the contracts or pricing agreements of appropriate federal, state, and local entities and consortiums. Where the UCCSN uses the original contract in order to obtain quantity pricing or other competitive discounts, the original contract is not liable for the obligations of the UCCSN. The requirements for competitive quotations and/or formal bidding may be considered satisfied through the use of the joinder contracts, including federal/state/local contracts, consortium agreements, and the educational pricing agreements. 6. Scientific Equipment - Faculty may designate the specific manufacturer of scientific equipment; however, the Purchasing Department shall have the responsibility of procuring competition of vendors whenever possible.

NEVADA REVISED STATUTES
CHAPTER 332

NRS 332.195 Joinder or mutual use of contracts by local governments.

1. A governing body or its authorized representative may join or use the contracts of other local governments located within or outside this state with the authorization of the contracting vendor. The originally contracting local government is not liable for the obligations of the local government which joins or uses the contract.

2. A governing body or its authorized representative may join or use the contracts of the State of Nevada or another state with the authorization of the contracting vendor. The State of Nevada or other state is not liable for the obligations of the local government which joins or uses the contract.
