In June 2011, the Board approved a policy to limit the number of credits for a baccalaureate degree to 120 credits with certain exceptions. That policy included limiting the associate's degree to 60 credits, also with certain exceptions. There was an omission in the proposal and not all references to the prior 60 credit "minimum" were updated to reflect the new proposed standard. The attached policy proposal aligns Title 4, Chapter 16, Section 25 (effective Fall 2012) with the provisions adopted in June.
