BOARD OF REGENTS BRIEFING PAPER

Clarification of National Guard Fee Waiver – State-Supported vs. Self-Supporting Courses

BACKGROUND & POLICY CONTEXT OF ISSUE:

Existing Board policy provides that active members of the Nevada National Guard are eligible for a fee waiver that will permit such Guard members to register for courses without a registration fee (e.g. resident tuition) (Title 4, Chapter 17, Section 12 of the *Handbook* and NRS 396.544). This waiver will also pay for laboratory fees associated with certain courses. In practice, the fee waiver applies only to state-supported academic credit-bearing courses that lead to a degree or certificate. However, the policy does not specifically distinguish between state-supported and self-supporting courses. System staff recommends revising Board policy to clarify this language and reflect existing practice.

SPECIFIC ACTIONS BEING RECOMMENDED OR REQUESTED:

Amend Board policy (Title 4, Chapter 17, Section 12 of the *Handbook*) to clarify that state-supported academic, credit-bearing courses that lead to a degree or certificate are eligible for the fee waiver, but self-supporting courses are not eligible for the fee waiver. (See attached policy proposal.)

IMPETUS (WHY NOW?):

This policy revision is recommended to clarify existing Board policy and reflect existing practice.

BULLET POINTS TO SUPPORT REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:

- The policy revision will assist students and institutional staff by clearly distinguishing which types of courses (state-supported vs. self-supporting) are eligible for the National Guard fee waiver.
- The policy revision reflects existing practice.

POTENTIAL ARGUMENTS AGAINST THE REQUEST/RECOMMENDATION:

None have been presented.

ALTERNATIVE(S) TO WHAT IS BEING REQUESTED/RECOMMENDED:

Retain the existing policy.

POLICY PROPOSAL TITLE 4, CHAPTER 17, SECTION 12

National Guard Fee Waiver

Additions appear in *boldface italics*; deletions are [stricken and bracketed]

Section 12. Special Reduced Tuition and Fees

. . . .

- 4. Any member of the active Nevada National Guard, including a Nevada National Guard recruit, or the child or spouse of a person who was killed while performing duties as a member of the Nevada National Guard, may be permitted to register for credit without a registration fee or, except as otherwise provided, laboratory fee(s).
 - a. This policy is applicable during Fall and Spring terms only.
 - b. State-supported a[A]cademic credit-bearing courses that [will] lead to a [the] degree or certificate, including [state-supported] distance education courses, independent learning, and continuing education courses are eligible for the fee waiver. Self-supporting courses, including [Non-state supported] independent study and correspondence courses, are not eligible for waiver under this policy.
