Prevention and Response Efforts

- Employee Training
 - Preventing Sexual Harassment & Discrimination (Foundry)
 - Mandatory upon hire and every two years thereafter
 - Additional Preventing Sexual Harassment training is occasionally offered
- Student Training
 - Sexual Assault Prevention for Community Colleges (Foundry)
 - Must be offered at least once a year
 - TMCC offers this training to students each fall and spring semester
 - Student-Athletes are required to complete the on-line course each semester plus conduct annual in-person “TIX and Athletics” training.

Prevention and Response Efforts (continued)

Training and Certification for Employees with Title IX or Clery Roles:

- **Association of Title IX Administrators (ATIXA) Membership**
 - TIX Coordinator has completed a of six ATIXA certifications since 2017
- **Academic Impressions Membership**
 - Three key employees have completed five Title IX training sessions since 2020
- **Campus Security Authority (CSA) Training**
 - Eight to twelve (8-12) key employees will complete CSA training in 2022
