SB 192

SB 192 passed at the legislature, providing \$10 million toward funding the iNtegrate project. The original bill was amended allowing provision for the dollars to be spent over a four year period instead of two. The bill also required that NSHE funds be expended prior to state funds and that any unused state funds are reverted.

Project Director Search

The iNtegrate Project Director search has been opened and a search committee with representation from each campus has been formed with Vice Chancellors Reed and McCollum co-chairing it.

Negotiations Status

Services negotiations are underway with three vendors, SunGard Higher Education, Oracle/Ciber and CedarCrestone.
