The Mission of the Nevada System of Higher Education: To provide higher education to the citizens of the state at an excellent level of quality consistent with the state's resources.

The Position: The Board of Regents of the Nevada System of Higher Education seeks nominations and applications for Chancellor of the Nevada System of Higher Education (NSHE) to lead a growing, dynamic system of eight institutions committed to serving the needs of the citizens of the State of Nevada. Salary is \$378,198 – \$643,089 per Chapter 3 Section 1 (Salary Schedules) of the NSHE Procedures and Guidelines Manual. Final offer will be determined by the Board of Regents based on candidate qualifications.



Our Communities: Residents of Nevada enjoy a high desert landscape set against a backdrop of the beautiful Sierra Nevada Mountains. With an economy originally founded on mining but shifting to tourism by the mid-20th century, Nevada complements its tourist-centric economy with an emerging highly skilled technological base. The population of Nevada is highly diverse, and this is reflected in its education system as a whole.

NSHE: The Nevada System of Higher Education comprises two universities; one state college; one research institute; and four community colleges. The opportunity for contribution and impact offered by the Chancellor position is best illustrated by noting that Nevada is unique in the comprehensiveness and dominance of its public system of higher education. Thus, the NSHE Chancellor serves as the dominant voice for higher education in Nevada.

- ◆ Letter of interest/cover letter
- ◆ Four reference letters - must be within the past six months
- ◆ Four philosophy statements illustrating your knowledge and beliefs regarding each of the following - leadership, education, management, and DEI
- ◆ CV or resume - please include language proficiency/fluency
- ◆ Credentials with formal verification - degrees (including transcripts), licenses, and certifications

- ◆ The Chancellor shall have a degree from a college or university recognized as equal in rank to those having membership in the Association of American Universities. (NRS 396.210)
- ◆ Top-performing higher education leaders, as well as diverse and exceptional leaders from other sectors, are encouraged to apply
- ◆ Role expertise required: a candidate must wear the following hats very well: Leader, Communicator, Community Engager, DEI Advocate, Partnership Builder, Results Driver, Team Builder
- ◆ Competencies required to support role execution: Leadership, Political Savvy, Building Trust & Credibility, Relationship Building, Values Diversity, Communicating, Community Engagement, Integrity, Professionalism, Big Picture, Orientation, Problem Solving, Adaptability & Flexibility, Resilience
